2 INVITE FRIENDS TO PROTECT YOU

The app will walk you through a simple tutorial and setup. Be sure to invite your trusted contacts who will be alerted if you're ever in need of help.



3 TURN ON SIDEKICK

Press (and hold) **power button** to turn React Sidekick device on. Button will begin to flash **GREEN**.



4 CLICK "SETUP SIDEKICK DEVICE"

Click the **"Setup Sidekick Device"** button on home screen of app and follow the instructions.
