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## GENERAL INFORMATION

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### Product Description for Equipment under Test (EUT)

The *Telecell Mobile (H.K) Ltd.*'s product, model number: A240 (FCC ID: 2ADX3A240) or the "EUT" in this report was a *Mobile Phone*, which was measured approximately: 12.2 cm (L) × 5.0 cm (W) × 1.2 cm (H), rated with input voltage: DC 3.7V rechargeable Li-ion battery or DC 5.0V from adapter. The highest operating frequency is 2480MHz.

Model: DUOS A240

Input: AC 100-240V, 50/60Hz, 150mA

Output: DC 5.0V, 500mA

*Note: For the product, series model A240 and DUOS are identical schematics, the differences between them are their name. A240 was selected for fully testing, the detailed differences between them were explained and stated in the attached product similarity declaration letter by the applicant.*

*\*All measurement and test data in this report was gathered from production sample serial number: 1602273. (Assigned by Shenzhen BACL). The EUT supplied by the applicant was received on 2016-05-16.*

### Objective

This test report is prepared on behalf of *Telecell Mobile (H.K) Ltd.* in accordance with Part 2-Subpart J, Part 15-Subparts A and B of the Federal Communication Commissions rules.

The objective of the manufacturer is to determine the compliance of the EUT with FCC Part 15 B.

### Related Submittal(s)/Grant(s)

FCC Part 15.247 DSS and Part 22H & 24E PCE submissions with FCC ID: 2ADX3A240.

### Test Methodology

All measurements contained in this report were conducted with ANSI C63.4-2014, American National Standard for Methods of Measurement of Radio-Noise Emissions from Low-Voltage Electrical and Electronic Equipment in the range of 9 kHz to 40 GHz.

All emissions measurement was performed at Bay Area Compliance Laboratories Corp. (Shenzhen). The radiated testing was performed at an antenna-to-EUT distance of 3 meters.

Measurement uncertainty with radiated emission is 5.81 dB for 30MHz-1GHz, and 4.88 dB for above 1GHz, 1.95dB for conducted measurement.

## **Test Facility**

The test site used by Bay Area Compliance Laboratories Corp. (Shenzhen) to collect test data is located on the 6/F, the 3rd Phase of WanLi Industrial Building, ShiHua Road, FuTian Free Trade Zone Shenzhen, Guangdong, China.

Test site at Bay Area Compliance Laboratories Corp. (Shenzhen) has been fully described in reports submitted to the Federal Communication Commission (FCC). The details of these reports have been found to be in compliance with the requirements of Section 2.948 of the FCC Rules on October 31, 2013. The facility also complies with the radiated and AC line conducted test site criteria set forth in ANSI C63.4-2014.

The Federal Communications Commission has the reports on file and is listed under FCC Registration No.: 382179. The test site has been approved by the FCC for public use and is listed in the FCC Public Access Link (PAL) database.

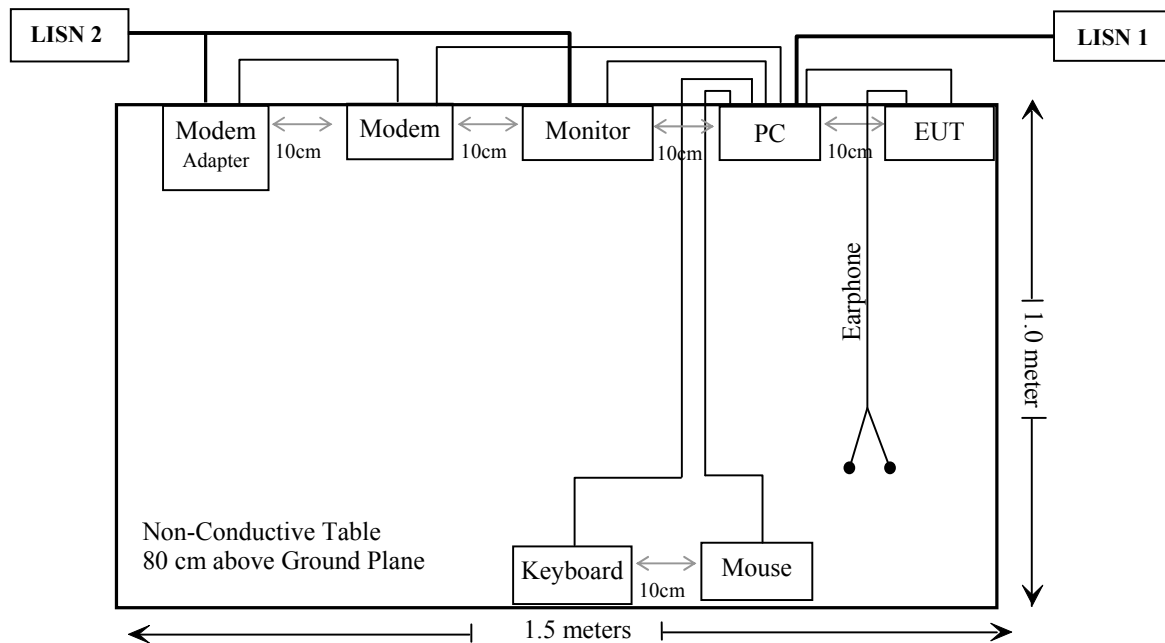

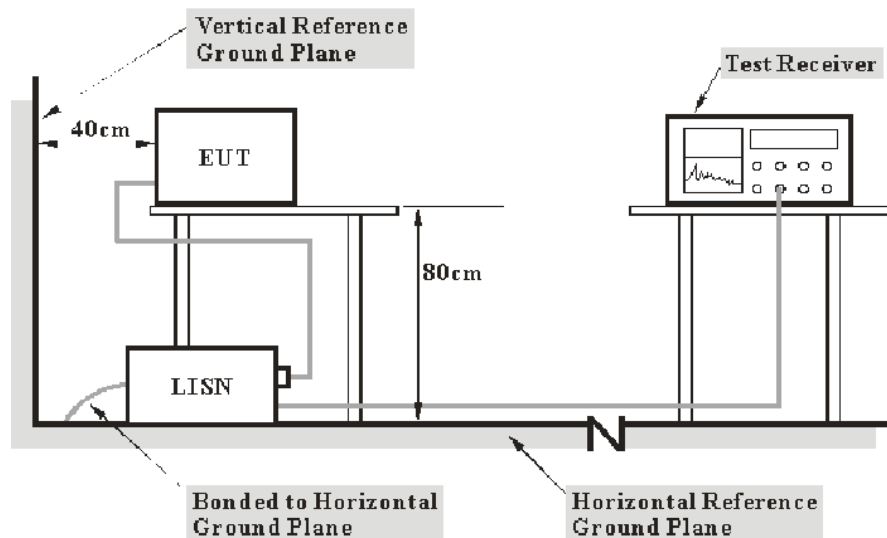
### Measurement Uncertainty

Input quantities to be considered for conducted disturbance measurements maybe receiver reading, attenuation of the connection between LISN/ISN and receiver, LISN/ISN voltage division factor, LISN/ISN VDF frequency interpolation and receiver related input quantities, etc.

Based on CISPR 16-4-2:2011, the expended combined standard uncertainty of conducted disturbance test at Bay Area Compliance Laboratories Corp. (Shenzhen) is shown as below. And the uncertainty will not be taken into consideration for the test data recorded in the report

- Note: 1. Support units were connected to second LISN.  
 2. Both of LISNs (AMN) 80 cm from EUT and at the least 80 cm from other units and other metal planes support units.

The measurement procedure of EUT setup is according with per ANSI C63.4-2014. The related limit was specified in FCC Part 15.107 Class B.

The spacing between the peripherals was 10 cm.



## EMI Test Receiver Setup

The EMI test receiver was set to investigate the spectrum from 150 kHz to 30 MHz.

During the conducted emission test, the EMI test receiver was set with the following configurations:

Frequency Range	IF B/W
150 kHz – 30 MHz	9 kHz

## Test Procedure

During the conducted emission test, the Computer was connected to the first LISN and the other relevant equipments were connected to the second LISN.

Maximizing procedure was performed on the six (6) highest emissions of the EUT.

All data was recorded in the Quasi-peak and average detection mode.

## Corrected Factor & Margin Calculation

The Corrected factor is calculated by adding LISN/ISN VDF (Voltage Division Factor), Cable Loss and Transient Limiter Attenuation. The basic equation is as follows:

$$\text{Correction Factor} = \text{LISN VDF} + \text{Cable Loss} + \text{Transient Limiter Attenuation}$$

The “**Margin**” column of the following data tables indicates the degree of compliance with the applicable limit. For example, a margin of 7 dB means the emission is 7 dB below the limit. The equation for margin calculation is as follows:

$$\text{Margin} = \text{Limit} - \text{Corrected Amplitude}$$

## Test Results Summary

According to the recorded data in following table, the EUT complied with the FCC Part 15.107, the worst margin as below:

**5.9 dB at 9.255190 and 9.657130 MHz in the Line** onducted mode

Refer to CISPR16-4-2:2011 and CISPR 16-4-1:2009, the measured level is in compliance with the limit if

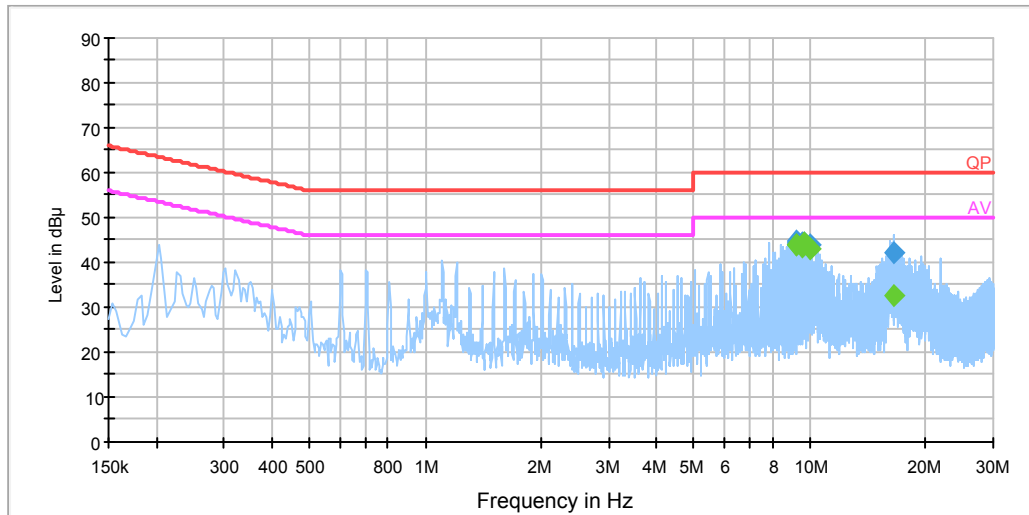

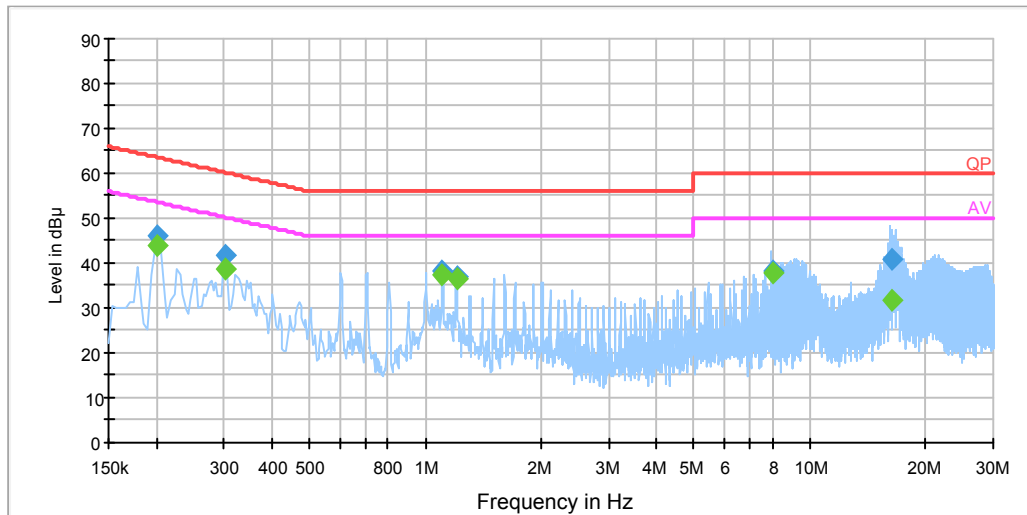

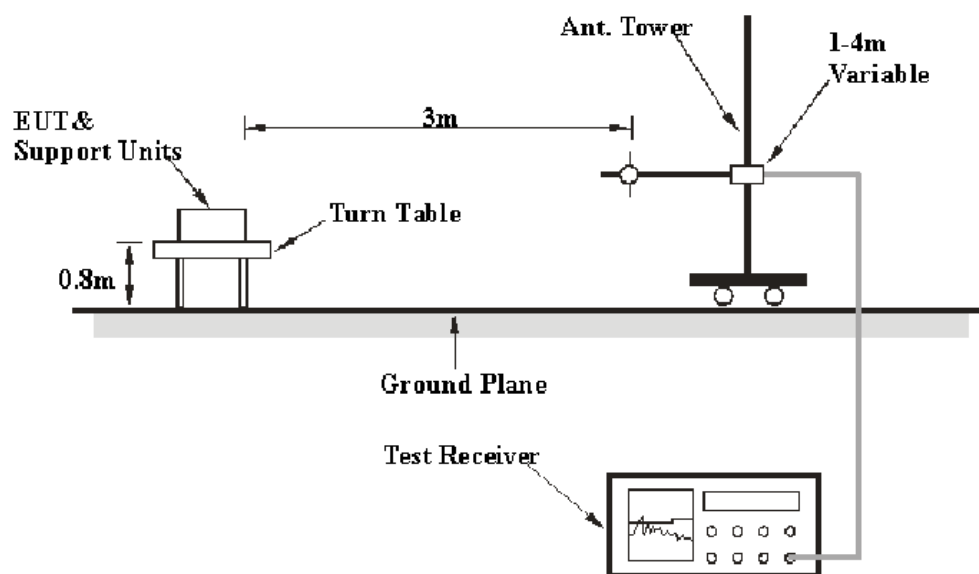
### Measurement Uncertainty

All measurements involve certain levels of uncertainties, especially in field of EMC. The factors contributing to uncertainties are spectrum analyzer, cable loss, antenna factor calibration, antenna directivity, antenna factor variation with height, antenna phase center variation, antenna factor frequency interpolation, measurement distance variation, site imperfections, mismatch (average), and system repeatability.

Based on CISPR 16-4-2:2011, the expanded combined standard uncertainty of radiation emissions at Bay Area Compliance Laboratories Corp. (Shenzhen) is 5.81 dB for 30MHz-1GHz and 4.88 dB for above 1GHz, 1.95dB for conducted measurement at antenna port. And the uncertainty will not be taken into consideration for the test data recorded in the report.

### Test System Setup



The radiated emission tests were performed in the 3 meters chamber test site.

## EMI Test Receiver Setup

According to FCC 15.33 requirements, the EUT system was measured from 30 MHz to 12.4 GHz.

During the radiated emission test, the EMI test receiver Setup was set with the following configurations:

## Test Procedure

Maximizing procedure was performed on the highest emissions to ensure that the EUT complied with all installation combinations.

All data was recorded in the Quasi-peak detector mode from 30 MHz to 1 GHz and PK and average detector modes for frequencies above 1 GHz.

## Corrected Amplitude & Margin Calculation

The Corrected Amplitude is calculated by adding the Antenna Factor and Cable Loss, and subtracting the Amplifier Gain from the Meter Reading. The basic equation is as follows:

$$\text{Corrected Amplitude} = \text{Meter Reading} + \text{Antenna Factor} + \text{Cable Loss} - \text{Amplifier Gain}$$

The “**Margin**” column of the following data tables indicates the degree of compliance with the applicable limit. For example, a margin of 7dB means the emission is 7dB below the limit. The equation for margin calculation is as follows:

$$\text{Margin} = \text{Limit} - \text{Corrected Amplitude}$$

## Test Results Summary

According to the recorded data in following table, the worst margin reading as below:

**4.05 dB at 959.94 MHz in the Horizontal polarization**
