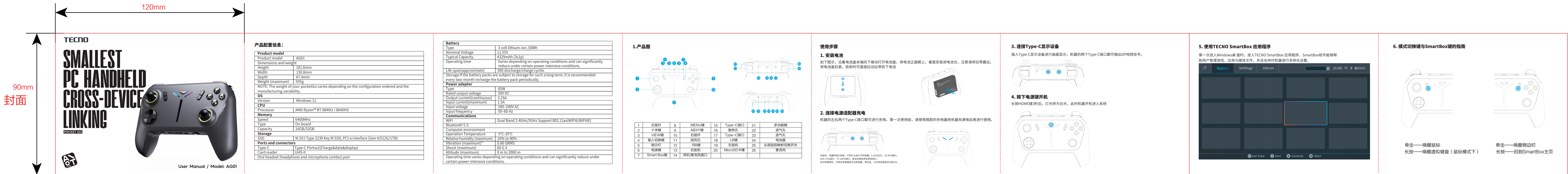

8. 头部追踪
