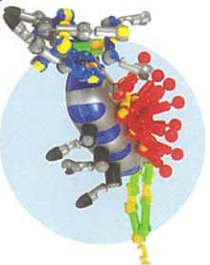
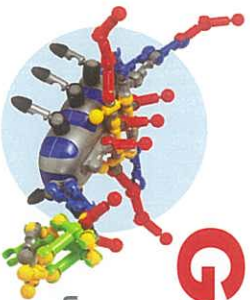

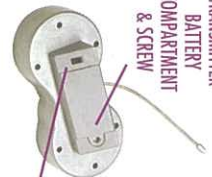

ON/OFF SWITCHES



OPERATING THE MOVER & TRANSMITTER

- Do not operate the Mover more than 30 feet (about 10 meters) from the transmitter, as the signal strength will weaken and it will not function properly.
 - Always operate your Mover in a dry, open area. Do not use in the street. Avoid sand, dirt, and water.
 - Switch both the Mover and the Transmitter to the "On" position. (Remember to turn both switches off when not in use.)
 - The Mover works differently than most other remote control vehicles, using "Tank Drive" style power and steering controls.
- LEFT CONTROL KNOB**
- RIGHT CONTROL KNOB**
- Straight Forward:** Push & hold BOTH knobs to the UP position.
- Straight Backward:** Push & hold BOTH knobs to the DOWN position.
- Rotate Right:** Push & hold LEFT knob UP, RIGHT to the DOWN position.
- Rotate Left:** Push & hold RIGHT knob UP, LEFT to the DOWN position.

CAUTION WHEN USING BATTERIES!

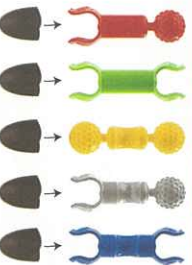
- Replace all batteries at the same time. Do not mix old and new batteries, or batteries of different types. Do not use non-rechargeable batteries with rechargeable batteries, or rechargeable batteries of different capacities.
 - Insert batteries so the + and - marks on batteries match the same marks inside the battery compartments.
 - Remove all batteries from the Mover and transmitter when not in use for extended periods of time. Dispose of used batteries properly, observing all local regulations.

GET THE MOST OUT OF YOUR ZOOBMOVER



- The black rubber feet that are supplied in this set are designed to give the Mover added traction on smooth surfaces. They will fit either the "jaw" or "ball" portions of any ZOOB piece. For best performance on any surface, test drive with and without the rubber feet.



- Alkaline batteries will help your ZOOBmover go faster and farther.
- To create even cooler creations, add more pieces from your other ZOOB sets.

WARNING! AVOID RADIO INTERFERENCE

- Do not operate your R/C vehicle in an area near high-tension wires, telephone poles, high-voltage transformers or CB radios. These send interfering signals that will cause your Mover to run erratically or have a loss of transmitter control.
- Do not operate another Mover or R/C vehicle with the same frequency nearby, this will also cause a loss of control.
- Changes or modifications not expressly approved by the party responsible for compliance could void the user's authority to operate the equipment.

WARNING! USE CARE WITH THIS VEHICLE

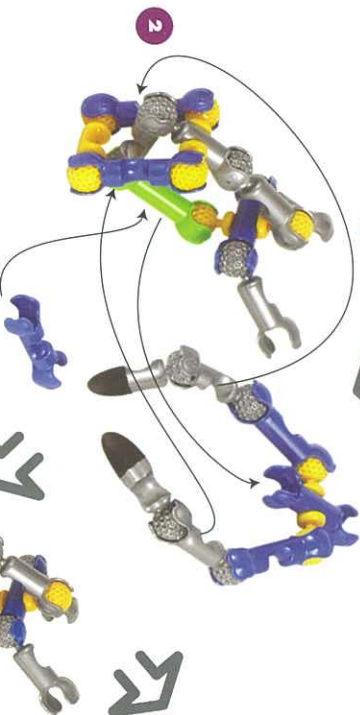
- Do not remove the six black sockets that are attached to your ZOOBmover. Do not attempt to open the Mover housings or alter the electronic components within the Mover or transmitter.
- Use care when operating your Mover—collisions may cause breakage. Use care when connecting ZOOB pieces to the ZOOBmover and removing them, particularly on the leg sockets.

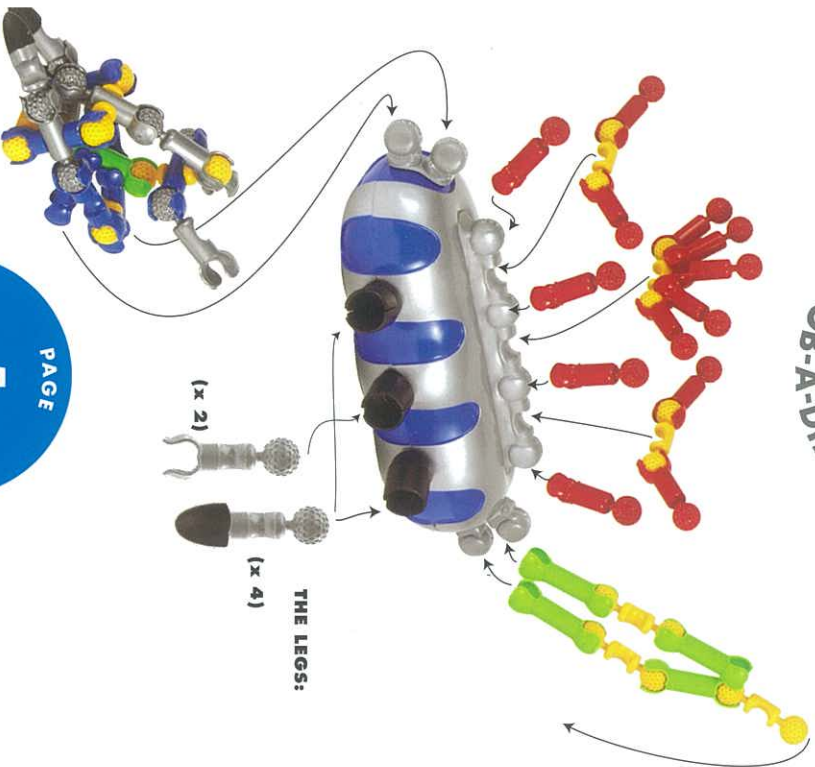
