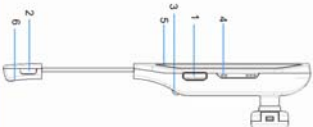


Know your headset

Talking time: 4 hours
Music play time: 4 hours

2. Main button (Answered call/Play/Pause music)

6. Microphone

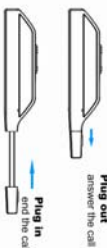


How to control mobile phone take photo

Double press the volume button , then it will take photo directly after open the camera function (but iOS mobile phone are most Android mobile phone support this function, iOS need setting : Camera-setting setting -Volume key set as the camera key)

How to answer the call

1. Answer the call when the call coming , please plug the mic in, then it will answer the call.
End the call: when you wanna finished the call , please plug the mic in, then it will end the call



2. Answer the call when the call coming , please press the main button once
End the call: when you wanna finished the call, please press the main button once

Charging power attention

1. Please use the original charger.
2. Please do not use it when you charging the headset

Volume control

Up/down: press once, the volume go down or up a little
Last track: press up button for three seconds
Next track: press down button for three seconds

Music control

Pairing: blue and red light flash
Turn off: red light flash continuously, then headset report the coming phone number
Charging: Red light is on when charging, it goes out after a full charge, and blue light is on

Use of Multi-functional button:

Tap: Press the button (tap once)
Reject call (tap twice)
Enter pairing mode (press for 5 seconds)
Play/pause songs (tap once)
Manually connect the lost connection (tap once)

Before Using the Bluetooth Headset

Carefully read the instructions, understand the various functions of the headset button , make sure the Bluetooth headset has power, charged before first use at least 1 hour .

Enters Pairing Mode:

1. When first use the headset, turn on and then step onto pairing mode, you can pair the headset with your phone settings now. Once lost connection or you want to pair a new phone, need to press the function key for 5 seconds to enter pairing mode again.
2. Turn off other Bluetooth devices to avoid interference.

How to charge the headset

Please use the AC charger (the original charger) when you charge the headset
When you charging the headset, please do not use the headset

What the Indicator and Voice reminding mean ?

Power on (pairing mode): blue and red light flashing "Power on"
Power off: red light flashing once " Power off"
Call: blue light flashing continual " mobile phone number "
End the call: blue light flashing 5 seconds once, " and the call"
Charging power: after the full charged , the indicator will showed blue light , before is red light

How to use the volume button

Volume + " " : Long press is control last song (music), short press is control volume up
Volume- " " : Long press is control next song (music), short press is control volume down
