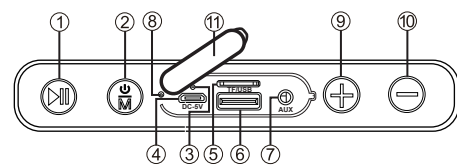
- Reorient or relocate the receiving antenna.

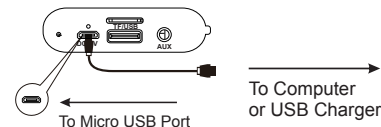


- 1. Play/Pause Button
2. Power On/Off & Mode Selection Button
3. Indicators
4. Micro USB Port (For charging only)
5. TF (Micro SD) Card Slot
6. USB Port
7. AUX (Aux/Line in) Jack
8. Microphone
9. Volume Up Button
10. Volume Down Button
11. Rubber Cover (This cover is to ensure water and dusts protection; always make sure it is completely closed.)

OPERATION:

The unit has a built-in Li-ion rechargeable battery, charge it before first time use or when it is drained as follows:

- 1. Open the Rubber Cover on the unit.
2. Connect the small plug from the supplied USB Connection Cable to the Micro USB Port on the unit.
3. Connect the full size USB Plug from the supplied USB Connection Cable to the USB Port on the Personal Computer or USB Charger (Computer and USB Charger not included).
4. When charging, the Red Charging Indicator on the top of unit will illuminate.
5. When charging is complete, the Red Charging Indicator will turn off.
6. Close the Rubber Cover completely to reduce water and dusts entering.



Notes:

- 1. When charging, you can also play and listen to music at the same time.
2. Your battery will last longer if you following these simple guidelines for caring and storing:

- A. Before first time use, recharge the unit approximately 4 hours until the unit is fully charged.
B. Charge and store the unit within the temperature range of 5°C - 35°C (40°F - 95°F).
C. Do not overcharge (longer than 24 hours). Excessive charging or running the unit until completely flat will damage battery. Battery life will be extended if you keep the battery fully charged.
D. Battery life naturally shortens slowly over time.
E. The rechargeable battery incorporated in this product is not user replaceable.

OPERATION:

General Operation:

- 1. Recharge the built-in Li-ion battery as previously instructed.
2. Press and hold the Power On/Off & Mode Selection Button on the top of unit approximately 1 second to power on the unit. The Blue Indicator and control buttons on the top of unit will illuminate.
3. Press the Play/Pause Button repeatedly to switch to desired playback mode. The unit will sound a prompt with your selection (see list below):

Table with 2 columns: Playback Modes and Voice Prompt. Rows include BT (Bluetooth), AUX (Aux/Line in), USB, and TF (Micro SD) Card.

Note:

If the Audio Connection Cable; TF (Micro SD) Card and/or USB Device have NOT been inserted into the unit, the corresponding selection will not be available.

- 4. During playback:
- Press the Play/Pause Button to pause; press again to resume to normal playback. In AUX (Aux /Line in) mode, press it to mute the sound, press again to turn the sound back on.
- Press and release the + or - buttons repeatedly to adjust volume level as desired.
- Press and hold the + or - buttons repeatedly to skip tracks.
Notes: It will not function in AUX (Aux /Line in) mode.
5. When finished listening, press and hold the Power On/Off & Mode Selection Button approximately 1 second to shut off the unit.

BT Mode:

BT (Bluetooth) pairing:

First time use or re-pairing the unit to a new BT Device, pair as follows:

- 1. Power on the unit and enter to BT mode as previously instructed. You will hear an audible prompt say "Bluetooth ready for connection" and the Blue Indicator on the top of unit will illuminate and blink.
2. Power on the external BT Device and enter to BT search mode. Start pairing following the on screen instructions from the external BT Device. When paired, the unit will sound a prompt "Bluetooth connected" and the Blue Indicator will stop blinking.
3. If pairing is complete you may now play music and answer the phone with your external BT Device.
4. During playback:
- Press the Play/Pause Button on the unit to pause; press again to resume to normal playback.
- Press and release the + or - buttons repeatedly to adjust volume level as desired.
- Press and hold the + or - buttons repeatedly to skip tracks.

BT Mode:

- 4. Power on the unit and enter to AUX mode as previously instructed, you will hear an audible prompt say "Aux in".
5. Play the music on the connected Audio Player as usual. (Make sure the volume level of the connected Audio Player is turned to high level.)
6. During playback:
- Press the Play/Pause Button on the unit to mute the sound, press again to turn the sound back on.
- Press and release the + or - buttons repeatedly to adjust volume level as desired.
7. When finished listening, press and hold the Power On/Off & Mode Selection Button approximately 1 second to shut off the unit.

Notes:

- When the external BT Device searches for the unit, our model number "MMA3762" will appear on the display of external BT Device.
If while pairing you are asked for a code, please try "0000" or "1234".

Normal operation after pairing:

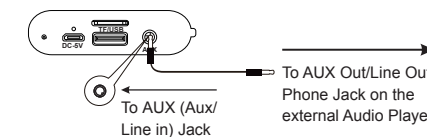
- 1. Power on the external BT Device and enter to BT playback mode.
2. Power on the unit and enter to BT mode as previously instructed. You will hear an audible prompt say "Bluetooth ready for connection" and the Blue Indicator on the top of unit will illuminate and blink.

- 3. Wait a few seconds until the unit is automatically paired to the external BT Device. The unit will sound a prompt "Bluetooth connected" and the Blue Indicator will stop blinking.
4. After pairing is complete you may now play music and answer calls with your external BT Device.

Line In (Aux/Line in):

To listen from an external Audio Player such as MP3 Player, Discman...etc.

- 1. In power off mode, connect one end of the supplied Audio Connection Cable to the AUX Out / Line Out /Phone Jack on the external Audio Player.
2. Open the Rubber Cover on the unit.
3. Connect the other end of the cable to the AUX (Aux/ Line in) Jack as illustrated below:

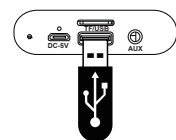


- 4. Power on the unit and enter to AUX mode as previously instructed, you will hear an audible prompt say "Aux in".
5. Play the music on the connected Audio Player as usual. (Make sure the volume level of the connected Audio Player is turned to high level.)
6. During playback:
- Press the Play/Pause Button on the unit to mute the sound, press again to turn the sound back on.
- Press and release the + or - buttons repeatedly to adjust volume level as desired.
7. When finished listening, press and hold the Power On/Off & Mode Selection Button approximately 1 second to shut off the unit.

USB:

To play music in a USB Device:

- 1. In power off mode, open the Rubber Cover on the unit then connect the USB Device (not included) into the USB Port on the unit as illustrated below:

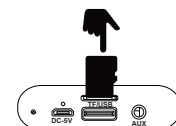


- 2. Power on the unit and enter to USB mode as previously instructed:
- You will hear an audible prompt say "USB".
- Music in the USB Device will be played back.
3. During playback:
- Press the Play/Pause Button on the unit to pause; press again to resume to normal playback.
- Press and release the + or - buttons repeatedly to adjust volume level as desired.
- Press and hold the + or - buttons repeatedly to skip tracks.
4. When finished listening, press and hold the Power On/Off & Mode Selection Button approximately 1 second to shut off the unit.

TF (Micro SD) Card:

To play the music in TF (Micro SD) Card:

- 1. In power off mode, open the Rubber Cover on the unit then insert the TF (Micro SD) Card (not included) into the TF (Micro SD) Card Slot on the unit with contacts facing down as illustrated below:



- 2. Power on the unit and enter to TF (Micro SD) Card mode as previously instructed:
- You will hear an audible prompt say "Memory Card".
- Music in the card will be played back automatically.
3. During playback:
- Press the Play/Pause Button on the unit to pause; press again to resume to normal playback.
- Press and release the + or - buttons repeatedly to adjust volume level as desired.
- Press and hold the + or - buttons repeatedly to skip tracks.
4. When finished listening, press and hold the Power On/Off & Mode Selection Button approximately 1 second to shut off the unit.

Notes:

- Up to 16 GB TF (Micro SD) Card/USB Device supported.
When inserting the TF (Micro SD) Card/USB Device, make sure the direction you selected is correct. Never insert violently to avoid damaging the TF (Micro SD) Card/USB Device or the unit. If it doesn't work, please check if the direction is correct.
Before replacing TF (Micro SD) Card/USB Device, make sure the unit has been powered off.

- You also need to download the desired music in MP3 format into the TF (Micro SD) Card/USB Device before insert into the unit.
