Set up and Connection

1. Connect the 3.5 mm audio cable to the Bluetooth Music Receiver's earphone jack, (optionally, the 3.5mm to RCA adapter can be used if needed) and plug it into the speaker's audio input port.
2. Insert the USB power cable, the indicator light will flash quickly meaning the device is in pairing/discovery mode and is searching for a Bluetooth enabled device.
3. While in the Bluetooth pairing mode, enable the Bluetooth function from Bluetooth enabled devices such as a smartphone, iPhone, iPad, tablet, Bluetooth computer or other devices with Bluetooth functionality.
4. Search the Bluetooth device list and find "BT BOX" and press "connect". If a password is needed the default password is: 0000. After successfully pairing, the blue LED light will flash slowly, which means the Bluetooth Music Receiver has been made successfully.
5. You can now select, play and stream music from the device wirelessly.

You can disconnect the Bluetooth connection by holding down the Center button. The indicator light will quickly flash again, meaning it has returned to discovery mode. To re-establish the connection, press "connect" on the "BT BOX" in your mobile device's Bluetooth list. After leaving and returning back within Bluetooth range the Bluetooth device may automatically reconnect.

Button Functions

You can PLAY/PAUSE the music by quickly pressing and releasing the Center button.
You can select the PREVIOUS TRACK by holding down the PREVIOUS TRACK (-) button.
You can select the NEXT TRACK by holding down the NEXT TRACK (+) button.

Note

1. Please make sure the Music Receiver is plugged in before and during use.
2. Keep the device away from high temperature and damp environments. Place it in a ventilated environment. Do not expose to rain and shock.
3. Do not open the cover of the case to prevent from electrical shock or any other accidents.
4. If any metal part or liquid drops inside it, turn off the power. It can be used only after examination by a professional.
5. For best results, turn off the device and disconnect the power cable when not in use.
