Mobile Phone Bluetooth Receiver




Introduction

With the Stereo Bluetooth Receiver you can control incoming and outgoing calls while you listen to music from your phone or from other device. This device must support Bluetooth. During a call, the music pauses automatically and starts playing again when the call ends.

1	Power On	Answer /reject the phone
2	Backward	Play the previous track(short press)/Adjust the volume(long press)
3	Music Key	Play/Pause the current media file
4	Upward	Play the next track(short press)/Adjust the volume(long press)
5	LED light	
	Flashing red and blue light	Device pairing.
	Blue light rapid flashing	Device connecting.
	Red light flashing 2 times	Low battery.
	Red light	Charging.
	Blue light	Charge completed.
6	Headset Jack	3.5 mm input for wired headphone
7	Clip	Attach the accessory to your clothing.
8	Microphone	Place within range of your voice
9	Micro USB Port	Insert the charger cable to charge the battery.

Noted: Some parts of Bluetooth receiver have magnetic, please don't put it with your credit card or other storage media. Prevent information from being deleted.

Charging the battery

Before using the Stereo Bluetooth receiver for the first time, you need to charge the receiver for approximately 1.5 hours. Strongly recommend to use the cable inside the package.

- 1 Plug the charger into a power outlet.
- 2 Plug one end of the USB cable into the charger (or into the USB port of a computer).
- 3 Plug the other end of the cable into the Micro USB port on your Smartbean Bluetooth Receiver.

Notification light will display the charging status after you turn off the receiver.

To manually pair the Adapter with your phone

- 1 Make sure your phone has the Bluetooth function turned on.
- 2 Receiver: Press and hold until the notification light flashes blue and red.
- 3 Phone: Scan for Bluetooth devices, then select N9 in the available devices list.
- 4 Follow the pairing instructions that appear on your phone. If a passcode is required, enter 0000.

Multipoint technology

Use Multipoint technology to connect your receiver to two Bluetooth devices simultaneously. For example, if you connect your receiver with two phones, you can receive calls from both phones without having to disconnect and reconnect.

Noted: Multipoint mode consumes more battery power than Singlepoint mode.

Imaging there are 2 mobile phones: A and B

- 1 Pairing receiver with A then turns the receiver off
- 2 Pairing receiver with B, Keep the Bluetooth mode on both mobile phones
- 3 Turn receiver off and then put it on pairing status (Blue light flashing). Now receiver connects with both devices.

Call handling

To answer a call with the device with receiver

- When you hear an incoming call signal, press .
- To end a call
- During an ongoing call, press .
- Redialing the Previous call
- Press for around 3 seconds, then it will make a call to previous number you called.

To listen to music

- 1 Plug your headset with receiver and open the media player software of your bluetooth device
- 2 Press to play the music on the receiver. To pause the music, press again.
- To move between tracks
- When you listen to music, press or .
