ENGLISH

Please read the following information carefully to prevent incidents and avoid damaging your device. Any configuration or use other than what is in line with the suggested and intended use is not covered or guaranteed.

PRECAUTIONS

MAINTENANCE

Handle the Montblanc Digital Paper, the Digital Pen and its accessories with care.

DEVICE PROTECTION. We advise you to keep your device and pen in a protective cover like the Montblanc folio, especially during transportation. When dropped, cracked, burnt or bent the device could be damaged due to sensitive electronic components contained within. Only use the USB-C charging cable and accessories enclosed with the device or recommended by Montblanc.

To protect the screen of your Montblanc Digital Paper, ensure you are keeping the tip of the Montblanc Digital Pen clean. Dirt and other small particles can excessively wear down the tip and cause damage to the screen of your device. Please replace the nibs of your pen frequently to avoid scratching the surface of the device.

CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS. Prior to cleaning your Montblanc Digital Paper device and its accessories, ensure you unplug all cables and turn the device off (hold the power button for 4 seconds and tap

'Power off'). Use a slightly damp, soft and lint-free cloth. Refrain from using window cleaners, solvents, aerosol sprays, household cleaners, alcohol, ammonia, or abrasives as they could permanently damage your device. When cleaning, avoid getting moisture into any of the openings.

LEATHER. Leather is a natural material that is sensitive to the effects of light, humidity and water. To keep the leather on your product in perfect condition and prevent the color from fading, protect it from prolonged exposure to high temperatures and direct sunlight. In the event of contact with water, it should be dried promptly with a soft, smooth cloth. To maintain its natural softness, Montblanc recommends treating your leather product with a neutral leather care product.

HANDLING

Do not drop, bend, or puncture your device and digital pen; do not insert foreign objects into or place heavy objects on your device and digital pen; do not subject your device and digital pen to shock or vibration. Sensitive components inside might become damaged.

DIGITAL PEN. Your Montblanc Digital Pen is compatible with a variety of pen-enabled devices, syncing with Wacom Active ES Protocol (AES 2.1), Microsoft Pen Protocol (MPP 2.0), Universal Stylus Initiative Protocol (USI 2.0) and Wacom Generic Protocol (WGP). Please inform yourself about the compatibility with the device manufacturer.

Write with the Montblanc Pen as if you are writing with a pen on paper. Ensure you do not let your pen rest on the tip and do not apply excessive pressure during writing to protect its sensitivity.

Ensure you always keep your Montblanc Digital Pen charged by attaching it to the Montblanc Digital Paper device when not in use. Ensure that the Montblanc Digital Paper device is charged frequently and is not running out of battery. A permanent discharge of the Montblanc Digital Pen or device may damage the battery.

CONTACT WITH LIQUIDS. Don't use the Montblanc Digital Paper device or its accessories in the rain or near other wet locations, as it contains electrical components that can be damaged if it comes in contact with liquid. If your device gets wet, unplug all cables and let the device dry completely before turning it on by pressing the power button. Do not attempt to dry your Montblanc Digital Paper device or pen with an external heat source, such as a microwave oven or hairdryer.

DAMAGE OR ALTERATIONS. Do not make any changes to the device, pen, USB-C cable or accessories yourself. Any change will result in the loss of the warranty and possibly create a danger for you and your environment. For service and maintenance, contact a Montblanc Boutique or an authorized Montblanc Retailer.

Refrain from using the Montblanc Digital Paper device, pen or charging cable if they are not working properly or have been damaged.

OPERATING TEMPERATURE. Do not subject the device and pen to high pressure or place it near or in a high temperature location or heat source (e.g., sun, fire, microwave, heating, stove, sauna or steam room). Turn off the device in potentially explosive environments.

The device and pen can be used in locations with an ambient temperature of 0 °C to 40 °C (32 °F to 104 °F). You can store the device and pen at an ambient temperature of -10 °C to 55 °C (14 °F to 131 °F) and -20 °C to 50 °C (-4 °F to 122 °F) respectively. Using or storing the Montblanc Digital Paper device outside the recommended temperature ranges may damage the device.

WARNINGS

HEALTH

PHYSICAL DISCOMFORT. Repetitive motions such as pressing keys or writing over a prolonged time may result in occasional discomfort in hands, arms, shoulders, neck, or other parts of your body. In case of headaches, blackouts, seizures, convulsion, eye or muscle twitching, loss of awareness, involuntary movement, disorientation, or other discomfort, discontinue using your device or the pen and consult a physician. Ensure you avoid prolonged use, maintain some distance between the device and your eyes, use your device in a well-lit room and take frequent breaks to reduce any associated risks. Find a comfortable position for the pen in your hand, ensure you are switching positions frequently and take sufficient breaks.

PROLONGED HEAT EXPOSURE. Montblanc Digital Paper and pen are compliant with applicable regulations and safety standards on surface temperatures. Nonetheless, contact with the device when connected to a power source can cause discomfort or injury. Avoid prolonged skin contact and refrain from sitting or sleeping on the device and charging cable.

INTERFERENCE WITH OTHER ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT. Although the device is designed, tested, and manufactured to comply with regulations governing radio frequency emissions in the U.S., the wireless transmitters and electrical circuits in the **Montblanc Digital Paper** Device and Montblanc Digital Pen may cause interference in other electronic equipment.

Please follow the advice below to limit the risks of radio-frequency interference:

- Consult a doctor prior to use if you have a pacemaker or other internal electronic device and, more generally, if you have a heart or other medical condition.
- Keep the device and charger at least 6 inches (15 cm) away from any implantable medical device (e.g., pacemaker, defibrillator, or other medical device).
- If there is any reason to suspect interference, turn off the device immediately.

If this equipment does cause harmful interference to radio or television reception, which can be determined by turning the equipment off and on, the user is encouraged to try to correct the interference by one or more of the following measures:

- Reorient or relocate the receiving antenna.
- Increase the separation between the equipment and receiver.
- Connect the equipment into an outlet on a circuit different from that to which the receiver is connected.
- Consult the dealer or an experienced radio/TV technician for help.

HIGH-CONSEQUENCE ACTIVITIES. The device is not intended for use in activities or situations where the failure of the device could lead to serious injuries or death. Exercise caution when using the device while walking or moving. Pay attention to your surroundings to avoid injury to yourself or others.

DISTRACTION. It is not recommended, and may in some areas even be prohibited or restricted, to use your device while operating a vehicle. If operation in vehicles is permitted, ensure you always give full attention to the operation of the vehicle. Generally, stop using your device if it becomes a distraction.

Follow the guidelines for communication devices provided by officials when travelling in airplanes or in locations where their usage is banned. Observe local guidelines and laws for mobile and communication devices (e.g. while driving).

CHARGING

Do not touch your device with wet hands while charging. Doing so may cause electric shock. While charging, keep the device away from highly humid environments, high pressure or water. Once the device is fully charged, do not leave it plugged in if it is not in use.

Your device may become warm while charging. If you notice your device becoming uncomfortably hot while or after charging, remove the device from the USB-C cable and wait until it cools down before use or continued charging.

HANDLING OF ACCESSORIES. Handle the USB-C cable with care. Do not place objects on the USB-C cable, bend it sharply, or apply heavy stress. Keep the cable away from liquids. Do not use the cable if it is damaged. Damage to the USB-C cable may result in malfunction, electric shock or fire.

Prevent the USB-C cable from contact with conductive materials, such as liquids, dust, metal powders, and pencil leads.

QUALIFIED ACCESSORIES. Only use Montblanc approved accessories (e.g., charging cable). Make sure to plug the charging cable into an outlet with a controlled output voltage of DC 5 Volt and a maximum output current of 2 Ampere.

Do not force a charging cable into a port, because this may cause damage to the device.

BATTERY

BATTERY DAMAGE. If you notice an unusual smell coming from your Montblanc Digital Paper device, Montblanc Digital Pen or the battery, or if you see smoke or liquids leaking from the device or battery, stop using the device immediately and take it to a Montblanc boutique or authorized Montblanc dealer.

Never use a device, pen or charging cable that is damaged in any way.

Do not handle a damaged or leaking Lithium Ion (Li-Ion) battery. For safe disposal of your Li-Ion battery, contact your Montblanc boutique or authorized Montblanc dealer.

LOW AIR PRESSURE WARNING. If the device or the pen with the battery is subjected to extremely low air pressure, it may result in an explosion or the leakage of flammable liquid or gas.
