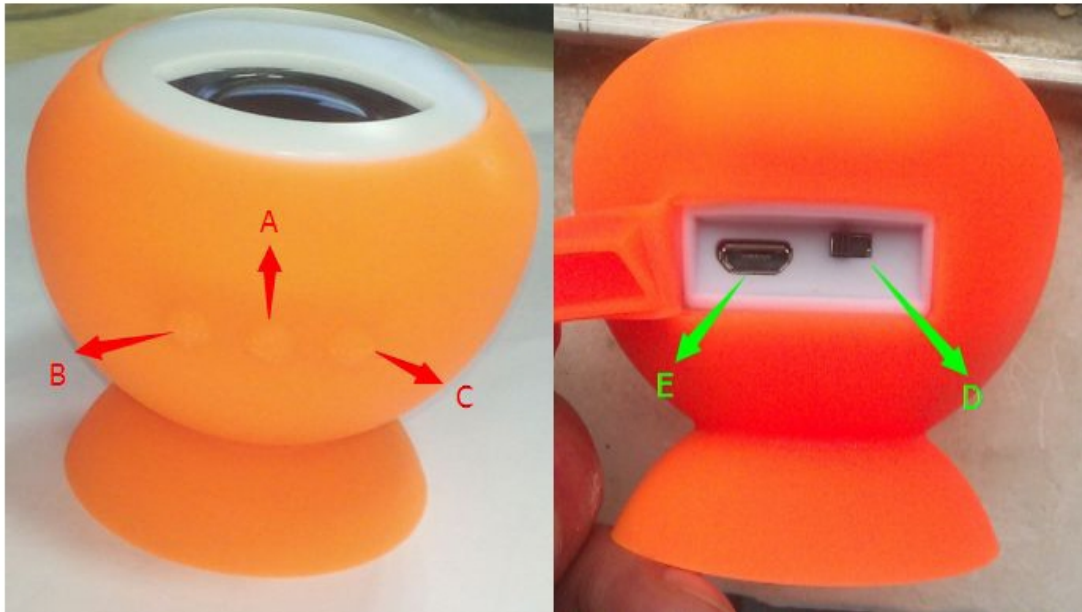
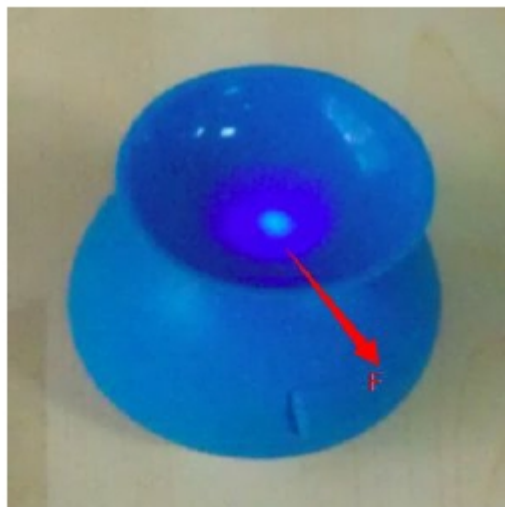

How to use:

D for the power ON-OFF, It's on when the switch turn to left and the Bluetooth Mode is ready to pair, indicating lamp is bright with the slow flicker to fast flicker, the light will keep bright when the advice remind success paired ; (Note: Please connect the equipment manually, once the advice is connected successfully the advice will connect automatically the next time.

A short press A to open the built-in player when the advice is paired, another press to A for the pause. Continuous double press to A for the call back function(the last call number), the short press for answering, the long short for refusing, the short press during communicating for hungup. B for the volume reduction / next song, The advice is in the Bluetooth state for default mode, long press for volume up, and the short press for the next song.

C for the volume reduction / last song, The advice is in the Bluetooth state for default mode, long press for Volume down, and the short press for the last song.

D as the power switch, the left is ON and right for OFF. E is Micro charging interface for external 5V adapter, the light on the button keep bright.

F is the indicator light for the Bluetooth and charging state.
