



Justification of Labelling

FCC ID: 2AERJ-OR-01

Model Name: Omni-R

The label exhibit of the FCC filing showed the location of the label on the inside of the battery cover.

According to section 4 in KDB 784748 D01, as an option to placing the FCC label on the exterior of the device, the FCC label may be placed in a user accessible area if the following conditions are met:

Requirement from KDB 784748 D01	Justification
The device is handheld (notebook computers are considered as handheld);	The Omni-R is considered a handheld device.
The FCC identifier is visible at the time of purchase. Marketing the device without the battery installed when the label is in the battery compartment is acceptable. The FCC ID on the box, or additional documentation directing the user where to find the FCC label, also satisfies this requirement;	The included User's Guide (under the FCC section) directs the user where the FCC label is located and satisfies this requirement. Also, the Omni-R will be marketed without batteries installed, which also satisfies this requirement.
The user accessible area must not require any special tools for access, and the FCC label must not be placed on a removable part;	The battery cover where the label is affixed to is a functional panel that provides a seal against water ingress and must be installed on the Omni-R for proper function of the system in all specified environments; therefore, it is not considered a "removable" part. The battery cover is removed using a standard screwdriver or other flat object which is not considered a special tool.
The FCC ID, Model Number, or FCC logo must be on the label and must meet all general labeling requirements or policies that apply for Certification, Verification or DoC.	The label meets all general labeling requirements.
