Device Guide



Device Safety

- Your True Wireless Earbuds have internal rechargeable batteries. Improper usage may result in the Earbuds becoming hot, ignite or burst and cause injury if exposed to conditions of abuse.
- Do not disassemble, throw away or damage the True Wireless Earbuds.
- Store the True Wireless Earbuds in a dry place, keeping them away from damp corrosive materials and environments such as salt air.
- Keep the True Wireless Earbuds away from direct sunlight, fire and high voltage equipment. Do not store the True Wireless Earbuds inside a car during hot weather. Remember a closed car acts as a green house allowing the inside to reach high temperatures.
- The True Wireless Earbuds are not a toy. Please keep them out of the reach of young children.
- Please do not discard the True Wireless Earbuds. Consult your local waste collection agency for proper disposal or recycling methods. You may also contact "Call2Recycle" at 877-273-2925 or online at "call2recycle.org" for a battery recycling drop off location near you.



Charging the earbuds

- Please plug the earbuds into the charging case, then turn on the charging case, the charging case indicator will be solid blue and the earbud indicator will be solid red during charging.
- When the battery of earbuds is fully charged, both indicators of the earbuds and the charging case will turn off.

Charging the charging case

- Please plug the charger cable into the charging case.
- Connect the charger to a USB power source, the charging case indicator will flash red during charging. If charging does not start, disconnect the charger plug it in again, and retry. Charging the batteries fully may take hours.
- When the battery of the charging case is fully charged, the red indicator light will be solid. Disconnect the charger from the USB power source and the charging case.

Pairing One Earbud

- Long press the multifunction button on the chosen earbud until the indicator flashes blue and red.
- Activate the Bluetooth™ feature on your phone, and set the phone to search for wireless devices. (See the User Manual for your device)
- Tap the Earbuds on your device displayed as BB-BT-EB and the indicator turns off. (if pass code is requested enter 0000)

Pairing Two Earbuds

- Long press 2-3 seconds the multifunction button on both of the earbuds to power on then two earbuds will paired automatically in 8-15 second. If two earbud paired, LED indicator of the master will blink blue and red, LED indicator of the other one(slave)will turn off.
 - Activate the Bluetooth™ feature on your device, and set the device to discovery mode to search for wireless devices. (See the User Manual for your device)
 - Tap the Earbuds on your device displayed as BB-BT-EB, then led indicator of the master will turn off, the earbuds are connected to your device successfully. (if pass code is requested enter 0000)
- * Once the Earbuds have been paired, they will automatically pair with each other and your device, when they are powered on and Bluetooth™ is already activated on your device.

Playing Music

- Once the Earbuds are paired, press play on your device.
- Short press the Multifunction button to pause music, and press again to play.

Answering Calls

- Answer an incoming call by short pressing the Multifunction button on either side.
- Refuse an incoming call by press 2 seconds on the Multifunction button.
- Redial the last number used by the device by double-clicking the Multifunction button during earbuds paired with the device.
- When there is a phone call, you can just hear the ringing from the master of the earbuds, either side multifunction button can answer/ hang up/ change answer mode/reject the phone call.

Power Off

- Press the Multifunction button on either side until the LED flashes red.
- When there is not paired, the earbuds will turn off automatically after 5 minutes.

Battery Information

Your earbuds are powered by a rechargeable batteries. The full performance of new batteries is achieved only after two to three complete charge and discharge cycles. The batteries can be charged and discharged hundreds of times, but it will eventually wear out.

- Do not leave a fully charged earbuds connected to a charger, overcharging may shorten their lifetime. If left unused, fully charged earbud batteries will lose their charge over time.
- Never use any charger that is damaged.
- Leaving the device in hot or cold places will reduce the capacity and lifetime of the batteries. Optimal temperature for the batteries is between 59°F and 77°F. A device with a hot or cold batteries may not work temporarily, even when the batteries are fully charged.
- Do not dispose of batteries in a fire as they may explode. Batteries may also explode if damaged. Always dispose of batteries according to local regulations. Please recycle. Do not dispose as household waste.
