




### How to use?


- Press the on/off button to turn on the unit .LED turn "Blue"

- Charge your Mirror Dongle only by wall charger provided.






Use for connecting smartphone (with Screen mirroring function) to Nuvu NV5 or NV6 screening mirroring device


A. For NV6
