1. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Read the instructions carefully before using the product.

1.1. STRAIGHTEN HAZARD: Helioball has STRAILED in China. Keep this sound out of the reach of children more than 36" (91.5 cm) above. Never use extension cords with AC Adapters. Only use the power adapter supplied with the product.

1.2. Choking hazard: This product contains small parts, please be careful when unpacking and use.

Read and keep to instructions. All the safety and operating instructions should be read carefully before using the product. The product cannot replace responsible adult supervision.

1.3. Fire hazard: **Caution:** This product is designed for indoor use only. The unit should not be exposed to rain, moisture, dripping or splashing. No objects filled with liquid should be placed on the product. Do not use the product outdoors. Do not use the product near water.

1.4. Electrical safety: The appliance is of the class II or class III. If your baby monitor is not working properly, do not touch any part of the appliance. If you have any electrical problem, do not touch any part of the appliance or do not plug in the power cord. Do not use the product if you are suffering any damage to product. Contact "Helioball" service center to get the replacement or repair of the appliance in order to avoid any possible risk.

1.5. Do not touch the product: Do not touch the product with your hands or other objects to avoid any risk. Otherwise, the guarantee will be placed in void.

1.6. Do not touch the product: Do not touch the product with your hands, soft, rough or similar surface may block the ventilation opening, or be placed in an enclosed area such as a bookcase or under a bed.

Keep away from sources of heat: This unit should not be exposed to direct heat sources such as fire, candles, heaters, or other appliances that emit heat. The unit should not be left in direct sunlight.

1.7. Do not touch the product: Do not use with the AC power adapters included in this package (rated 5V 1A). Do not use with other power adapters.

1.8. Do not touch the product: This unit should be serviced by qualified personnel only. The product is not designed for repair.

The unit does not appear to operate normally or exhibits a distinct change in performance when the unit is being triggered on the enclosure dashboard.

The units have been dropped on the enclosure dashboard.

2. WARRANTY TERMS

We offer one year warranty from the original purchase date against defects in workmanship and materials. If you have any warranty or support issues, please contact our after sales team via email.

3. INSTALLATION GUIDELINES

1. The unit should be mounted on a surface where you have to establish a radio link between them, and the range will be affected by environmental conditions. The units should be placed in a clear line of sight, without any obstruction, reinforced concrete between the baby and parent unit will block the radio signal.

2. The signal strength may also be reduced by other solid structures, like walls, or by radio frequency interference from other electronic devices, like mobile phones. Frequent flights of domestic satellites.

3. The units are not compatible with wireless networks (Wi-Fi routers), Bluetooth, smartphones, or microwave ovens, may cause interference with this product, so keep the baby monitor away at least 15.2cm from such products, or turn them off if they cause interference.

4. PLACEMENT OF THE BABY MONITOR

1. The baby unit should be mounted on the wall. Don't place baby unit on soft objects like cot or the corners of cupboards, shelves, etc. Keep the baby unit away from the parent unit. The parent unit should be placed in a clear line of sight away from TV sets, microwave ovens and radios. If interference occurs, move the camera a few inches.

2. The unit should be within 6 feet (2 meters) of the area being monitored for optimum performance.

5. GETTING STARTED

TURN ON THE BABY UNIT

1. Insert the DC plug of the power adapter into the DC Jack in the rear of the Baby Unit;

2. Plug the power adapter into a standard wall electrical outlet;

3. Once the adapter is connected, the power LED will light up;

TURN ON THE PARENT UNIT

1. Insert the DC plug of the power adapter into the DC Jack in the side of the parent unit;

2. Plug the power adapter into a standard wall electrical outlet;

3. Press and hold the power key 3 seconds on the top of the parent unit;

4. Once parent unit is on, the power LED will light up and the image will display on the LCD.

5. INFRARED NIGHT VISION (AUTOMATIC)

The infrared night vision function allows the camera to pick up images in dark or low light conditions. In this mode, only black and white images will be displayed on the monitor. The optimum viewing angle is when the subject will be in 2m away from object. The camera in night vision mode, the IR LED will be displayed on the top of screen.

3. BABY UNIT OVERVIEW:

The baby unit consists of the following parts:

7. KEY OPERATION

7.1 TURN ON/OFF

Press and hold the power  for 3 seconds to turn on / off the parent unit.

7.2 UP & DOWN KEYS

Press once to call the camera up by one step. Press and hold to call it continuously.

Press once to call the camera down by one step. Press and hold to call it continuously.

7.3 RIGHT + KEY

Press once to pan the camera right by one step. Press and hold to pan continuously.

7.4 CAMERA VIEWSCAN

Press once to scan the camera's camera; during scan mode, the scan icon  will be displayed on the top of the screen. After second's view will be displayed on the LCD screen and 10 seconds time change to next camera.

7.5 DIGITAL ZOOM

Press and hold the  key 4 seconds to operate zoom in / out.

7.6 Two Way Talk

Press and hold the  key to enter two way talk mode. A microphone icon  will be displayed on the top of the LCD screen. Release the key to stop.

Note: When in the two-way talk mode, the parent unit speaker is muted.

8. MENU OPERATION

8.1 PAIRING THE CAMERA AND PARENT UNITS

The baby unit is pre-paired to your parent unit. You do not need to register it again until the baby unit loses its link with the parent unit. To re-register your camera, or register

New baby unit, follow the procedure below:

Note: Camera icon with  means it is well registered. You should select and pair with the camera without any delay.

1.1.1 ADD CAMERA

- Press the **MEH** () key when the menu will pop-up.
- Press the **1** () / **A** / **▼** key until the camera icon () is selected by red box.
- Press the **1** () / **A** / **▼** key to enter into sub-menu.
- Press the **MEH** () key to select the camera you want to add.
