

User Manual



Power ON/OFF: (Every time the key is removed, the other parameters are removed from time to time)



Color Select: Choose the color, red and green versions have changong, green, red and green three optional; three optional red and blue version of red, blue, red and blue; green version of a single green, blue, green, blue three optional.



Flash Mode: Flashing switch



Timer Reset: Timing reset button, the button cancel timing settings (red, green, red, blue and red light flashes 3 tips; blue for Blu ray scintillation prompted three times)



Flash Speed -: Flashing speed slows down buttons



Flash Speed +: Flashing speed up down buttons



2 hours: Time 2 hours, Laser light flashes 1 times



4 hours: Time 2 hours, Laser light flashes 2 times



6 hours: Time 2 hours, Laser light flashes 3 times



8 hours: Time 2 hours, Laser light flashes 4 times
