To Whom It May Concern:

This letter is to ascertain that Tintag Electronics , Product Tintag (charger), has been the units used for conducting FCC compliance testing, and it meets KDB 680106 Clause 5(2) all 6 conditions as stated below hence PBA is not required.

1	Power transfer frequency is less than 1 MHz
2	Output power from each primary coil is less than 5 watts
3	The transfer system includes only single primary and secondary coils. This includes charging systems that may have multiple primary coils and clients that are able to detect and allow coupling only between individual pairs of coils
4	Client device is inserted in or placed directly in contact with the transmitter
5	The maximum coupling surface area of the transmit (charging) device is between 60 cm ² and 400 cm ² .
6	Aggregate leakage fields at 10 cm surrounding the device from all simultaneous transmitting coils are demonstrated to be less than 30% of the MPE limit.
