5 Do not use the product in a hazardous location.



Turning ON/OFF & Pairing

To turn ON

The TrueBuds will be turn on when they are removed from the charging case. If not press and touch both TrueBuds for 3 seconds.

To turn OFF

Place TrueBuds back into the charging case and close the top. You can also press and touch the TrueBuds for 5 seconds to power them off.

To Pair TrueBuds

When you remove the TrueBuds from the charging case they will automatically pair to each other and you will hear a voice prompt "Connected". Now they are ready to be paired with your device.

Charging

Place the TrueBuds into the charging case and use the supplied charging cable in order to start charging. Plug the Type-C end into the charging port on the case and plug the USB into a PC or wall adapter to start charging.

While charging the charging case's LED light will flash red. Once it is fully charged the LED light will turn red.

When charging the TrueBuds the LED light will turn red and the LED will power off once fully charged.

***Before initial use it is recommended to charge TrueBuds for a minimum of 3 hours.**

Low Battery

When battery level is low you will hear a prompt through the earbuds every 30 seconds and the indicator light will flash red every 5 seconds.


TrueBud Touch Functions

Function	Command
Play/Pause	Short Press
Increase Volume	Triple press RIGHT earbuds
Decrease Volume	Triple press LEFT earbuds
Next Song	Double press RIGHT earbuds
Last Song	Double press LEFT earbuds
Receive Incoming Call	Short Press
Hang Up	Short Press
Reject a call	Long Press for 2 Seconds

You can also use your smart device to control the volume of your TrueBuds
