



- 1. Power Button: Long-click the button for till 3 seconds, into system interface. In sleeping status, short click the button, will start into system.
- 2. Camera

- 6. Remote control signal sensor: Do not block IR receiver, so that you can use the remote control properly.
- 7. L/R output: to connect audio device like speakers
- 8. TF card slot: for TF card (the device can play the multi-media files in the TF card)
- 9. HDMI port: To connect TV for HDMI output
- 10. Reset: Press it, the system will be reset.
- 11. USB port: to connect keyboard, mouse, U-disk or the other storage device.
- 12. DC-in jack: to connect adaptor.

### Before connecting


- 1. Ensure that the device and other external equipments to be connected are switched off before commencing connection.

## Connecting external device.


The device comes equipped with a HDMI output jack and audio output jack. Use this feature to connect the device signal to TV external equipment.

- 2. Use the HDMI cable to connect the device HDMI output jack to output signals.



## **QUICK GUIDE**

### **POWER SUPPLY**

Plug one end of the power adaptor into the unit DC socket, and the other end of the power adaptor to the power source. Then press the power button you can start to use this device. TURNING ON/OFF device

- Power on: Plug the power adapter to the power source, and then connect the power adapter to the power socket of your Sound PAD System. Then undo the button. The system runs, the starting logo appears and then the Home screen displays.
- Power off: long press, Disconnect the power source and the unit will turn off or use the remote control Power key.
- When the system is running, Short time press the power button on the remote control to standby, press the button again to wake it up.

# **DETAILS OF OPERATION**

### 1. CONNECT TO TV

Use HDMI cable to connect Sound PAD System and TV. If you need adjust HDMI output, please into **SETUP** menu select the **HDMI MODE** from "**Screen**", choose the right resolution you want and save it.




### 2.WIFI CONNECTION

If there is WIFI signal environment, enter into **SETUP** menu to configure WIFI connection. will show on menu bar when the WIFI links successfully.



### 3.PORTABLE HOTSPOT

As following to set: go to "set up", choose "more" –"portable hotspots"-"portable WI-FI hotspot" and choose it, and now you already start this function. After it successfully set up, the icon on bottom right of menu bar will show . Furthermore, you can name it and give it a password, please kindly refer to below pictures to your guide.







### 4.BROWSER

### 1) Website

When link to internet, Click **BROWSER** on homepage to surf web now. You can use wireless keyboard, Mouse or remote control for operation, like the way of computer, you need to input the website by the virtual keyboard (you can hide the virtual keyboard by click the right key of the mouse)

Press or the button of the remote control to go back to previous menu. Press from the remote control to go back to the main interface.

## 2) Save the pictures from the website

Long press the screen until there is "select menu" coming out, and choose "save" to your memory card. Normally, it saves under local disk/down load, details please refer to below pictures.



### 3) Set up of website review

When you are surfing the website, you can click the III in the up corner, and it will comes up with set up menu, you can choose the preferred option for internet as below



Choose "set up", it will shows the regular menu, choose "set up main page", and then input the website you want to be for main page, and press confirm as below,





### 5. Application

This Sound PAD System comes with our own customized UI, and the end users can classify all of the applications and put them in the right category. It includes Music ,Video and Local media.

1) How to classify the application(add or delete) Go to the main interface, and choose the category by your remote control or your mouse, and there will be "add application" shows up, click it, it will come up all of the application installed in your Smart Home Entertainment System, as below:



Choose the ones you want to add or delete, and choose by mark  $\checkmark$ , press submit to finish.

2) Check all of the installed application: go to the main interface, press the mark of in the right-down corner to go to the application interface, you can choose any one of them of press the OK key of the remote control or the right key of the mouse, and start it.



Shut down the application, press the button of in the left-down corner, all of the used application will show up, click the left button of the mouse and remove it to shut down the application.

### **6.FILE MANAGEMENT**

Click **FILE Manager** to enter into file management interface. The INTERNAL FLASH/SD CARD/USB/ SATA /UPNP/NETWORK PLACES will display on screen. Selection you want a memory card use remote control or mouse to click the item for this interface.



Under the submenu mode, you can edit these files.

Note: Do not attempt to edit the system files, May damage the system from working

- System files: saved under internal flash/Android.
- APK files: saved under internal flash/ subdirectory. E.g. Karaoke Apps: internal flash/audiocnkalaok
- Files downloaded from the internet: saved under internal flash/download







### 8. MUSIC PLAYER

Use remote control or mouse to click the icon on the Home screen, then the Music library screen opens, with tabs that you can click to view your music library organized by Artists, Albums, Songs, Play lists or now playing. Press the button of on the left-down corner for more options.





In the music interface, press the different button for different operations as below,



- Press for pause
- Press to resume playback.
- Press | to skip to the next track in the album, play list, or shuffle.
- Press I to skip to the previous track in the album, play list, or shuffle.
- Press it to start balance gear menu

- Press is to play the current play list in shuffle mode (tracks are played in random order).
- Press is to toggle repeat mode

When you are operating the other application, you can always check the current playing music or go back to the music interface by clicking the lin the down corner of the screen.

### 9. PICTURES VIEWER



### 10. SETTINGS

Use remote control or mouse to click the icon so on your Home screen. The following settings are available for configuration:





[WI-FI]: click on to scan WIFI signal or click off to turn off WIFI

【Ethernet】Click on/off for related options

[Data usage]: Display the data usage cycle of installed apps.

[More]: to set up VPN/Portable Hotspot/Mobile Networks/PPPoE

[Sound] Display sound input and output devices.

【Display】:In this item you can set the Animation, Display Interface, HDMI Mode and Screen Scale settings.

【HDMI】: to set up the output screen.

【Screen shotsetting】 to set up the screen shotsetting.

【Storage】:View the memory cards storage status.

【Battery】:View the battery status.

[Apps]: Application management.

[Security]: to set up the security for all of the out coming un-known application.

[Language & input] :Setting the Language and keyboard or input method.

【Backup & reset】:Setting the Back up my data, Automatic restore and Factory data reset.

【Accounts】: Setting the sync to Background data sync or Auto-sync and manage the accounts.

【Date & time】:Setting the date and time

[Accessibility]: related accessibility option (suggest not to use);

[Developer options]: Related data of developer (suggest not to change);

[About device]: View the device information.

### 11. USING TF CARD & USB DEVICE

You can safely insert the TF card and USB device into your sound Pad system any time when the unit is on or off by gently slide the card into the TF card slot or USB slot. "Preparing SD card or Preparing USB Mass storage" will be displayed on the status bar for one second, and it will disappeared as soon as the TF card or the USB device is connected.

(Suggest you to remove the TF card or the USB device when the System is under the status of power off, otherwise, it will damage the TF card or the USB device.)

### **12. OTHER**

You can download files and even applications from web pages. The files that you download are stored on your SD card.

**WARNING:** Applications downloaded from the web can be from unknown sources. To protect your Smart home entertainment system and personal data, download applications only from trusted sources, such as Android Market.

## **TROUBLING SHOOTING**

- 1. No signal on the HDTV
- Check if the HDMI cable is securely connected.
- Check if you have selected the correct HDMI input on your HDTV.
- 2. Cannot turn on your SoundPAD System..
- Check if the power connector has completely plugged into the DC socket of your Smart Home Entertainment System
- Check if the power supply is right (18V, 2A).
- 3. Cannot connect to network
- Make sure the network cable is securely connected and the Ethernet works well.
- Make sure Wi-Fi network is connected and the security key for the encrypted network is correct.
- Make sure you select the correct IP address settings.
- 4. Remote control does not respond.
- Make sure the batteries are good
- 5. Some HDTVs cannot display the entire picture.
- SETUP you're the HDTVs display of automatism
- 6. HDMI cannot the signal output
- Make sure that your TV is under the status of HDMI input.
- Unplug the HDMI cable, and connect it again.

### 7. No audio output or the volume is low

- Check if the out coming speakers or the amplifiers work properly.
- Check the volume status of your Smart Home Entertainment System
- Check if the AV cables are connected well.
- Check if your Smart Home Entertainment System is under the status of mute.
- 8. Can't download Video/audio/pictures etc., and shows "SD card is full"
- Please go to Explorer/internal Flash/download to delete the files for more space. Or you
  can go to setting/storage to erase storage to clear all of the files, and you need to restart
  the Device
