

User's manual

Package Includes

- 1 Bluetooth speaker
- 2 USB to Micro USB cable

Features

- Durable, shock and weather-resistant silicone wrap
- On-board playback and volume controls
- Auxiliary input to connect speaker with non-Bluetooth devices

Charge it

- Plug the micro USB cable into the micro USB port under the silicone cover on the bottom right corner of the speaker, and connect the other end of cable to either a computer USB port or to a USB-compatible car or wall charger.
- A solid red LED light will appear through the grill on the back of the speaker to indicate when the JBT-608 is charging, even while speaker is turned off.
- When charging is complete, the red LED light will turn off.
- Charging time is approximately 2 hours

Pair & Connect with a New Device

- Power on the JBT-608 speaker (refer to the "Turn it on" section)
- The JBT-608 will emit a tone, and then LED light on the back of the speaker will begin to flash blue as it tries to reconnect with a previous device. If it cannot reconnect, the LED light will begin to quickly flash blue to indicate that the speaker is now ready to be paired with a new device.
- On your Bluetooth enabled smartphone, tablet or media player, navigate to the Bluetooth setting menu, turn on the Bluetooth feature, and search for a new device.
- After a few seconds you will see "JBT-608" listed
- Tap this model to select it. The LED will turn a solid blue. You are now paired, connected and ready to play.

Power On/Off

- Press & hold the bottom of the Bluetooth switch for 3-5 seconds to turn on the speaker.
- The JBT-608 will emit a tone, and the LED light at the bottom of the speaker has fast flashing blue light to indicate that the speaker is being searched and powered on. When the LED light at the bottom of the speaker has a long bright blue light that indicates it has been paired and connected Bluetooth. The LED light at the bottom of the speaker has slow flashing blue light to indicate Bluetooth is being played.
- Press the Bluetooth switch shortly, the blue light is bright longly, this state is pause playback.
- Press the LED switch shortly, turn on the lights and change the light.
- Charging at DC 5V, charging red light bright longly. When fully charged, the red light changes to blue light.

- When the voltage below 3.5V, it will automatically turn off Bluetooth play.
- To turn the JBT-608 speaker off, press &hold the Bluetooth switch again for 3-5seconds.The speaker will emit a tone to indicate that the JBT-608 is now powering off.

Reconnect to Bluetooth

- You only need to pair your Bluetooth device with the JBT-608 once.
- With your previously paired device's Bluetooth turned on and in range, power on the JBT-608.
- The speaker will automatically reconnect to the last Bluetooth device it was connected to.
- If you have a previously paired device that does not auto-reconnect, navigate to the Bluetooth settings menu on your device, turn on the Bluetooth feature, and select "JBT-608" from your list of paired Bluetooth devices.

Play

- Open your favorite music app and press play.
- You can control the music ,volume ,and tracks from your device, as well as control the playback and volume from the speaker: Volume on your device and on the speaker are controlled separately.
- Speaker will emit a tone when the maximum or minimum volume on the speaker has been reached. If volume is still too low, you can also adjust the volume on your device.
- All audio, including music, games, videos, and notifications will be routed through the JBT-608.
