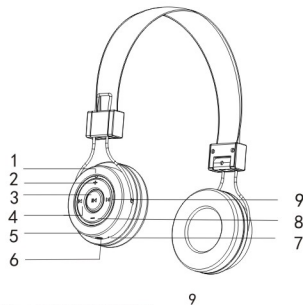

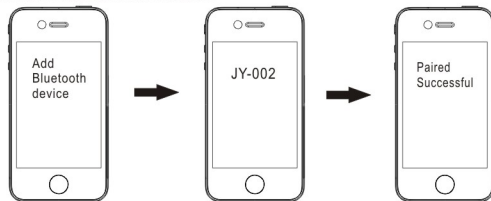
Double tap



Turn on/ off	Press  until blue light on/ red light off
Play/ pause	Press
Stop	Double tap
The next/previous	Press  /
Adjust volume	Hold  /
Answer/ End a call	Press
Reject a call	Double tap
Redial the last dialed-out number	Hold
Active voice dialing	Double tap
Pair	Hold  until blue and red light flash

Before using your new JY-002 Bluetooth Headset for the first time, make sure it can match up to the mobile phone.

1. Make sure the headset already charged, the mobile is turned on, the bluetooth function is available.
2. After turn off the headset, press until headset red and blue light flash alternately.
3. To match headset with mobile.
