Remote Guide:

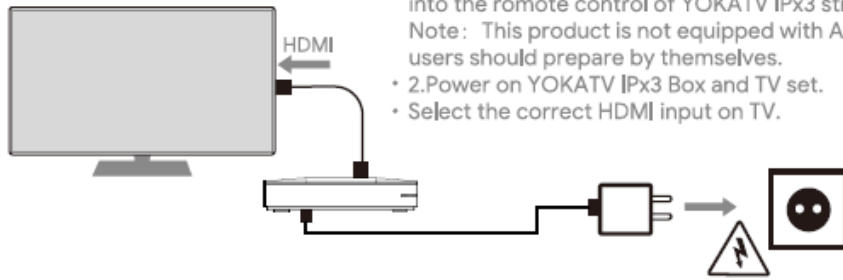


When the user's Y03H remote control is lost, by pressing the button on the back of the box, the remote control will beep.

(Note: This function is only available on the Y03H remote control.)



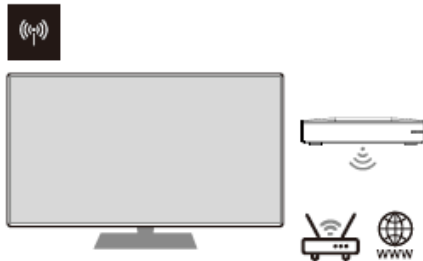

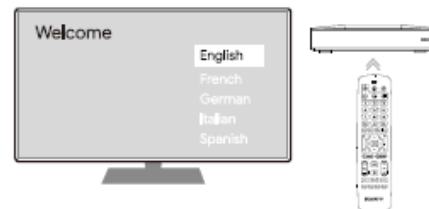
- 1. Before using, locate and insert 2 AAA batteries into the remote control of YOKATV IPx3 streaming box.
Note: This product is not equipped with AAA batteries, users should prepare by themselves.
- 2. Power on YOKATV IPx3 Box and TV set.
- Select the correct HDMI input on TV.

3. Keep the router near to YOKATV IPx3 Android Box. Make sure the internet is available, then connect LAN or WiFi.



4. Press the remote to control the IPx3.
