



Features & Instructions

With the Bluetooth Headset, you can trash-talk opponents; make new friends in the game lobby and organize your party in co-operative games. Plus, this Bluetooth compatible device is a great way to make hands-free calls.

Features & Instructions

Pairing Headset

- 1) Within the Settings Menu, highlight Accessory Settings and press X on the controller.
- 2) Highlight Manage Bluetooth Devices and press X on the controller.
- 3) Highlight Yes and press X on the controller to register the headset.
- 4) With the headset OFF, hold down the power button (approx. 4 seconds) until the LEDs start flashing blue & green.
- 5) Once the LEDs on the headset start flashing blue & green, press O on the controller to Start Scanning. Once the scan is complete, the PS3 should identify all of the Bluetooth devices within range.
- 6) Highlight WL009 on the list of available devices and press X on the controller.
- 7) Press X on the controller to enter 0000 (four zeros) as the Pass Key and press X again to select OK.
- 8) You will be taken to a new screen stating registration is now complete.
- 9) Press O on the controller twice to go back to Accessory Settings.
- 10) Scroll down and press X on the controller once you have highlighted Audio Device Settings.
- 11) Select WL009 as the input and output device from the list. Press X on the controller to confirm your choices.
- 12) Scroll down to highlight OK and press X on the controller. The WL009 Bluetooth headset is now ready to use. Enjoy!

Charging & Operating the Headset

The headset contains a rechargeable Li-ion battery. Prior to using the headset for the first time, it is strongly recommended to fully charge the battery for 3 hours.

Charging the Headset:

- 1) Connect the supplied USB cable to your PS3 console.
- 2) Connect the mini USB end to the headset.
- 3) The LEDs will glow green while the headset is charging and they will turn blue when charging is complete.

NOTE: Do not try to pair the headset to the console while the headset is charging because it may cause pairing issues.

Operating the Headset:

- 1) To power on your headset, press and hold the power button for 1 second until you see a BLUE & Green LED flash.
- 2) To fit the headset on your ear comfortably, lift the ear hook and loop it around your ear. Position the speaker in your ear for optimal audio performance.
- 3) To adjust the volume, use the + / - buttons.
- 4) To mute the headset, press the power button briefly (less than 1 second), and repeat the process to un-mute the headset.
- 5) To power OFF your headset, press and hold the power button for 3 seconds. The LED will turn green and then go out to indicate the device is now OFF.

NOTE: You only need to complete the pairing process for the initial setup. To reconnect your headset to your PS3 console at any time, simply press the power button on the headset.
