
#### Before You Install



WARNING: Do not insert the batteries into the lock until it is fully installed. Doing so may damage the lock.

- Check the box for the following installation components:
- A Keypad (x1)
- Back Panel (x1)
- Back Panel Screw (x1)
- Strike Plate (x1)
- Mounting Plate (x1)

- Short Silver Screws (x2)
- AA Batteries (x8)
- ₩ood Screws (x4)
- Main Screws (x2)
- Deadbolt Latch (x1)



- Prepare your installation by first removing any existing deadbolt hardware.
- 3 You will need a Phillips head screwdriver. If using power tools, we recommend that you adjust them to the lowest torque setting to avoid stripping your screws.
- 4 Download and install our Rently Smart Home App from the Apple App Store or the Google Play Store.




#### Installation Instructions


Slide the deadbolt assembly into the opening on the side of the door with the "TOP" text oriented properly. Install using the screws provided. Be sure the deadbolt assembly is fully seated.





2 Arrange the corresponding rubber gaskets to be fully seated against the back of the keypad and the back of the mounting bracket. Feed the keypad wire under the deadbolt hardware, then through the cable hole in the mounting bracket.







3 Attach the mounting bracket to the faceplate using two of the machine screws provided. Multiple screw lengths are provided to accommodate the thickness of your door. If necessary, you may rotate the cable 90° and hang the keypad from the bracket while arranging your hardware.






4 Connect the keypad cable to the battery box cable by firmly snapping the connectors together. Then rotate the deadbolt shaft so that the bump is on the top side. Next, rotate the deadbolt knob to align it with the shaft. Install the battery box using two short silver screws and the back panel screw at the bottom. Rotate the deadbolt knob by hand to be sure that it moves freely and that the screws are not overtightened.





Once your hardware is installed, you may insert the batteries. The lock will run on 4 batteries in the lower compartment, but using 8 will provide much longer battery life.





To complete the installation, log in to the Rently Smart Home app and follow the in-app instructions.

#### I IMITED WARRANTY

Rently, the "warrantor", extends the following limited warranty to the original purchaser of the Smart Bolt ordered, delivered, and installed in the U.S. (herein the "lockset" or "lockset").

- 1. ELECTRONIC COMPONENTS. Electronic components warranted TWO(2) YEARS. Rently warrants to the original purchaser of the lockset(s) manufactured by it to be free of defects in material and workmanship as long as the consumer (as the term 'consumer' is defined under United States Code Section 230(3)) occupies the residential premises upon which the lockset was originally installed. If, after initial installation of the lockset, any of the electronic parts or the finish should become defective, the Warrantor will repair or replace the locksets, in accordance with this Limited Warranty. Electronic components are warranted THREE (3) YEARS is a Rently Certified Security Professional sells and installs the Product. Electronic components include the touchscreen, circuit boards, and motor drive. a. The warranty of the replacement lockset will be limited to the unexpired term of the original warranty. b. Electronic components under warranty may be replaced with new or refurbished parts.
- 2. MECHANICAL PARTS & FINISH. Rently warrants to the original purchaser of the lockset(s) manufactured by it to be free of defects in material and workmanship as long as the consumer (as the term "consumer" is defined under United States Code Section 2301(3)) occupies the residential premises upon which the lockset was originally installed. If, after initial installation of the lockset, any of the mechanical parts or the finish should become defective, the Warrantor will repair or replace the locksets, in accordance with this Limited Warranty, a. When the lockset has been used for commercial, institutional, industrial or other installations other than single-family dwellings, the mechanical parts warranty is reduced to THREE (3) YEARS and the finish warranty is reduced to TWO YEARS. b. The warranty on the replacement lockset will be limited to the unexpired term of the original warranty.
- 3. CONDITIONS AND EXCEPTIONS. This Limited Warranty shall apply only when the lockset is properly installed in accordance with local codes, ordinances and regulations, the printed instructions provided with it and good industry practices. THIS WARRANTY DDES NOT COVER defects caused by: modification, alteration, repair or service of the lockset by anyone other than Warrantor or an authorized designee of Warrantor; physical abuse to, or misuse of, the lockset or operation of it in a manner contrary to the accompanying instructions; shipment of the product to anyone other than Warrantor for service: improper installation; acts of God; fire; flood; casualty; failure to exercise normal maintenance; for the consequences of uses for which locksets were not designed or designated, or for defects caused by the use of paints, solvents or other chemicals which come in contact with the lockset. THIS WARRANTY DDES NOT APPLY to locksets or component parts of locksets that were not originally manufactured by Warrantor. THIS WARRANTY SHALL
- 4. SERVICE AND REPAIR EXPENSE. Under this Limited Warranty the Warrantor will provide only a replacement lockset or a part of it. Warrantor will pay reasonable shipping costs for surface transportation only for locksets returned to Warrantor's Customer Service Department. Warrantor will ship replacement parts under this Limited Warranty at its expense by surface transportation only. Any special handling, express or expedited service or different method of transportation shall only be provided at the request and expense of the purchaser of the locksets. However, if warrantor determines that a lockset does not quality for repair or replacement under the applicable Limited Warranty, Warrantor will notify the consumer of the estimated costs of repair or replacement and obtain the consumer's authorization and agreement to pay actual repair or replacement costs before proceeding with non-warranty repair or replacement. Warranter shall have no liability to pay any costs for repairs performed by anyone other than Warrantor or its designee, unless in each instance Warrantor has given written approval for such repair. Warrantor shall not be responsible for any costs incurred for the removal or re-installation of locksets covered by this Limited Warrantey.
- 5. LIMITATION ON IMPLIED WARRANTIES. ANY EXPRESS WARRANTY NOT PROVIDED IN THIS LIMITED WARRANTY, AND ANY REMEDY FOR BREACH OF CONTRACT THAT, BUT FOR THIS PROVISION, MIGHT ARISE BY IMPLICATION OR OPERATION OF LAW, IS EXCLUDED AND DISCLAIMED.
