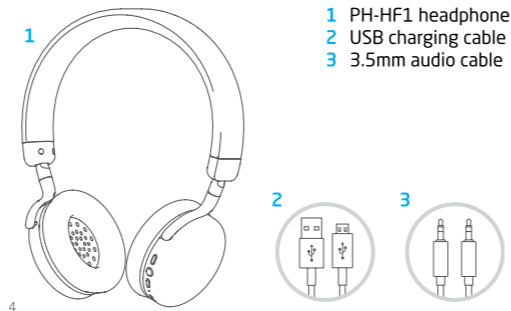
Thank you for purchasing the Photive PH-HF1 and welcome to the Photive family!

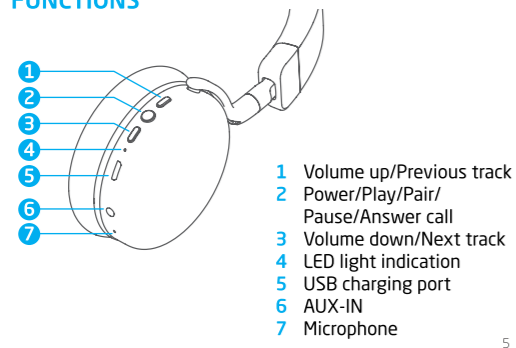

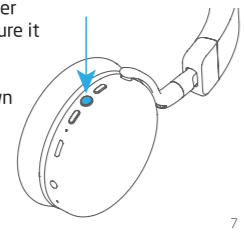


FUNCTIONS



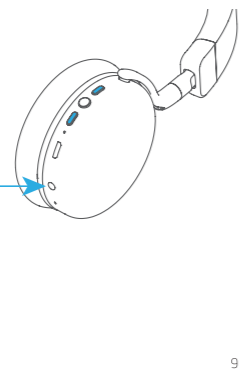
PAIRING

- Press and hold the Power button to turn your headphone on as shown.
- The Bluetooth LED indicator will flash red and blue.
- Enable your Bluetooth device such as cell phones, tablets or other Bluetooth media and make sure it is in searching mode.
- Select "Photive HF1 headphones" in the list shown in the Bluetooth device.



Please note: the changing track buttons only work when connected wirelessly via Bluetooth. Volume function will work in Aux-in mode.

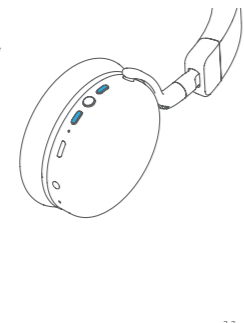
IMPORTANT This Aux-in port is for audio input only. Please DO NOT connect other headphones.



OPERATION INSTRUCTION

VOLUME ADJUSTMENT

At any time while playing music, the volume can be changed with the Volume up (Previous track) or Volume down (Next track) button. To raise the volume, press the Volume up button. To lower volume, press the Volume down button as shown. There will be a tone from the headphone to indicate that the level has reached maximum or minimum volume.



CHARGING

Before using your PH-HF1, please charge it using the micro USB charging cable included in the package. Please note: Most USB chargers are compatible with PH-HF1. For optimal AC charging, please use a 1.0A USB charger.

Plug the small micro USB pin into the charging port on the right side of the headphone, and the other end of the cable (the standard USB 2.0 plug) into any standard USB port (such as a computer or USB charger).

The LED light on the right side ear cup will turn red when it is being charged. When it is fully charged, the LED indicator light will turn blue. The headphone can be charged while playing music.

Note

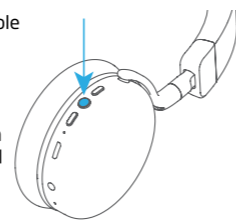
- If it prompts, please enter password "0000" for a connection.
- The headphone will automatically reconnect to the last connected Bluetooth enabled audio device.
- IMPORTANT** When you need to connect your headphone with another Bluetooth enabled audio device, hold the PAIRING button (power button) until the Bluetooth LED indicator flashes quickly. This will put the headphone into pairing mode.

LINE-IN

If your device is not Bluetooth enabled you can still enjoy your music simply by using the Line-In Audio Jack. Connect the headphone with the audio cable that is included in the package to any device with a 3.5mm standard audio jack. Once connected the headphone can be used as a wired headphone.

HANDS-FREE SPEAKERPHONE

- You can use PH-HF1 as a portable headphone for incoming calls when connected wirelessly and outgoing calls via Bluetooth.
- Take your call by pressing the Power button. Press once again when ending the call. Music will resume automatically.
- To make a call, simply dial your cell phone and talk to the speakerphone. Once your call is connected, choose PH-HF1 in the headset options.



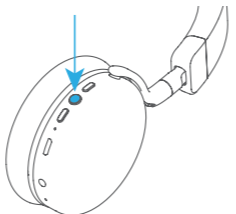
CHANGING TRACKS

Press and hold the Previous track (Volume up) or Next track (Volume down) button on the right ear cup to change tracks.

Please note: If listening to music via the Aux line in the track controls on the headphone will not function. Control the track from the device playing audio (ie: Smartphone, Tablet)

PLAY AND PAUSE

Press the Power button on the headphone to play/pause the music.



TROUBLESHOOTING

No power

Ensure the headphone is charged and with enough power for operation. The headphone can be used when it is in charging mode.

No sound

Ensure the headphone is on. Ensure your Bluetooth device is on. If the volume of the headphone is too low, adjust the volume to an appropriate level.

Unable to connect

Press the pairing button until the LED indicator flashes quickly. The Bluetooth headphone will go into pairing mode. Select PH-HF1 on your Bluetooth enable device.

NOTES

Automobile Accident Hazard

- Do not place the PH-HF1 on high surfaces such as shelves. During music playback the PH-HF1 may move which could cause the PH-HF1 to shift and fall off of the edge.

- Do not attempt to replace your PH-HF1 battery. It is built-in and is not changeable.
