6.1 Radio Frequency Exposure Compliance

6.1.1 Electromagnetic Fields

RESULT:**Pass**

Test standard : RSS-102 Issue 5 March 2015
FCC KDB Publication 447498 D01 v06

The maximum output power of the transmitter is 0.122mW (-9.12dBm) only, which less than 4mW. Hence the EUT is exempted from routine evaluation limits (SAR Evaluation) according to clause 2.5.1 of RSS-102 Issue 5.

Since maximum output power of the transmitter is $0.122\text{mW} < 10\text{mW}$, and the distance from EUT to human is $\geq 5\text{mm}$, hence the EUT is excluded from SAR evaluation according to FCC KDB publication 447498 D01 General RF Exposure Guidance v06.
