

## 6. Safety Human exposure

### 6.1 Radio Frequency Exposure Compliance

#### 6.1.1 Electromagnetic Fields

**RESULT:** Pass

Test standard : RSS-102 Issue 5 March 2015  
FCC KDB Publication 447498 D01 v06

The maximum output power of the transmitter is 0.350mW (-4.56dBm) only, which less than 309mW. Hence the EUT is exempted from routine evaluation limits (SAR Evaluation) according to clause 2.5.1 of RSS-102 Issue 5.

Since maximum output power of the transmitter is 0.350mW<96mW, and the distance from EUT to human is  $\geq 50\text{mm}$ , hence the EUT is excluded from SAR evaluation according to FCC KDB publication 447498 D01 General RF Exposure Guidance v06.
