Tips and Precautions

- Please fully assemble the AWC-1004 before placing in your car. Most states allow drivers to mount a phone inside their car as long as it doesn't get in the way of the driver's view to drive safely. Please check local laws before attaching to dashboard or windshield.
- Keep these instructions.
- Do not drop, puncture or disassemble this product.
- This product should not be exposed to dripping or splashing.
- Avoid long exposure to direct sunlight, which may cause damage.
- Use a clean, soft cloth to clean. Do not use any commercial cleaners.
- Keep your attention on the road. Do not operate the controls of this product while driving.
- Read all the instructions before using the product, and use the product as intended.
- Secure the mount just before driving. Do not adjust while driving.
- Keep close supervision of this product if being used around children.
- Do not expose to rain or moisture and do not use near water.
- Do not expose to extreme heat sources. Do not dispose in a fire.
- Do not place metal items on the surface of the product.

- Do not cover the product with paper or other materials. Use in a well-ventilated area when charging.
- Do not charge the phone while it is being charged, and the charger may temporarily stop charging if it gets too hot.
- Do not assemble, modify, or try to use for a non-intended purpose, and do not use if damaged or modified. Never insert objects other than the specified cord into the product.
- Do not place magnetic strip cards or similar magnetically sensitive items between the phone and the charger. Wireless charging uses magnetic induction that could damage the product.
- Multiple Qi devices cannot be charged at the same time.
- Disconnect the USB cable from the USB power source if not in use or once the phone is fully charged.

Get Started

Assembly:

- Place suction mount on a flat surface with orange knob positioned on the right.
- Turn knob on the suction mount counterclockwise to loosen.
- Holding the extender bar horizontally, insert it into the top of the suction mount's ball joint and then into the top of the extender bar's ball joint.
- Position the extender bar at the desired angle and then turn the knob clockwise to hold the extender bar securely in place. (Please be sure not to hold the extender bar while doing this.)
- To place the smartphone mount onto the base, remove the screw on the back of the mount by turning it counter-clockwise. Then, hold the screw onto the ball joint of the extender arm instead. We will use this screw to tighten the smartphone mount to the extender arm.
- Once the screw is tight on the base, you will make the extender arm stand and screw it onto the ball joint. Adjust the angle of the smartphone mount and then tighten the screw.
- Your mount is fully put together now. If you need to readjust any angles, just loose either screw or knob, make the adjustment, and then tighten the screw.
- Plug the USB-C cable (included) into the wireless charging mount's USB-C port which is located on the underside of the mount behind its adjustable foot.

Mounting on the Dashboard:

- Make sure to choose the flattest area on the dashboard that doesn't obstruct your view of the road and your surroundings while driving.
- Open the clear film from the base of the suction cup.
- Clip the area and a clean cloth.
- Remove the clear film from the base of the suction cup.
- Mount the suction phone mount on your dashboard.
- Press the oval button on the back of the suction mount's base by pulling it upward. Place the mount on dashboard. Close the latch by pushing back down. Make sure the mount is to the windscreen. This should make a strong connection.
- Method 2: If the dashboard is too curved, or if a very curved area is on the dashboard, use the suction disc. Peel the protective cover off adhesive of the and click it to the dashboard. Note that this permanently sticks the disc to your dashboard.
- Open the release latch on the front of the suction mount's base by pulling it upward. Place the mount on suction disc and close latch.
- With a slight adjustment, you can adjust the position of the mount by loosening the knobs and rotating each ball joint, and then tightening the knobs again.
- Open the release latch on the front of the suction mount's base by pulling it upward. Place the mount on the vehicle's USB power output port, or USB vehicle adapter. connector on the cable into a USB-A power port such as the vehicle's USB power output port, or USB vehicle adapter.
- To use included cord management clip, peel protective coating from back and adhere to desired position. Feed cord through it.

Mounting on the Windshield:

- Make sure to choose an area on the windshield that doesn't obstruct your view.
- Clean the clear film area with a clean cloth.
- Open the release latch on the front of the suction mount's base by pulling it upward. Place the mount on the windshield. Close the latch by pushing it back down. Make sure the mount is to the windscreen. This should make a strong connection.
- To adjust the viewing angle, you can adjust the position of the mount by loosening the knobs and rotating each ball joint, and then tightening the knobs again.
- To power the wireless charge plug the USB-A connector on the end of the USB-C cable into the vehicle's USB power output port or USB vehicle adapter. (Requires power to charge your device.)
- To use included cord management clip, peel protective coating from back and adhere to desired position. Feed cord through it.
- To open the mount from the windshield, open the release latch on the front of the suction mount base by pulling it upward. Then turn pull up on the top on the back of the suction cup.
- Press the oval button on the back of your phone to release the arms. Fully expand it until phones up to 3.6 inches wide in cases. Pull down on the foot to fully extend.
- Place the phone on the foot and adjust its position to center your phone at the center of the charger where the wireless icon is located. Manually close arms to securely hold the phone in place.

Charging your Phone

- To prevent damage to the phone or the charger:
 - Do not place metal objects on the charger during charging.
 - Do not place metal objects on the charger during charging.
 - Qi wireless chargeable phones with metallic looking finishes will charge normally.
