Installation

Remove RF pendant back cover (figure 1), place the battery (figure 2), close the back cover (figure 3).

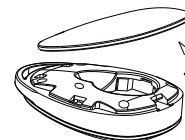

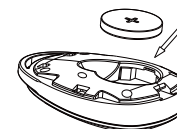



Note:

Please push aside the battery contact spring before replacing the battery.

Configuration

1. RF Learning

- On idle, press  (menu), choose Settings-->Advanced Setting (default password: admin) --> RF Keys Learning, choose the RF key X (1-10) that needs to learn, then press , a "Please choose learn/delete key..." message will be displayed on the screen;
- Press , then press the button on Pendant after seeing "RF Key X learning...". The phone will display "RF Key X learned" after successful learning. Repeat this step for other RF keys;
- Press , then press  after seeing "Delete RF key X Data?" the RF Key X data will be deleted. Press the corresponding RF key, the phone does not respond, RF key is disabled.

2. RF Function

- Configure RF function on web interface first, Menu-->Phone-->Emergency Call-->RF Key;
- Press RF key, phone's corresponding function is responded.
