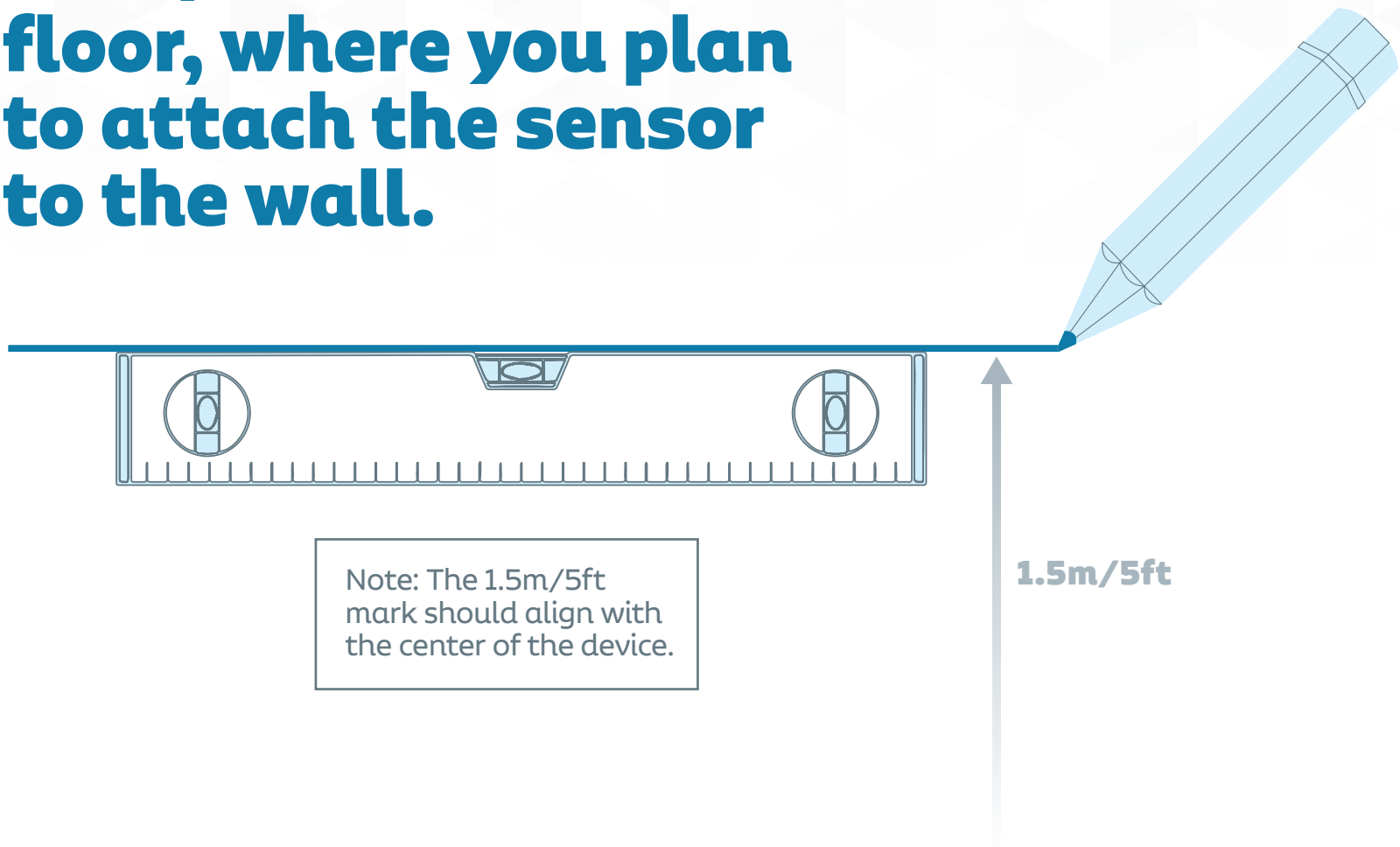


In-wall installation



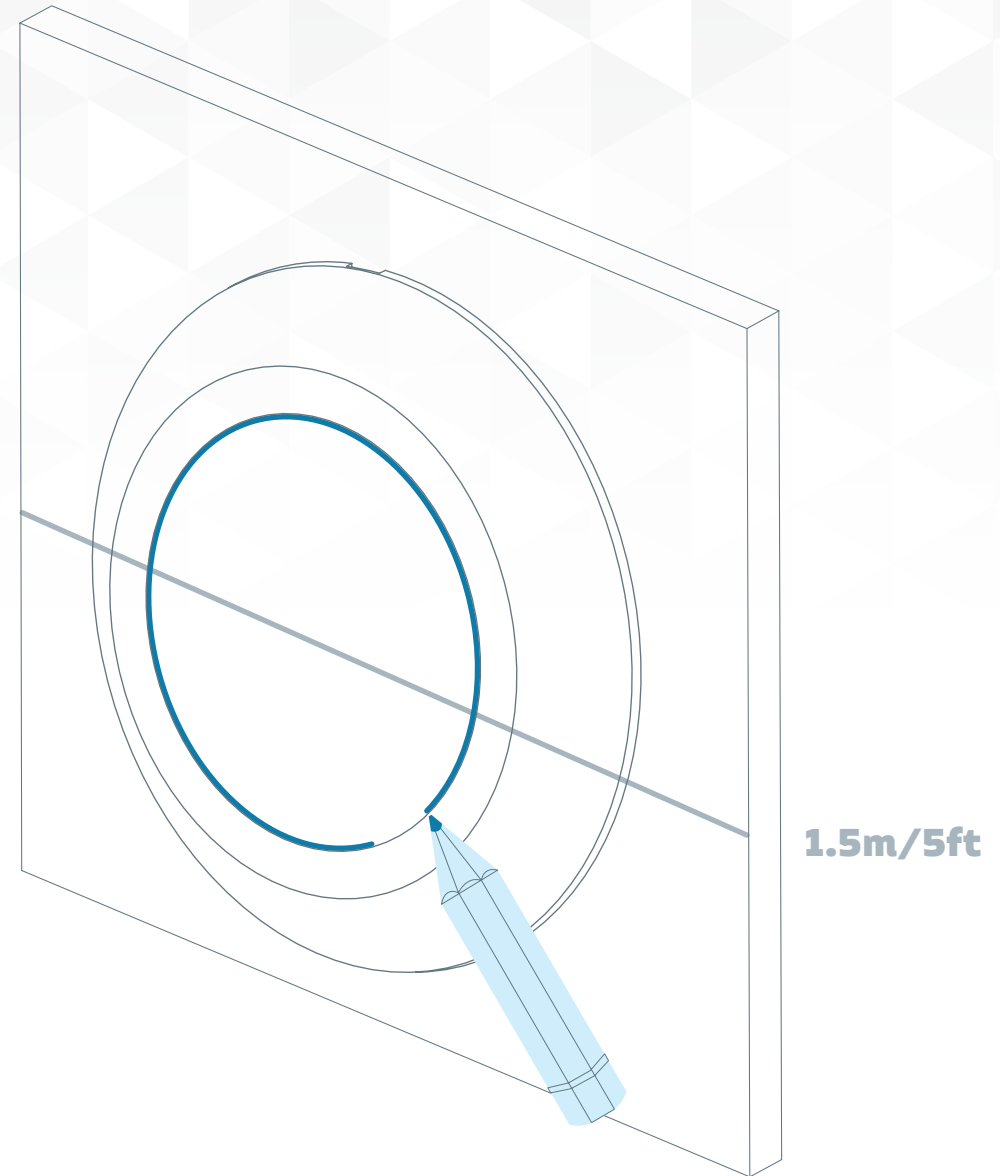

Mark a line on the wall, measured 1.5m/5ft from the floor, where you plan to attach the sensor to the wall.



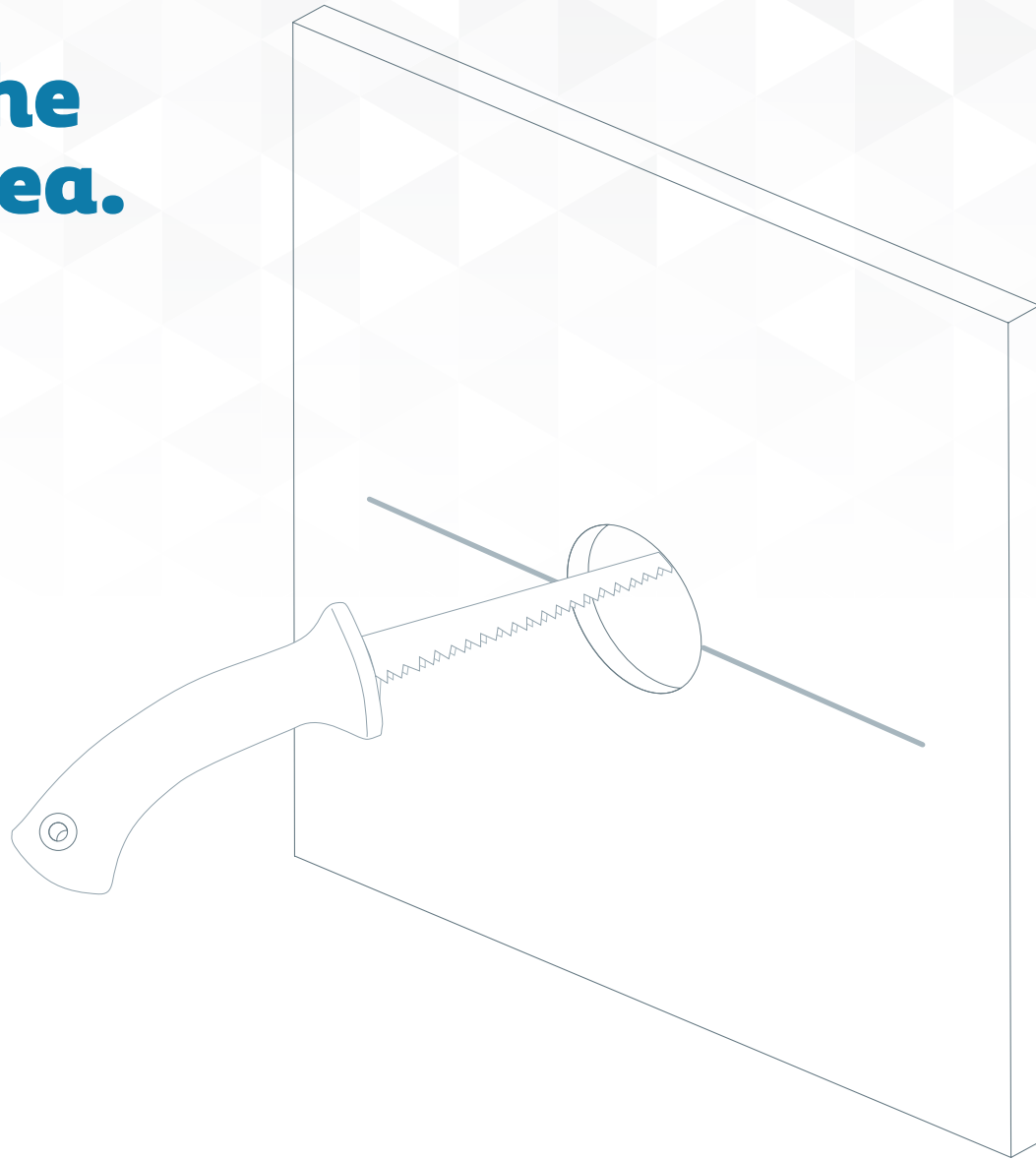

Using the front cover as a template, draw a circle with the line going through the center.



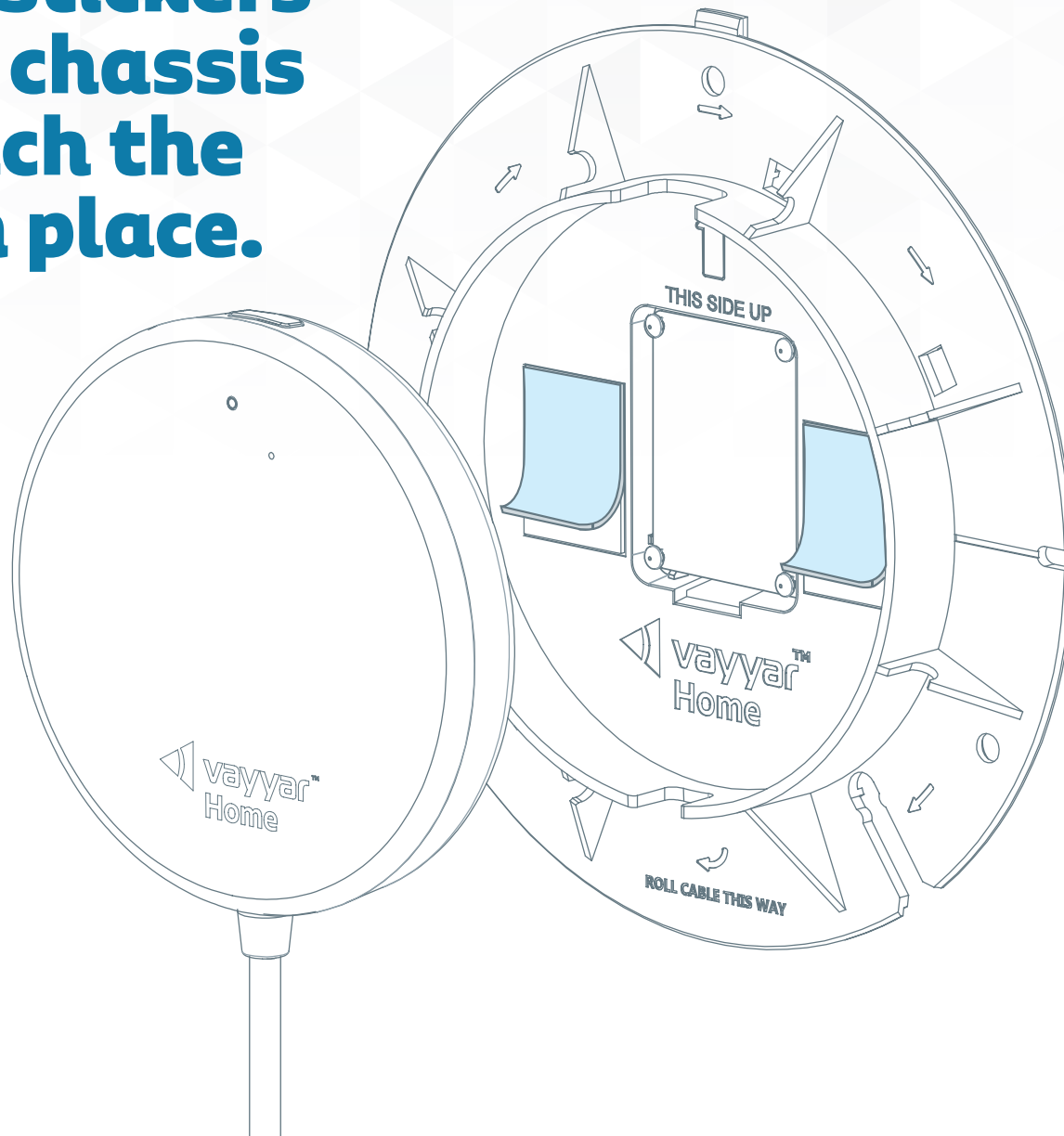

circled area.**



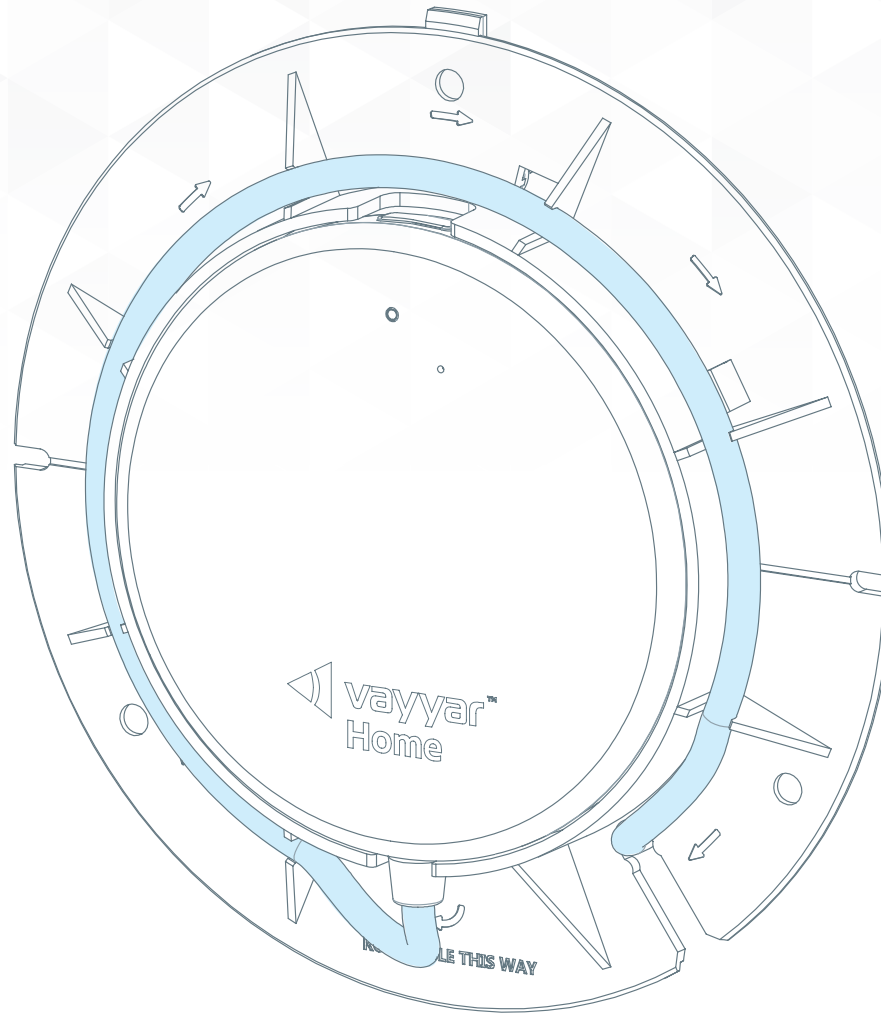

Peel the stickers from the chassis and attach the sensor in place.



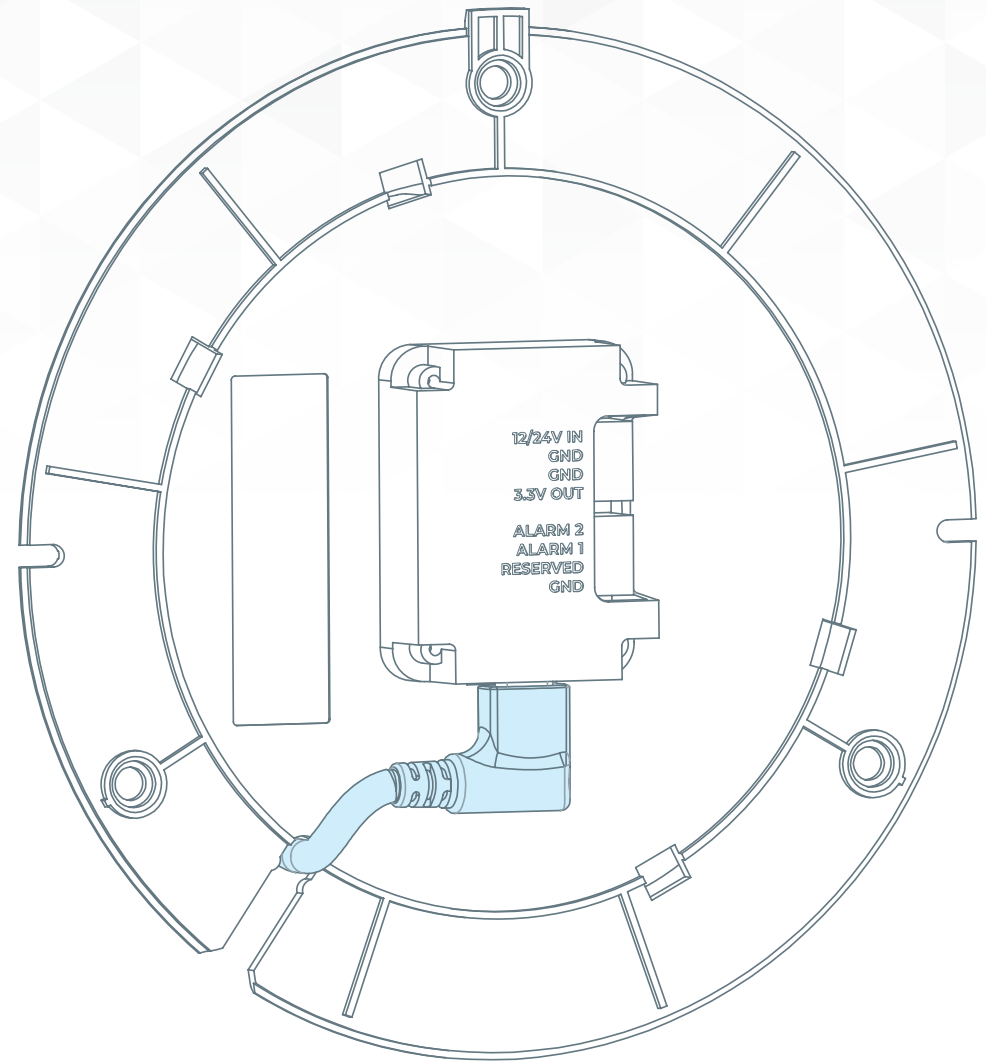

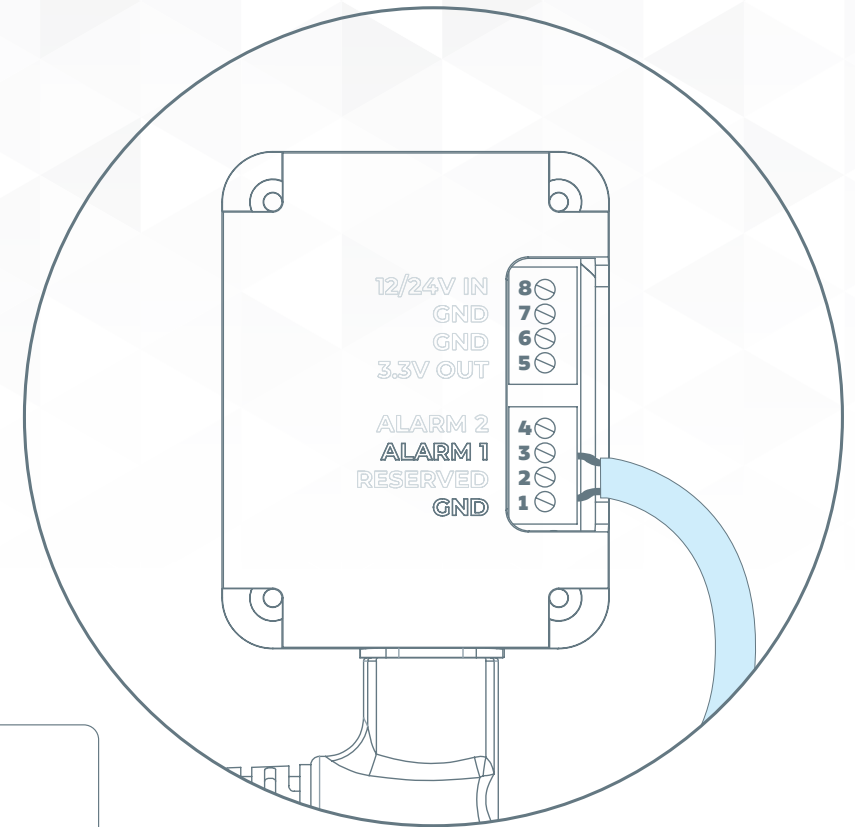
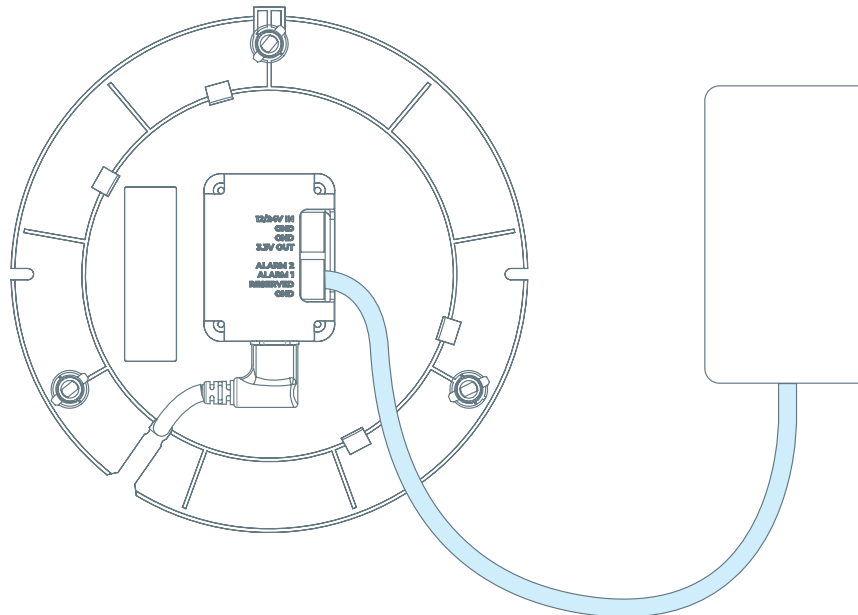
Drill holes in the wall in line with those on the chassis and insert wall plugs.

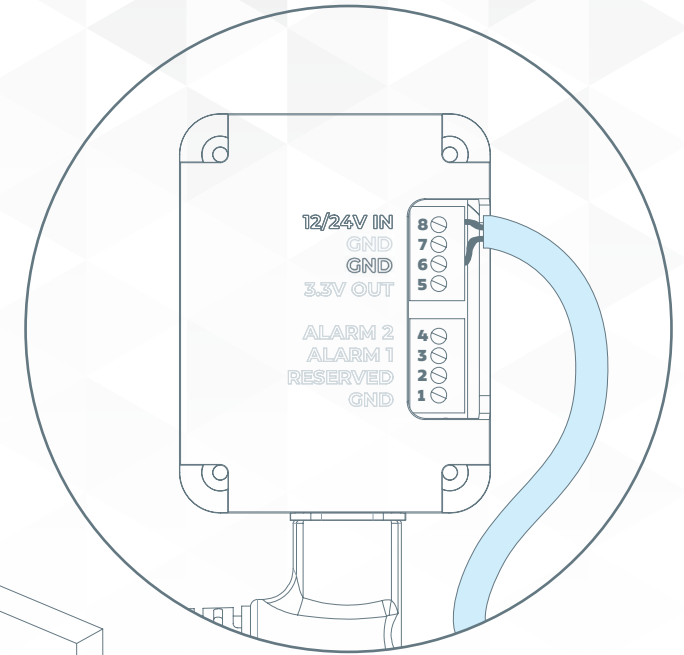
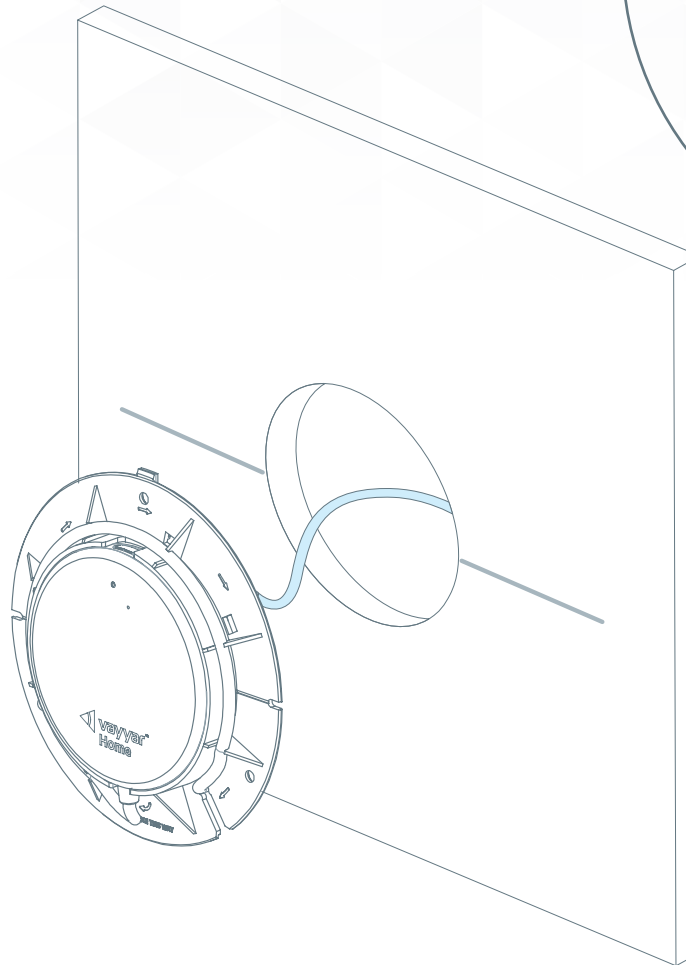


The transmitter cables should be connected to the bottom first (GND) and third (ALARM 1) locations on the board. Do not attach the cables at locations directly next to each other.

Connect the sensor to the electrical supply*.

*Note: It is important to connect the transmitter before connecting the electrical supply.



The electrical cables should be connected to the bottom eighth (12/24V IN) and sixth (GND) locations on the board. Do not attach the cables at locations directly next to each other.

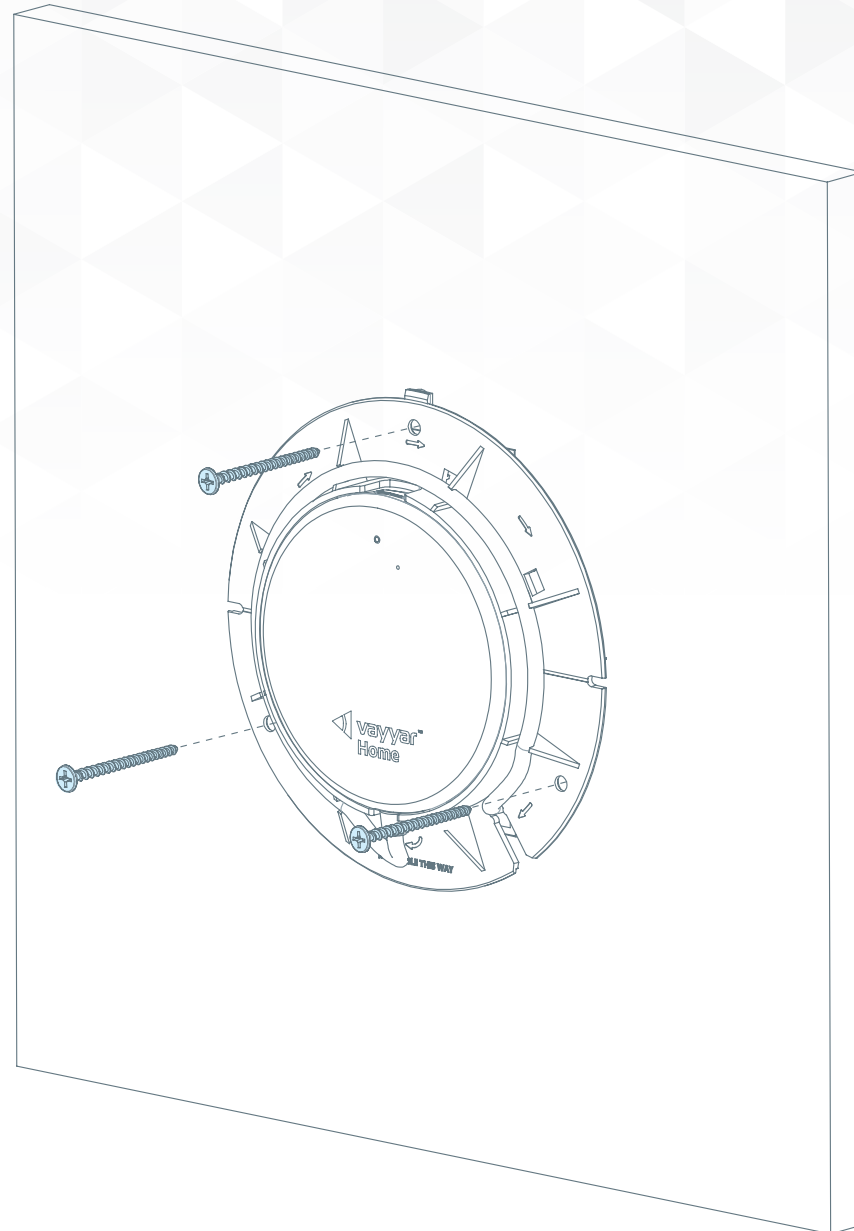

Test the device, before completing wall installation:

- ▶ If your device is pre-provisioned, make sure the device is powered ON and you see a white light from the LED
- ▶ If your device is NOT pre-provisioned, please reference the provisioning instructions provided by the Vayyar Home Customer Success team
- ▶ Once pairing is complete & power is confirmed, simulate the dry contact is working by pressing the power button for 2-seconds

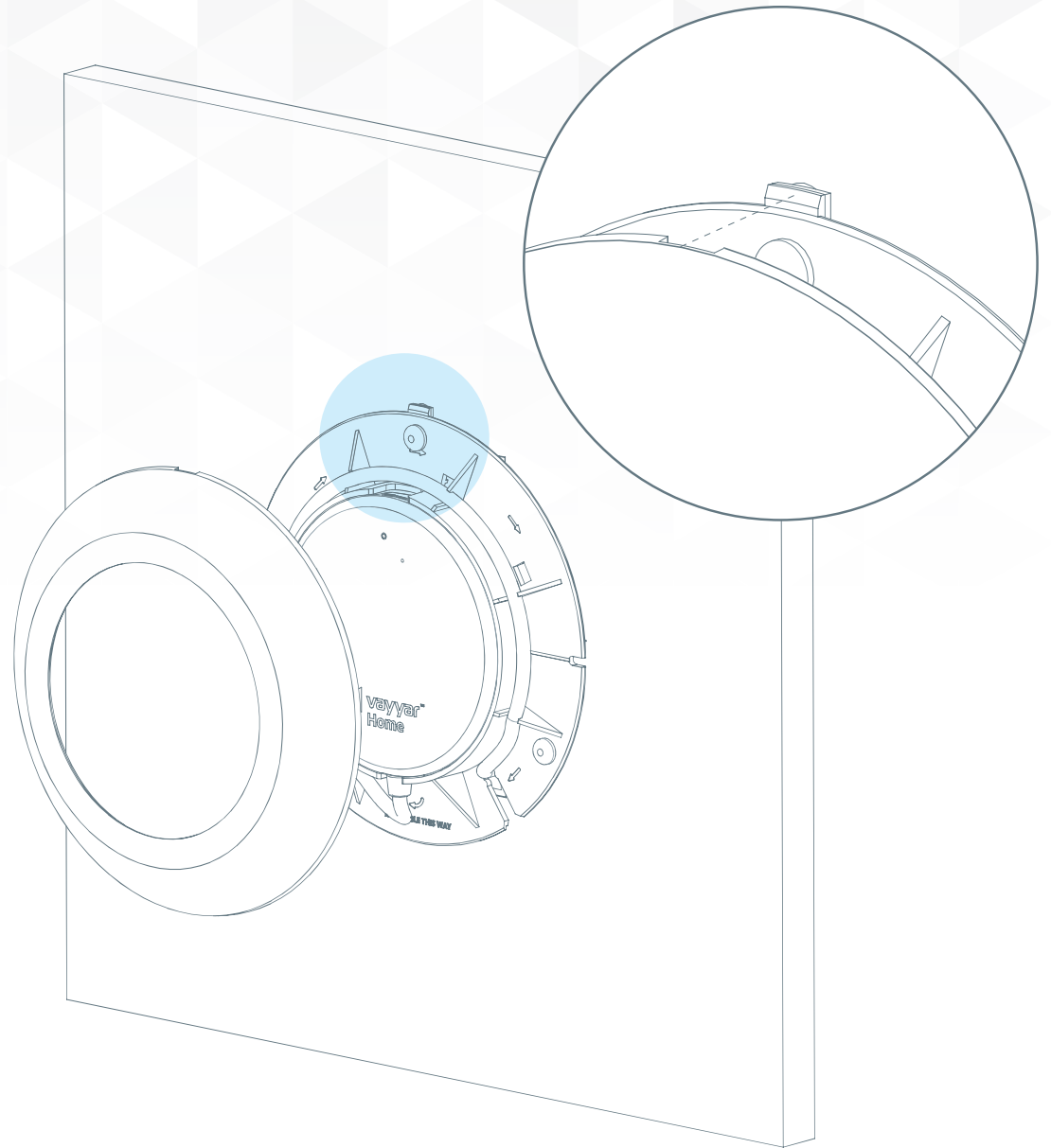

With a spirit level, mark a line 1.5m/5ft from the floor on the wall where you want the sensor.



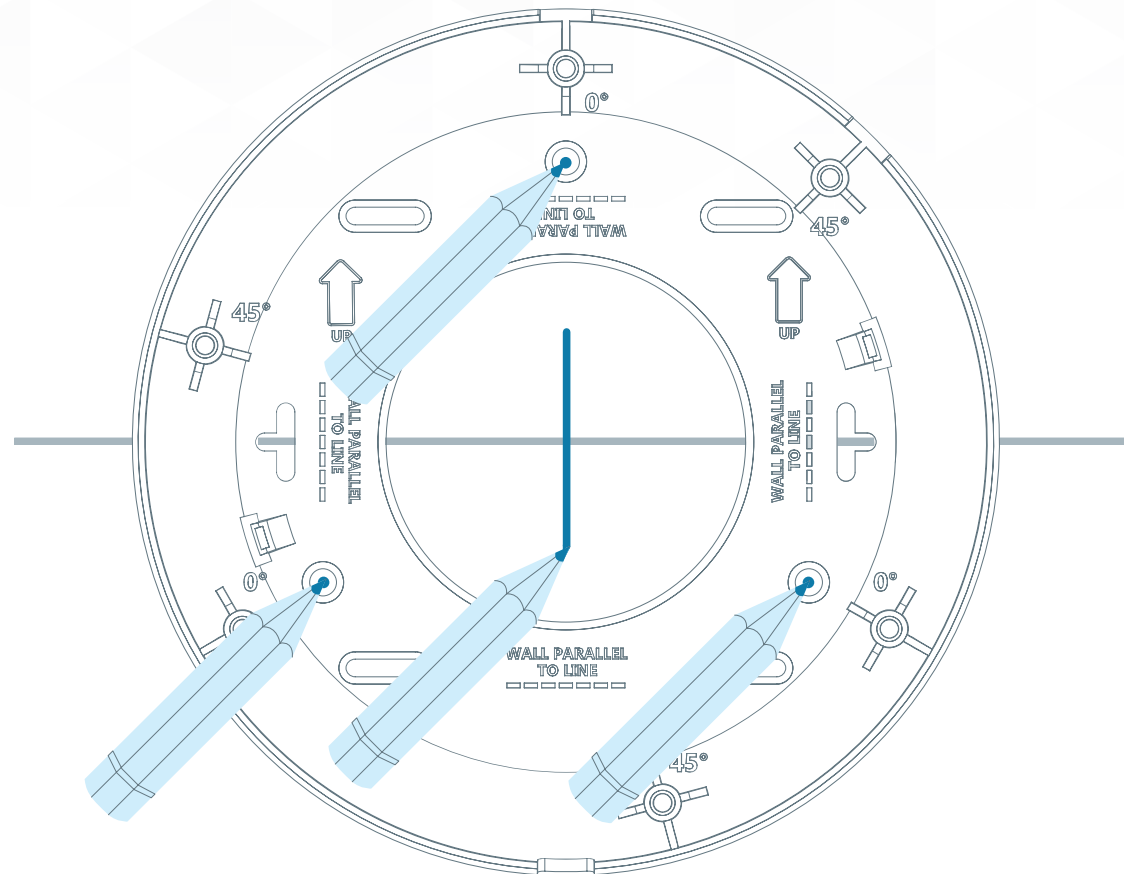

Place the back cover on the wall so that it correctly intersects the line and is the right way up.



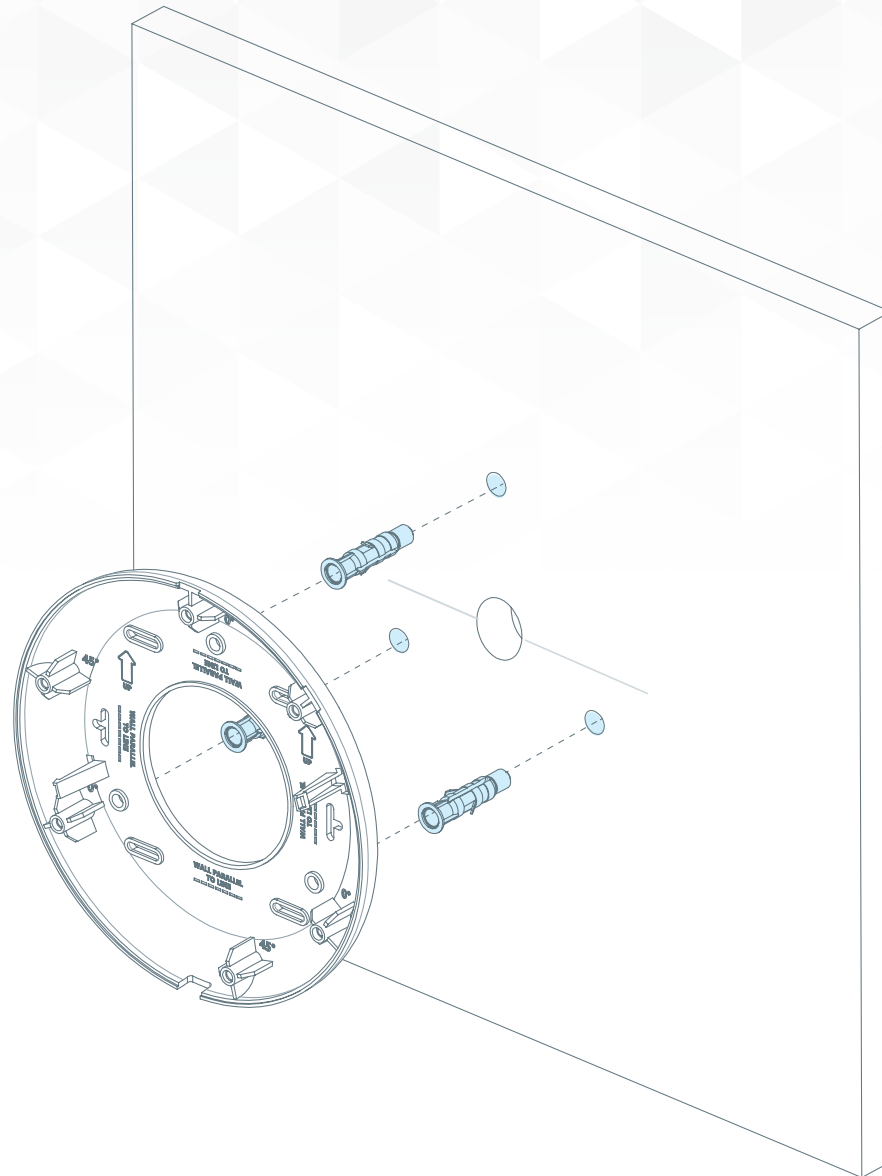

Mark drill-hole positions on the wall, including one in the middle for the cable.



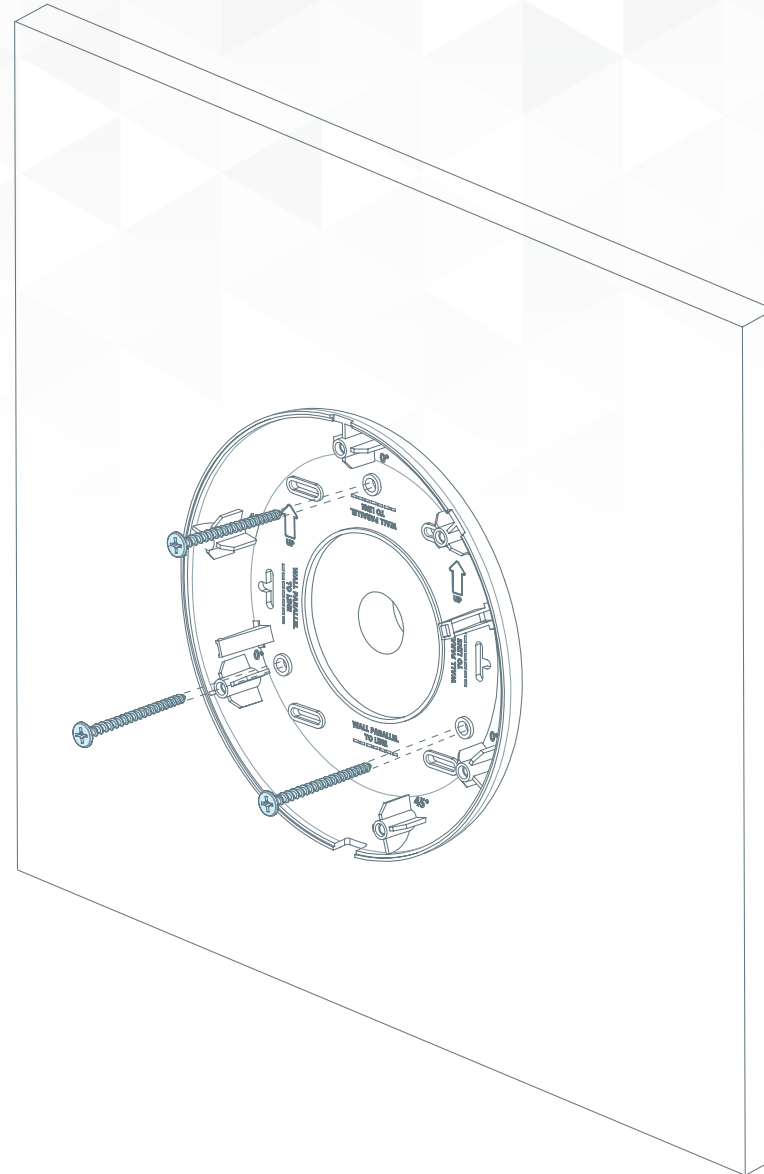

(Optional) Connect a dry contact alarm to the sensor.



Pass the cable through the bottom-center of the device, there should be a specific opening in the back cover for the cable in this location (see illustration).

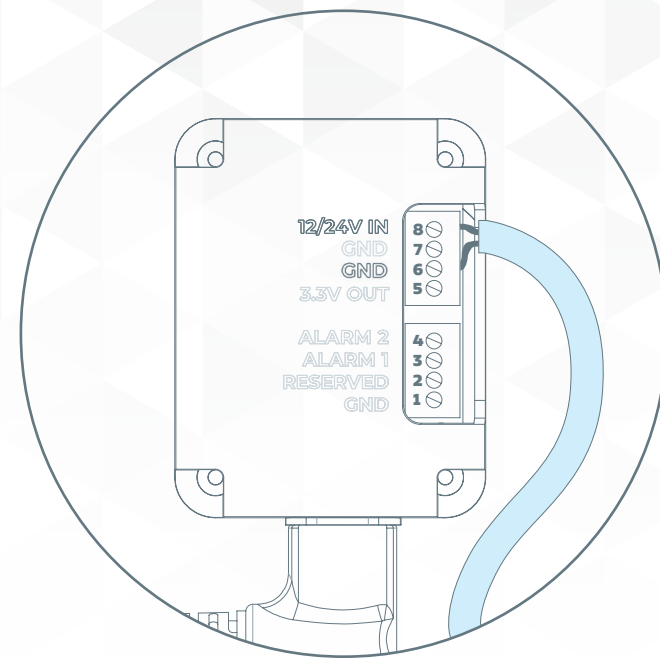
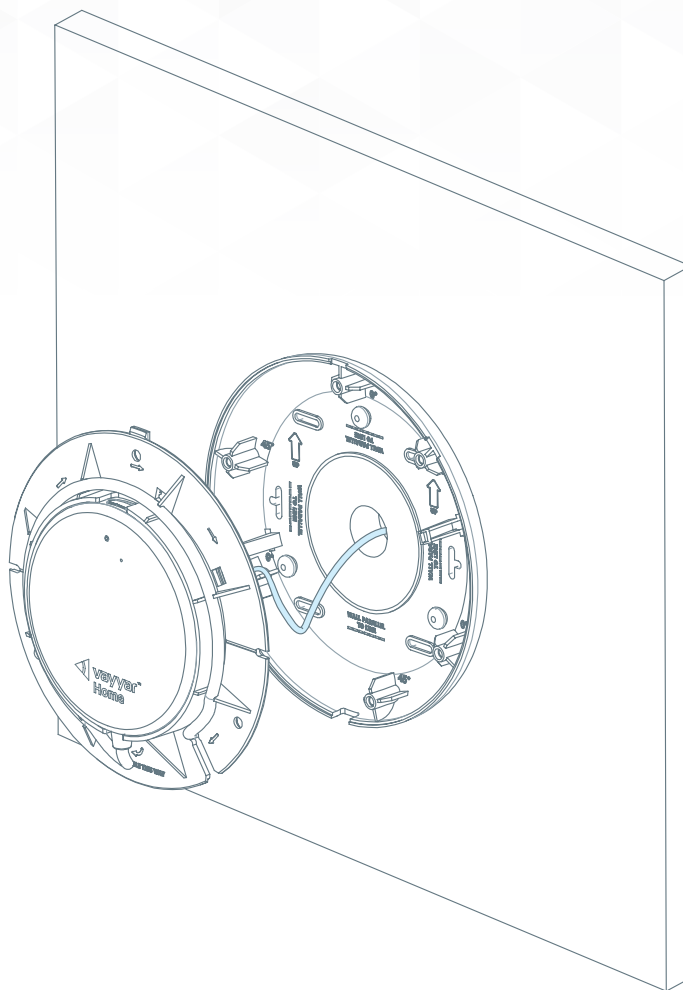
The transmitter cables should be connected to the bottom first (GND) and third (ALARM 1) locations on the board. Do not attach the cables at locations directly next to each other.



Note: Make sure the voltage reaching the system is under 5 volts.

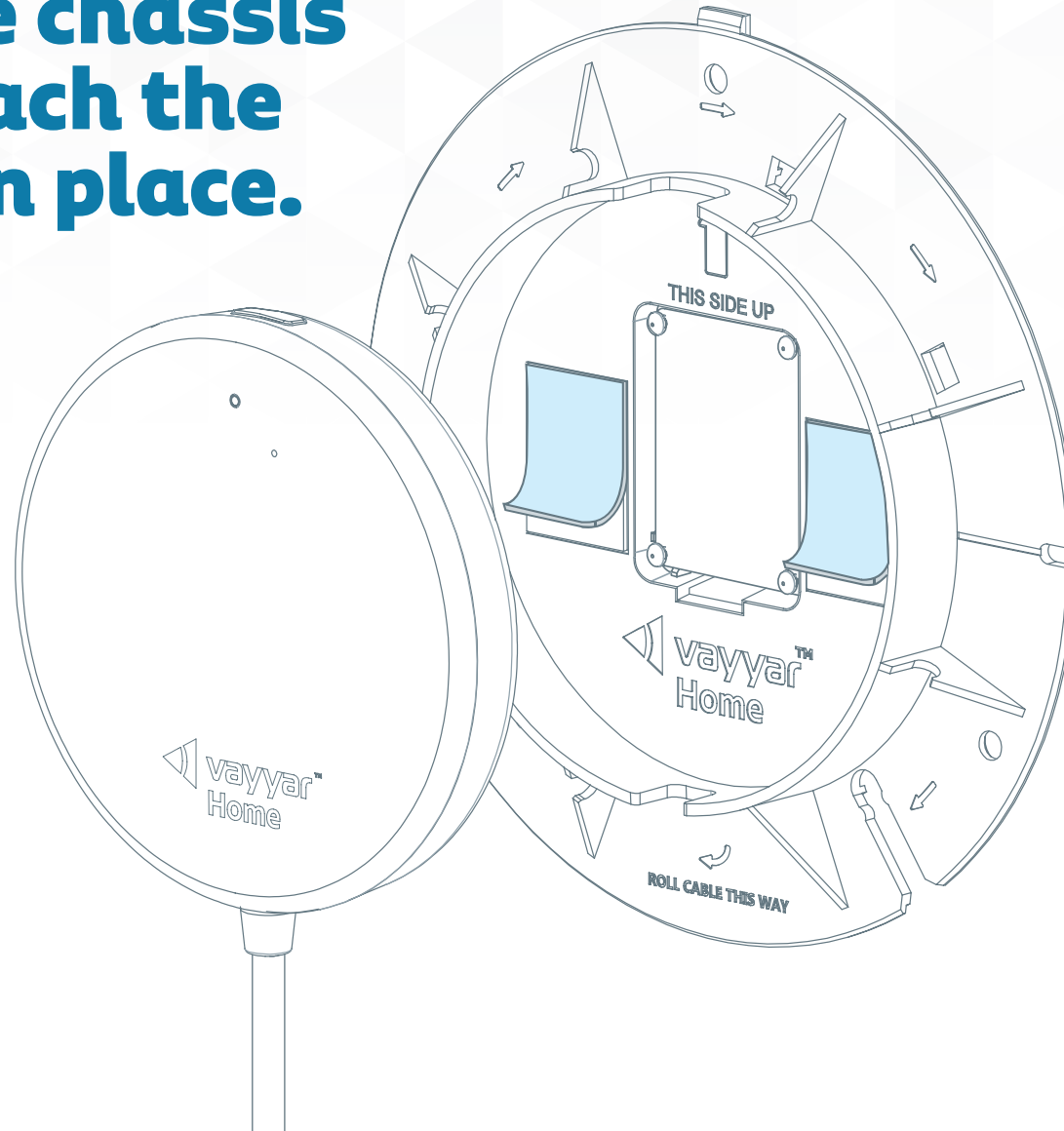


Ceiling installation



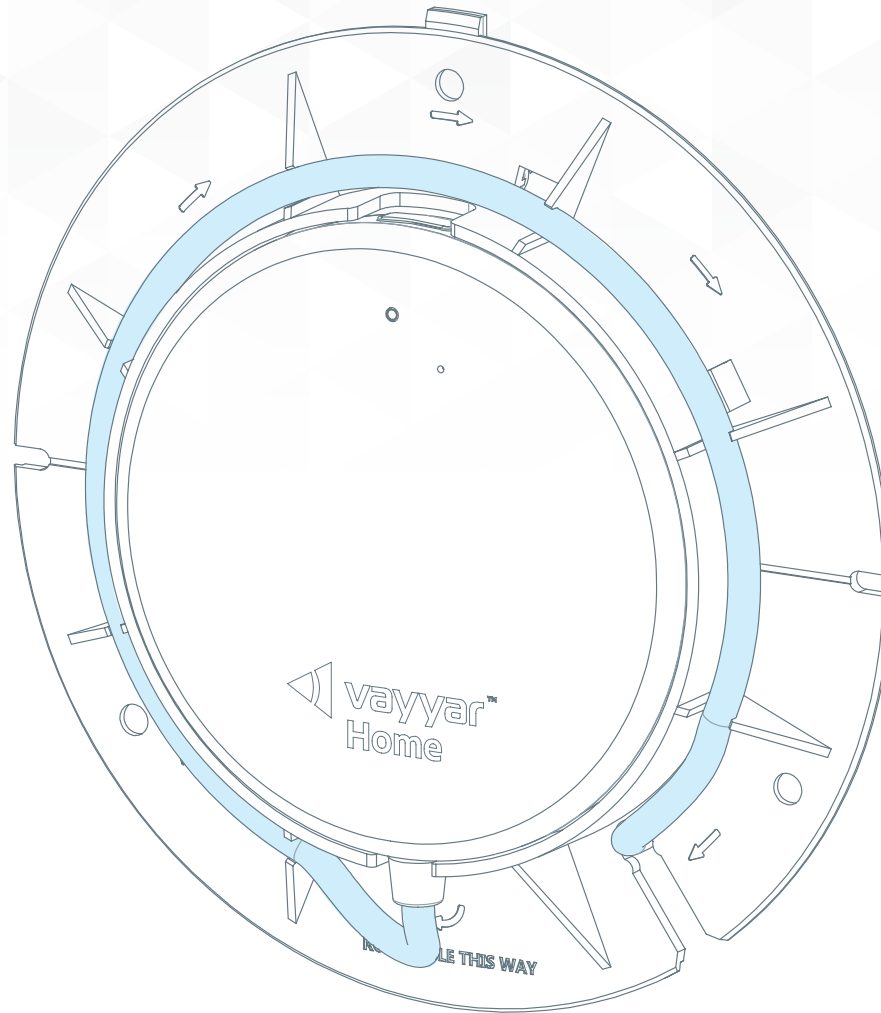

Orient the back cover according to the room wall widths – the top arrows should be parallel to the x-axis.

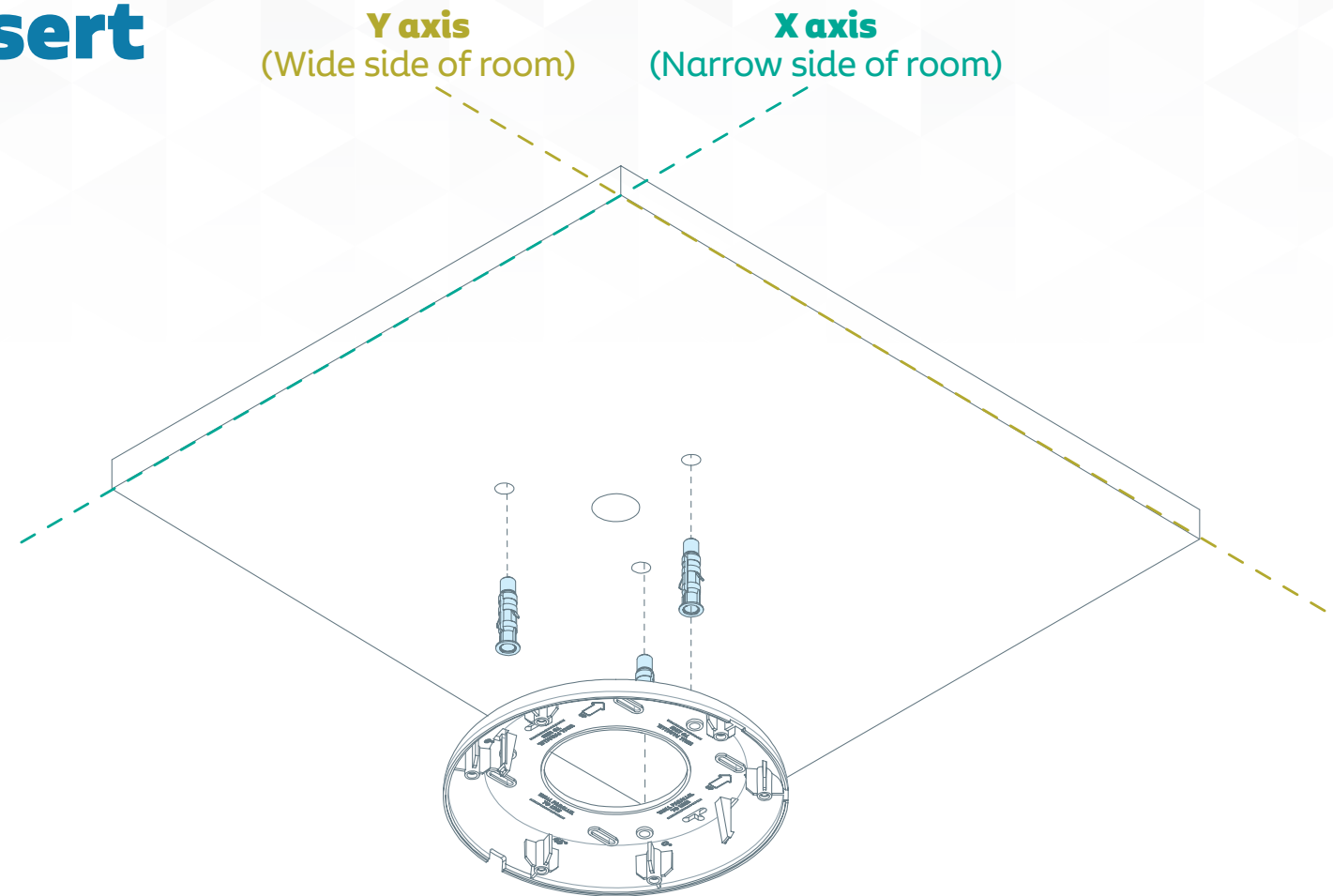


Y axis
(Wide side of room)



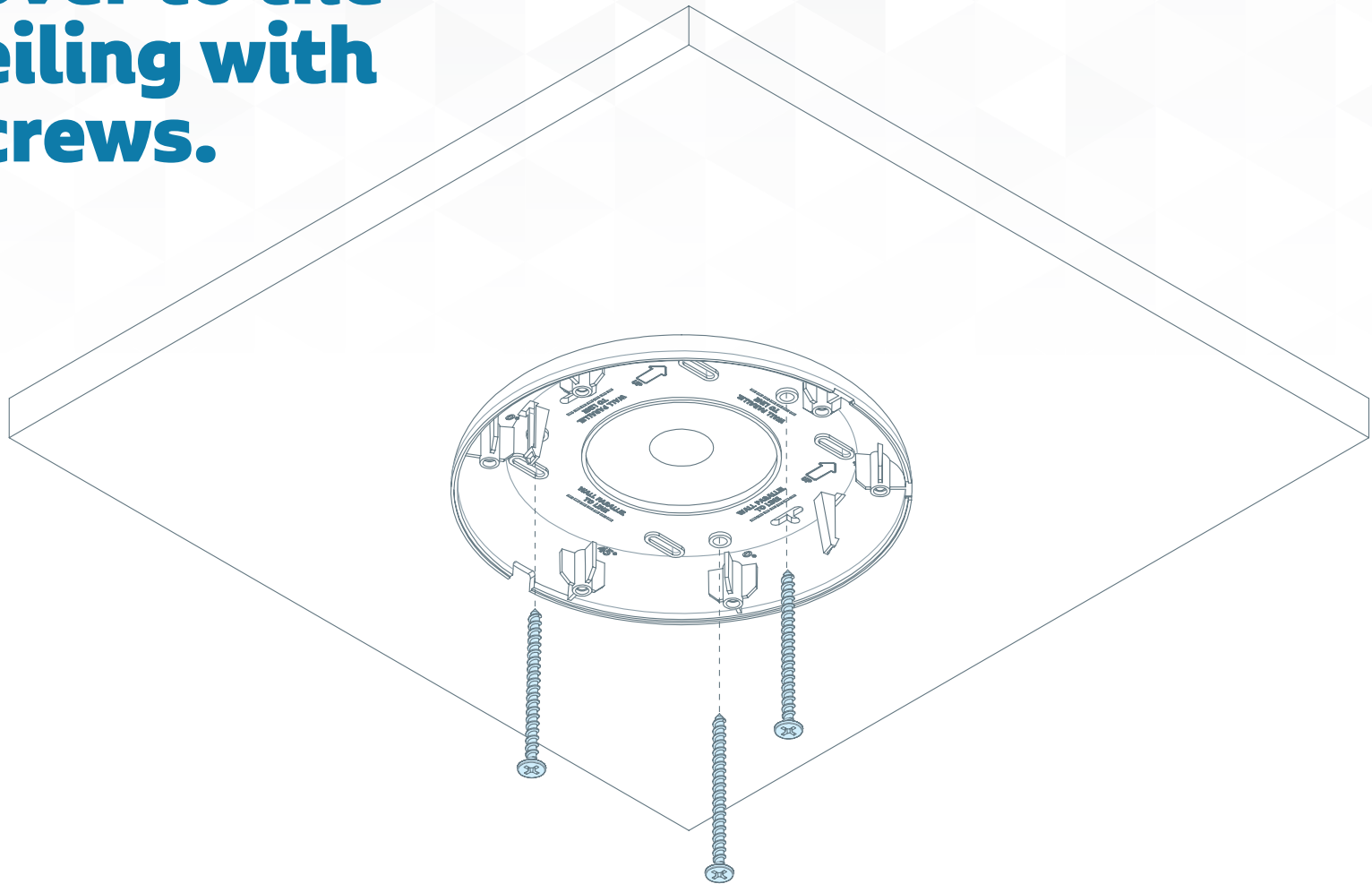

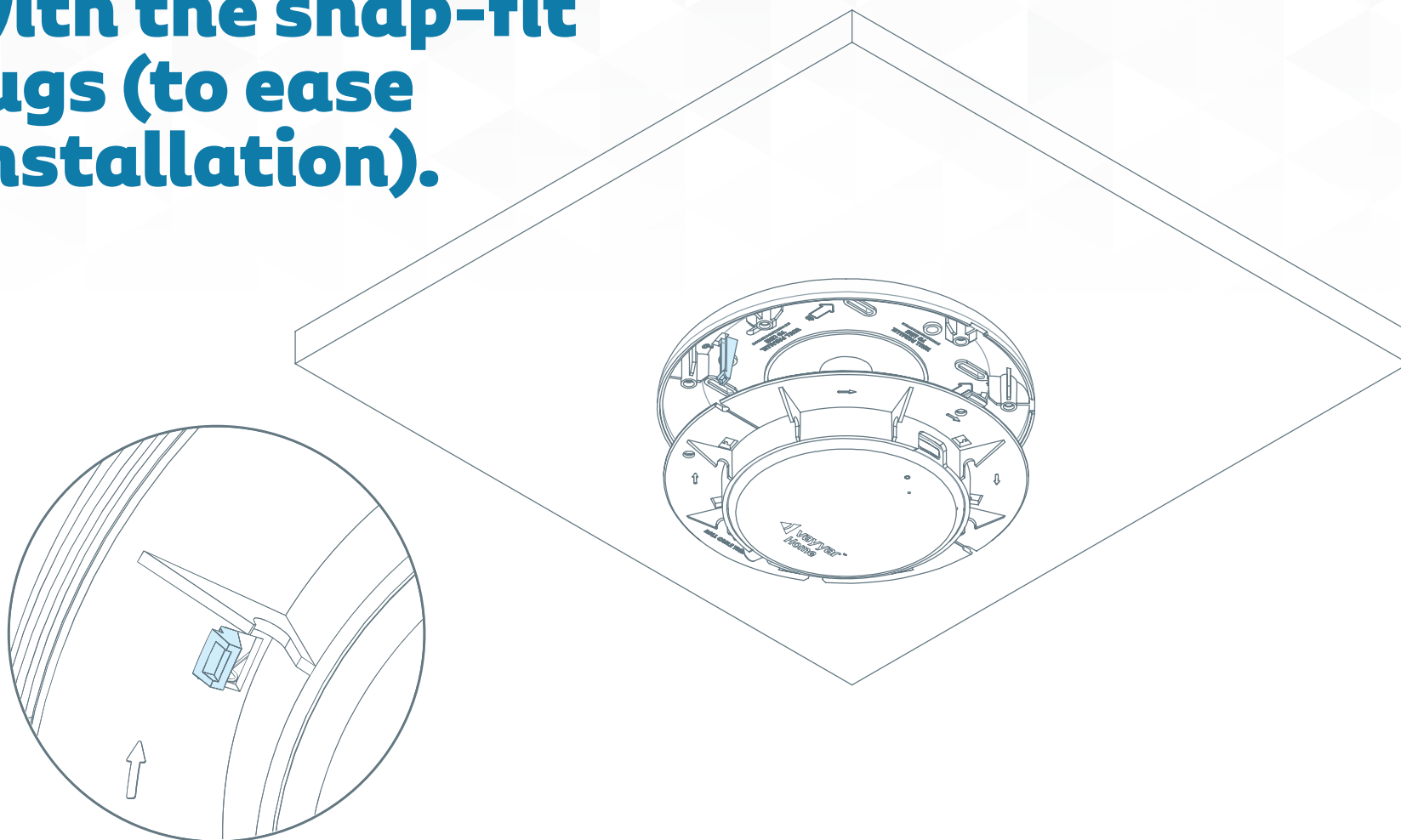
Align the holes between the parts according to the required orientation (0°/45°).



Note: Ceiling mounting with a 45-degree rotation is recommended for better coverage.

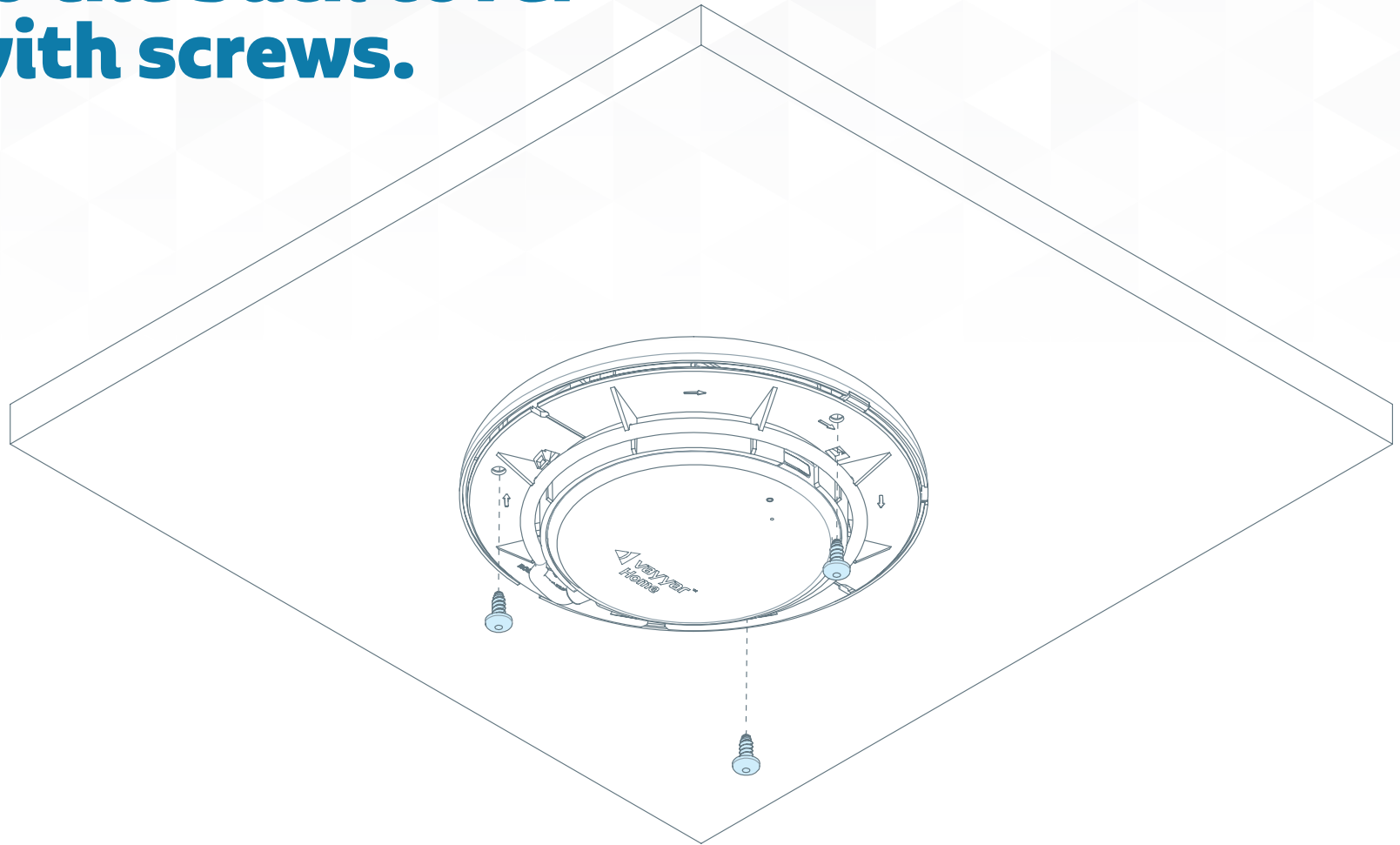

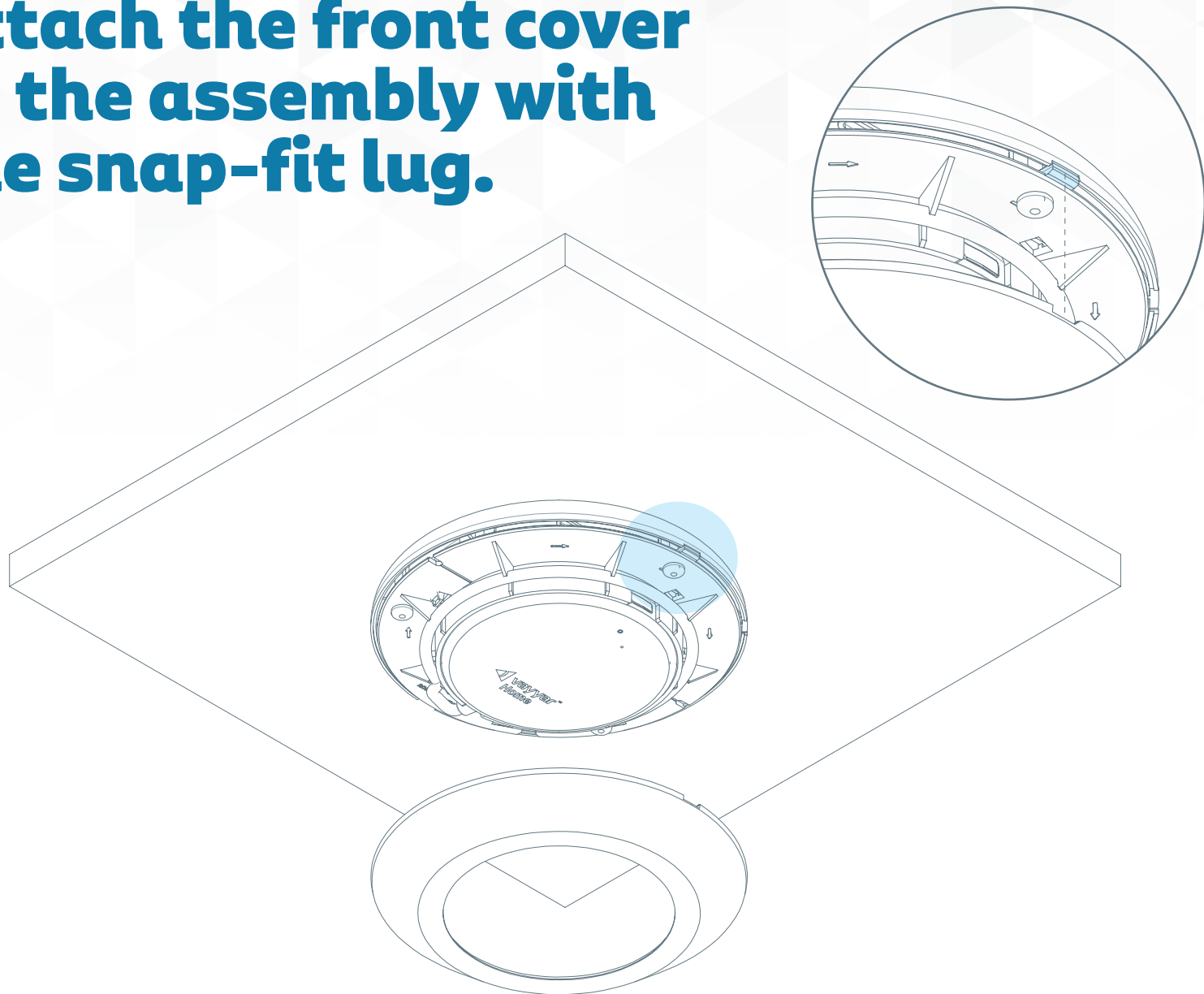

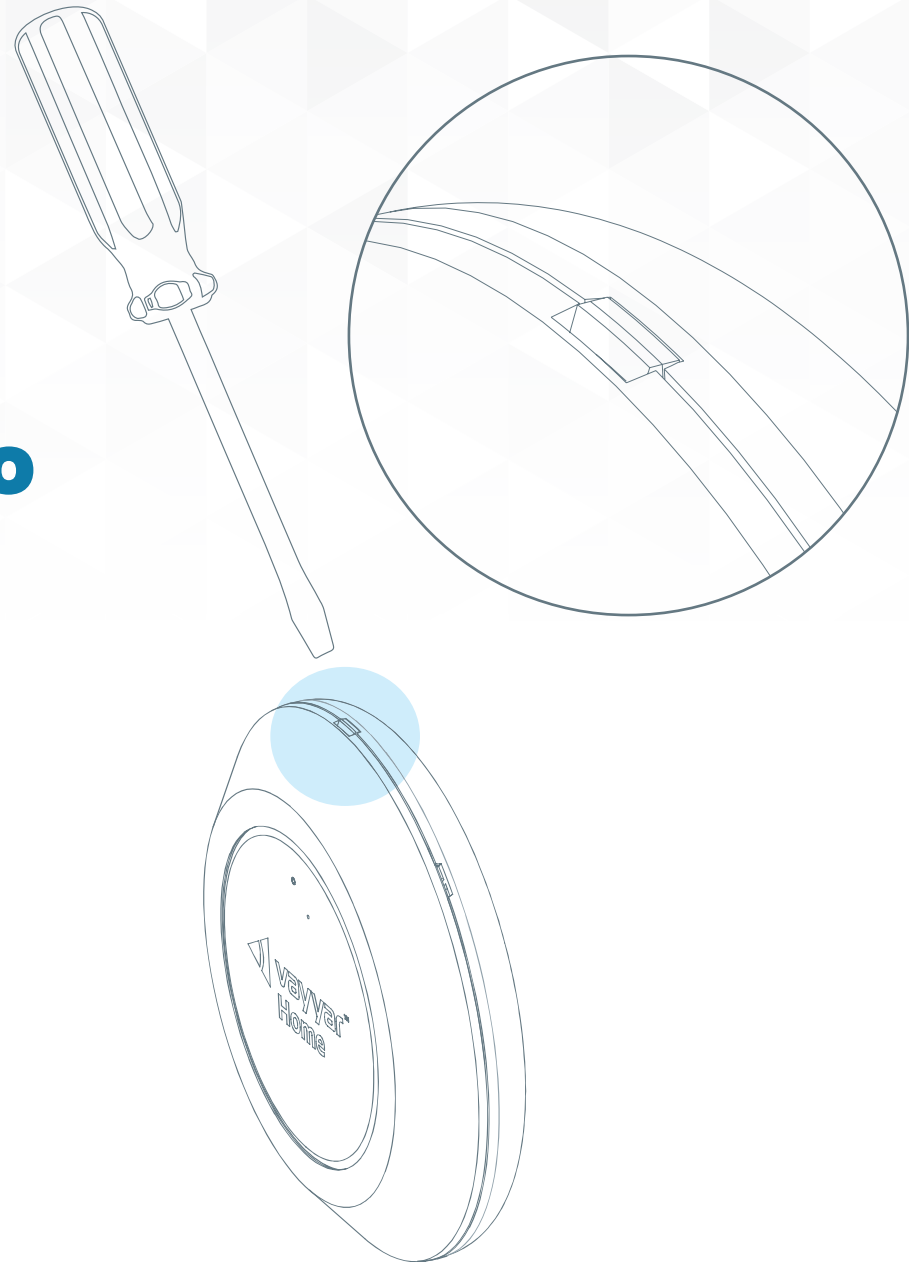


Disassembly instructions



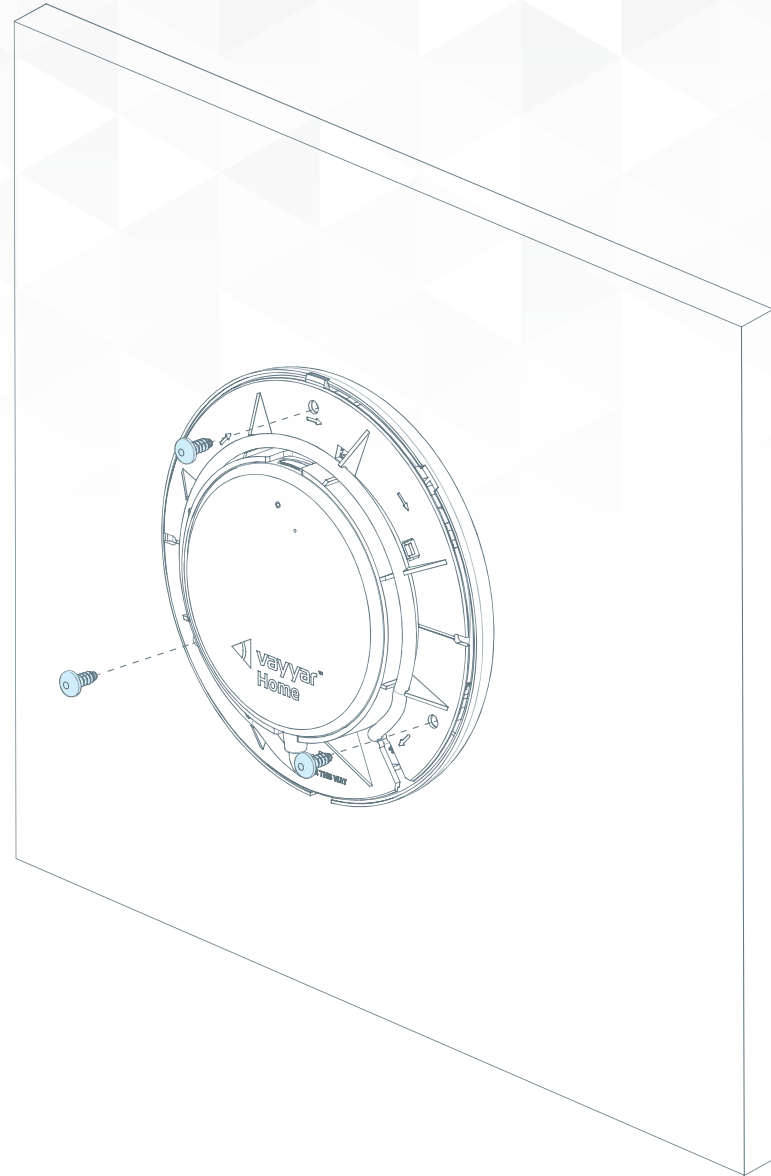

Release the snap-fit joint by inserting a flat-headed screwdriver into the top slot.



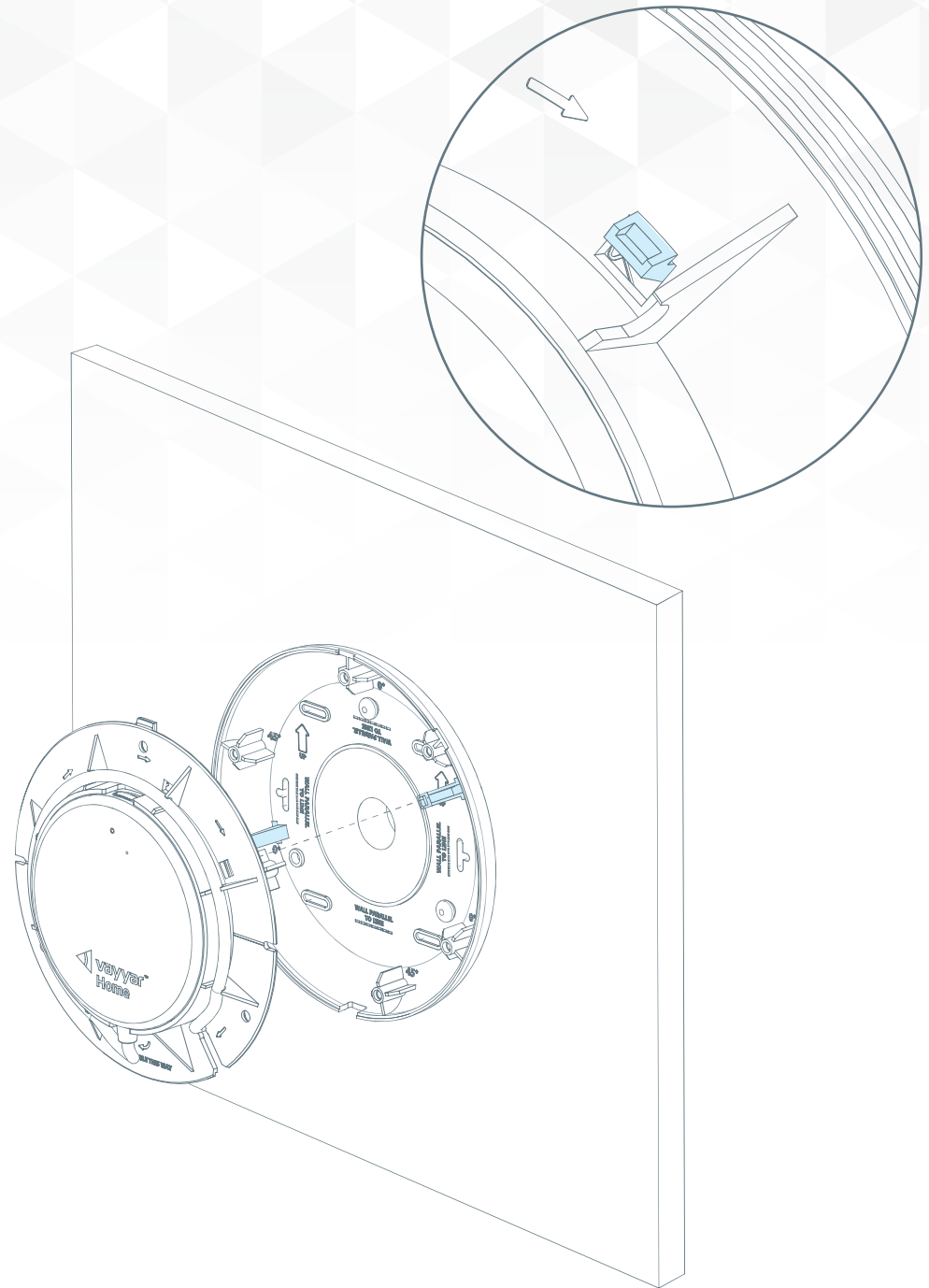

Detach the screws from the chassis.



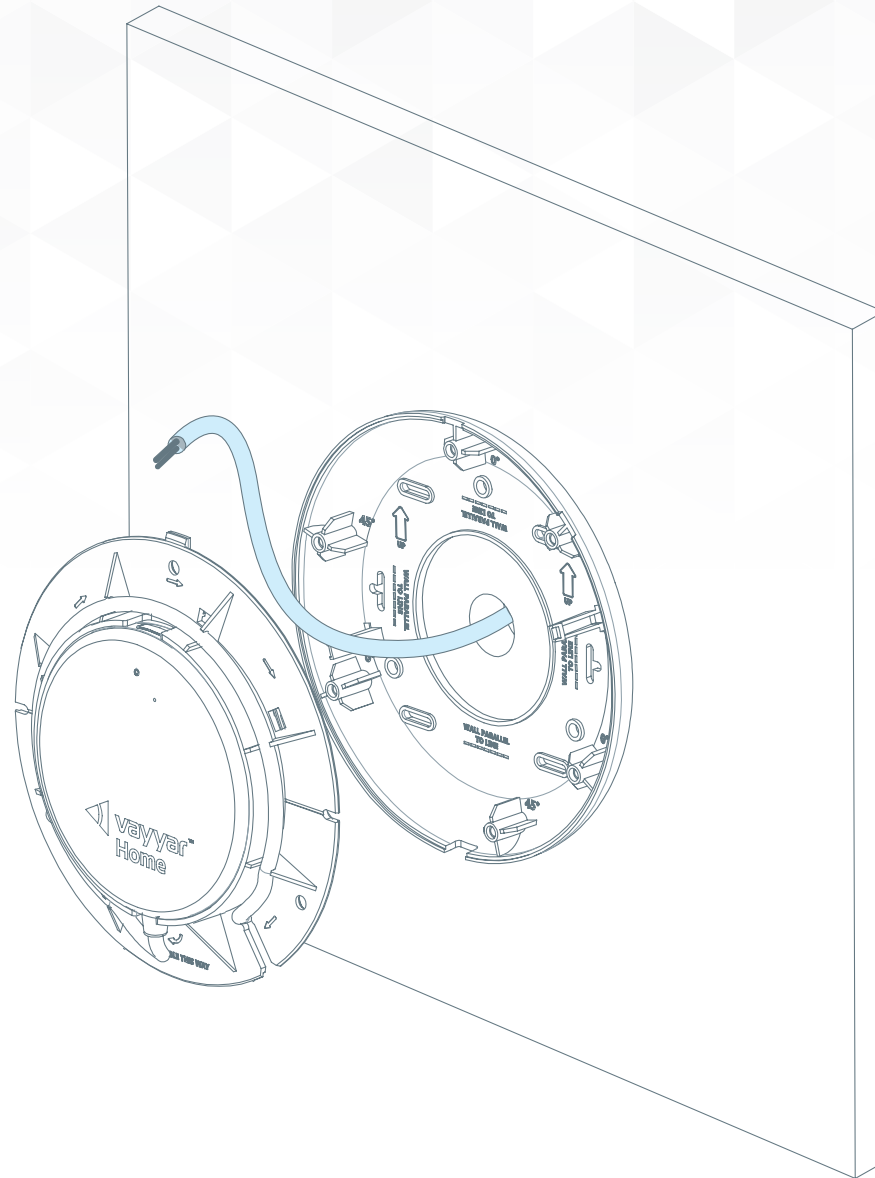

Push the snap-fit lugs towards the center and manually detach the chassis from the back cover.



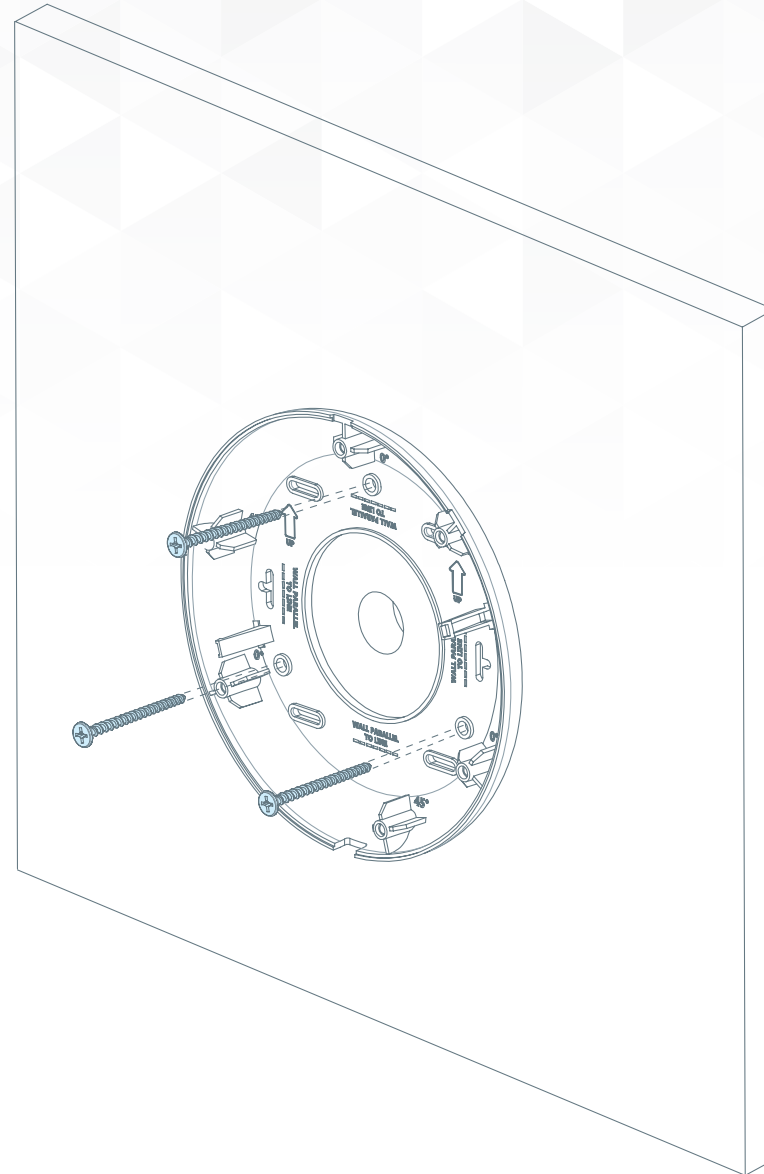
