3. Charge the Battery

Plug the supplied DC 5V 3A charger to an AC wall outlet, then connect the other end of USB to DC cable to the DC IN socket on the side of PV-1000AHD. The green LED indicator will turn on when the battery is charging. The green LED will turn off when battery is fully charged.
