1. For best results, only use type CR2032 battery.
2. Install only new battery of the same type in your product.
3. Failure to insert battery in the correct polarity, as indicated in the battery compartment, may shorten the life of the batteries and causes the batteries to leak.
4. Do not dispose battery in fire

To replace battery:

- 1) Pull out the battery tray & remove battery
- 2) Insert new CR2032 battery with + sign facing down
- 3) Close tray
