Use tips:

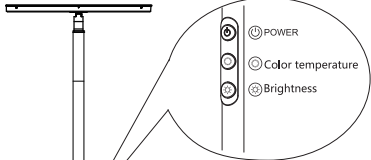
*The remote controllor requires two AAA batteries.
*Pairing is not required before using.

If the remote control fails to work, we suggest you to re-pair with the following methods:
1.Turn on the power switch;
2. Unplug the power cord three times in a row and reconnect it, the floor lamp will flash quickly, and then you can Long press the "⊙" button of the remote controller about 3 seconds within 1 mins until the lights flash quickly.

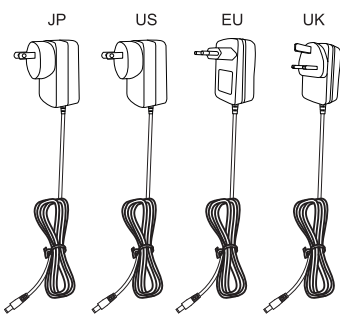

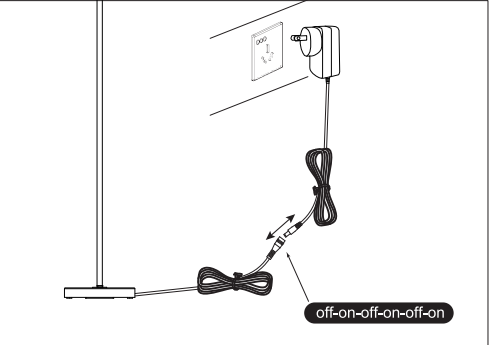

Tips

1.If you want to cancel the pairing between the controller and the floor lamp. Please turn off-on-off-on-off-on the power for 3 times.

2.There is a magnet on the back of the remote controller, which can be adsorbed on any iron metal surface such as floor lamp pole.

WARNING:

Cut off the power before installation.

Keep it away from flammables and fire source.

Replaceing and clean to avoid electricity touched.

Lamp is operated in dimming circuit

Keep it away from water.

Assemble the lamp according to the instructions and do not rebuild.

Do not stare at the lamp for a long time.

Assemble,take apart or move the lamp gently.

Please do not cover anything on the lamp head and avoid bending and bumping the lamp pole.

Keep it away from children.
