

Bluetooth 4.1 Headset D1	EN
<p>In order to normally and safely use the headset, please read this user manual in detail before use and preserve it.</p> <p>Matters needing attention to use the headset:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Please reasonably control the volume and time when using the headset. 2. Do not use the headset in the potentially dangerous environment in order to guarantee the safety. 3. A driver must not use the headset to listen music, call or answer the phone in driving as far as possible which could cause distraction. 4. Please put the headset on the places where children cannot touch to avoid danger caused by improper use. 5. Please do not use the headset when washing to prevent the tone quality or the headset from being damaged. 6. Please avoid continuous increase of volume to prevent you from not hearing the surrounding sound, and please adjust the volume if you feel tinnitus or adjust the volume to a suitable level. 7. Please immediately stop using the headset if you feel bad, piquant or other untoward reaction when using the headset. 8. Please avoid storing or using the headset in the environment with the temperature lower than -10DEG C or higher than 50DEG C, otherwise the service life of the headset will be reduced. <p>Charging and battery: before the headset is charged by the charging device, please firstly inspect the charging device whether is the original device or not.</p> <p>Warning: the headset must be charged by the matching charging device, the mismatched charging device will damage the headset, the direct voltage must be 5V, and the electric current shall be more than 100mA(5V/100mA).</p> <p>Charging of the headset: The headset uses the built-in rechargeable batteries are adopted for the headset. Do not take out the battery from the headset to prevent the headset from being damaged.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Please turn off the headset before charging. 2. Insert the USB cable into the charge hole of the headset, and the other end is connected to the charge hole of other charging device. Then the headset is charging, and the red light constantly turns on when charging. 3. After 1.5 to 2 hours, the headset is fully charged, the red light goes out and the blue light constantly turns on after full charging. 4. Low battery when the voltage of the battery is lower than 3.2V, the red indicator light of the headset will flicker, meanwhile, the headset will sound warning tone, and then the headset will be charged. 	<p>Package content of the headset: A pair of Bluetooth headset, One user manual, Illustration diagram for the headset, One USB cable</p> 
<p>Switch on Slightly push up the ON/OFF key to switch on the headset which will sound the warning tone, and the blue light flickers. The headset is in the pairing mode immediately, and the red light and the blue light flicker alternately.</p> <p>Switch off Lightly push down the ON/OFF key to switch off the headset which will sound the warning tone, and the red light flickers once then turns off.</p> <p>Pairing step of the Bluetooth:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Please control the distance between the Bluetooth headset and the mobile phone (other device) to be connecting within one meter. 2. Switch on the headset, and make sure the headset is in the pairing mode, and the red light and the blue light flicker alternately at the moment. 3. Turn on the Bluetooth function on the mobile phone or other device needing to be connected at the same time, and the Bluetooth headset will be automatically reconnected with the mobile phone. <p>Answer the call:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. After being connected with the mobile phone, the headset will sound the warning tone when the mobile phone ringing. 2. Click the multifunctional key or use your phone to answer the call. <p>Hang up: Click the multifunctional key or use "hang up" button on your phone to end the call.</p> <p>Reject the call:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The headset will sound the warning tone when receiving a call. 2. When hearing the warning tone from the headset, long press the multifunctional key for about 2 seconds, or use your phone to reject the call. <p>Redial the last number: Double click the multifunctional key to redial the last number which is called by the phone.</p> <p>Three-party calling: (phone feature)</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. During the first call, when answering the first call, click the multifunctional key to hold the first call and answer the second call. 2. When holding the first call and answering the second call, click the multifunctional key to end the second call and switch to the first call. <p>Mute the phone: Click the multifunctional key to pause the music; click the multifunctional key again to play the music.</p> <p>Volume adjustment and song selection: When answering the call or hearing the music, long press the volume button to increase or lower the volume. Click the volume button to select the next song.</p> <p>Disconnecting the headset and the Bluetooth on the mobile phone:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Switch off the headset, or turn off the Bluetooth function on the mobile 	<p>phone. Or move the headset 20 meters (about 60 feet) or the longer distance away from the mobile phone.</p> <p>Connecting the paired headset with the mobile phone again:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Control the distance between the Bluetooth headset and the mobile phone (other device used for connecting) within one meter. 2. Switch on the headset which is in the reconnection mode immediately, and the red light and the blue light flicker alternately. 3. Turn on the Bluetooth search function on the mobile phone or other device needing to be connected at the same time, and the Bluetooth headset will be automatically reconnected with the mobile phone. <p>Answer the call:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. After being connected with the mobile phone, the headset will sound the warning tone when the mobile phone ringing. 2. Click the multifunctional key or use your phone to answer the call. <p>Hang up: Click the multifunctional key or use "hang up" button on your phone to end the call.</p> <p>Reject the call:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. <p>FAQ</p> <p>1. Why the Bluetooth headset cannot match with the mobile phone? Answer: please make sure that the headset is not switched off. Or make sure that the headset is in the pairing mode or the reconnection mode, or try to connect the headset with other Bluetooth device to confirm whether the headset is properly operated or not, and inspect whether the Bluetooth search function on the mobile phone is opened or not; and inspect the Bluetooth search on the device and delete/cancel the headset, and the headset is reconnected according to the manual.</p> <p>2. Why the headset cannot start? Answer: please inspect the battery remaining capacity of the headset.</p> <p>3. Can the battery of the headset be replaced? Answer: cannot, and the non-detachable lithium polymer battery is adopted for the headset.</p> <p>4. Can the Bluetooth headset when driving? Answer: the communication type headset can be used when driving, it does not suggest using the headset when driving.</p> <p>5. The headset is disconnected with the mobile phone within 10 meters. Answer: please inspect whether the metal or other materials interfering transmission are in the short distance or not, as the wireless technology, the Bluetooth is sensitive to the object between the headset and the connected device.</p> <p>6. After being connected with the computer or mobile phone? Answer: the communication type headset can be used when the output channel of the computer is designed as Bluetooth audio device, and whether the volume of the computer/mobile phone.</p> <p>7. After the headset is connected with the mobile phone, can use the headset control the application program on the mobile phone? Answer: the software setting of the application program of the equipment is different, so part of the application program cannot be controlled by the headset.</p> <p>8. The headset cannot be charged. Answer: please check whether the USB cable is fixedly connected with the headset and the charge hole and normally operates or not. If using computer, please make sure that the USB cable is started and fixedly connected. Or start the headset and switch off again.
