

# Installation

1  
Plug your Zip into a 120V wall outlet centrally located in your home or office.



A red light should illuminate, indicating the Zip is powered on and ready.

2  
Download the free Switchmate App from the Google Play or Apple App Store onto your phone.



Launch the Switchmate Home App and walk through the simple installation.

Press the Logo button on the Zip to pair to your smartphone.

The blue light will turn steady for 3 seconds, indicating the smartphone and the Zip have successfully paired with each other.

Once the smartphone and the Zip are paired, the Zip will start searching nearby routers. Enter your Wi-Fi password, when the password is accepted, the GREEN LED will become steady for 3 seconds before going off.

# Troubleshooting

Q: I am having trouble getting my smartphone to connect to my SimplySmart Home Zip.


A: Different phones may behave differently when connecting to SimplySmart Home Zip. When experiencing difficulties, try the following steps:

1. Turn Wi-Fi & Bluetooth off, then turn them back on. Try to connect again.
2. Close the Switchmate Home App & restart the App – try to connect.
3. Restart Smartphone – try to connect.
4. Uninstall the App & download it again.
