1. Camera Status Screen

2. Power/Shutter Button

3. Microphones (3)

2. Universal Tripod Mount

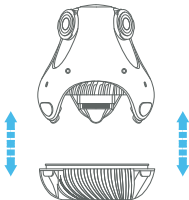

## ④ Getting started

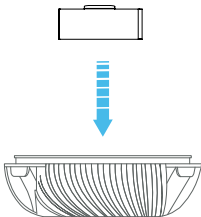

Unlock the 3 clips, hold the top of the camera with one hand and pull gently the magnesium alloy back with the other hand to open the camera bottom door.

Insert the battery following the instructions written on the camera bottom door.

To insert the memory card:



1. Slide gently the memory card lid and open it



2. Insert the memory card into the card slot. Make sure the card label faces up

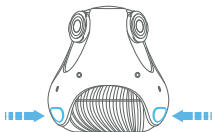
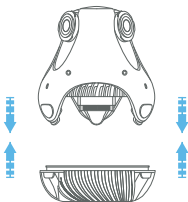


3. Close the lid and slide it to lock the card

Replace the bottom door to its original position. Press the bottom door on the camera and lock it by pushing firmly on the 3 clips.



# 5

Charge the battery by connecting the camera to a computer or other USB charging adapter using the USB cable provided. The camera status screen turns on and displays the charging status.



Once the battery is fully charged the following icon shows on the camera status screen

*NOTICE: Using a wall charger other than a 5V 1A wall charger can damage the 360cam battery. Only use chargers marked: output 5V 1A. If you do not know the voltage and current of your charger, use the included USB cable to charge the camera from your computer. When charging with a computer, be sure that the computer is connected to a power source. If the camera status light does not turn on, use a different USB port. The included lithium-ion battery comes partially charged. No damage occurs to the camera or battery if used prior to a full charge. For more battery information, see Battery.*

*WARNING: Use caution when using your 360cam as part of your active lifestyle. Always be aware of your surroundings to avoid injury to yourself and others. Abide by all local laws when using your 360cam and related accessories.*

Press and hold the Power/Shutter button until the camera battery level bar appears. When the camera status screen displays "Video", your camera is on.

Press and hold the Power/Shutter button until the camera status screen displays the 3 "OFF" letters. Release the button. Your camera is off.

The 360cam features several camera modes. To cycle through the modes, press the Mode button repeatedly.



Switching between video and photo modes on the 360cam requires a few seconds, during this loading time the camera displays an animated mustache on the camera status screen.

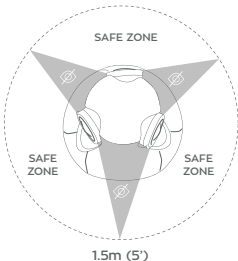
# Camera Modes

These modes appear:

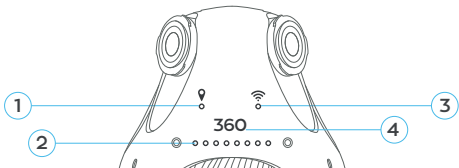
<b>Video</b>	Record video
<b>Photo</b>	Capture a single photo
<b>TimeL</b>	Capture a photo every X seconds
<b>Burst</b>	Capture a serie of photos during X seconds
	Adjust general camera settings
	Loading video / photo mode

## 🚫 Be Aware of the Blind Spots

There are four (4) blind spots: one between each lens and one on the bottom of the camera. For best results, avoid placing your subject/focal point closer than 1.5 meters (5') in-between the optics on the camera.

## Camera Default Settings

The 360cam powers up with the following default settings:

Video	25 fps
Photo	5 sec self-timer
TimeLapse	Every 5 sec
Burst	3 fps for 5 sec
GPS	Off
Wireless	Off

*NOTICE: Those default settings can be changed by using the 360cam companion app (Available on iOS, Android & Windows phone).*



## Micro SD Cards

The 360cam is compatible with:

Type	microSD - microSDHC - micro SDXC
Capacity	8GB - 16GB - 32GB - 64GB - 128GB

- You must use a microSD card with a **Class 10** or a **UHS-1** rating.
- GIROPTIC recommends using brand name memory cards for maximum reliability in high-vibration activities.
