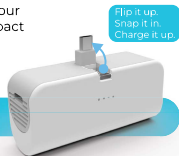

Flip up the USB-C charging tip. Insert it into the charging port of your device. Charging will start automatically.

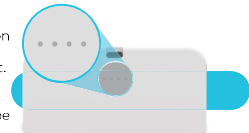
Note: Charging with the USB-C tip will only work if your charging port is USB-C.

There are 4 LED lights on PowerSnap to indicate how much charge is left.

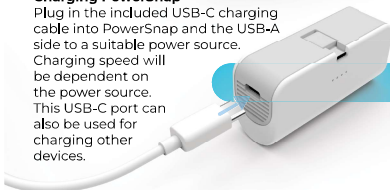
When charging, the battery remaining will be indicated.



When not charging, you can press the button to check the amount of battery left.

Charging PowerSnap

Plug in the included USB-C charging cable into PowerSnap and the USB-A side to a suitable power source. Charging speed will be dependent on the power source. This USB-C port can also be used for charging other devices.



You can also use the USB-C port on the side of PowerSnap to charge an additional device simultaneously using a USB-C charging cable.
