— A feature:

Bluetooth specification: Bluetooch 4.1 + EDR specification.

Battery capacity: 120mAH.

Bluetooth protocol: HFP v1.6, HSP v1.2, A2DP v1.3, AVRCP v1.5, SPP v1.2

Audio performance: Support SBC, MP3, AAC, stereo.

Bluetooth distance: 10 meters (accessibility).

Working time: 4 hours.

answer / hang up the phone, call waiting, volume adjustment, up and down the first switch, the music play / pause, power and connected to the voice prompts, maximum / minimum volume of voice prompts, telephone redial, Bluetooth phone home.

can simultaneously connect two mobile phones.

power display

— The operating instructions:

Power: Long press the answer key to boot, until you hear a tone switched (voice prompt boot) and the light blue lights flashing.

Bluetooth pairing: Press answer key to boot, until you hear a tone paired (voice prompts to enter pairing mode) and the indicator light alternately flashes red and blue light, to find the appropriate name Bluetooth devices on your phone, click on the device name on the phone screen Bluetooth pairing After successful pairing, paired hear the tone (voice prompts paired connected), blue indicator light flashes.

off: long press the answer button off (the voice prompts shutdown).

Charging: When charging, the indicator red light, blue light after full.

Charging voltage: 5V

Charging way: MICRO 5PIN USB port.

volume up: Press the volume up button to adjust the volume,

volume down: Press volume down button to adjust the volume.

a song on switching: short press volume down key on a first switch.

next song switch: Short press volume up button to switch to the next header.

music playback: Short press the answer key.

Music Pause: short press the answer key.

answer / hang up: press the answer key.

phone Redial: Press twice to redial the last call answer key number.

2 mobile phone connection: first open at two mobile phones, Bluetooth device is turned into pairing mode, two phones at the same time find the appropriate Bluetooth device name, then click on the device name on-screen pairing two phones (voice prompts pairing successfully connected, the second device is connected successfully).
