

- direction as shown, and pull some paper outside the cutter. Close the cover of thepaper container to finish printing




SIM Card & TF Card Installation


1. Take out the back cover, and the card sockets will be shown.









SIM Card & TF Card Uninstallation

- 2. Withdraw the metal tray from the middle of the two deck. 3. Push the metal tray into the middle of the of two deck again.








PSAM Card & TF Card Uninstallation




