
Features

- Stream music from Bluetooth enabled devices
- Compatible with iPad, iPhone, iPod, Android, Windows and other phones and tablets
- Built-in cradle holds iPod Touch, iPhone, iPad, Android, Windows and other brand phones and tablets
- Built-in FM radio

Description of Parts (Main unit)

General Operation

- Press Power On/Off Switch at the rear of the unit to ON position to turn on the unit with red LED light on.
- Press the Mode button repeatedly to select the playback source.
- Press the VOL +/- buttons to adjust volume level.
- Press the Mute button on the remote control to turn off the sound. Press it again to turn it off.
- If the unit is not used for a long period of time, turn off the unit and pull out the plug.

Using Bluetooth

- Keep your Tower Speaker and Bluetooth enabled device within 3 feet of each other during the pairing process.
- Press Power On/Off Switch to turn on the unit.
- Press Mode button on the panel or remote control repeatedly until you hear an indication tone and the blue LED flashes.
- Turn on the Bluetooth on your Mobile Phone or Tablet or Computer.
- It will search for available Bluetooth devices.
- Bluetooth Tower Speaker would appear as "SL TOWER SPKR" in the list of searched devices. Select it from the ED available list of devices.
- If required, enter the password '0000' to confirm pairing.
- Once paired successfully, you would hear indication tone and the blue LED will stay on.
- If you fail to pair it within a few seconds or you want to pair it with a new device, please repeat the steps outlined above.
- Select your favorite song at the Bluetooth source device and music would now stream through the speaker.

Play Music from Bluetooth devices.

Make sure the Bluetooth connection between the unit and the device is active.

- Press Play/Pause button to suspend momentarily the playing track. Press Play/Pause button again to resume playing.
- Press Next Track button to skip forward to the next track or Previous Track button to skip backward to the previous track.

Note: The Bluetooth Tower Speaker will connect automatically with the last paired device when its Bluetooth function is on.

Listen to the radio by auto search channel function

- Press the Power ON/OFF Switch to turn on the unit.
- Press Mode button on the panel or remote control repeatedly until you hear FM radio signal/station and the blue LED flashes.
- Press the FM Scan button on the panel or remote control, then the unit will start to search all available stations and store into the memory automatically.

To enhance radio reception ability:

FM: Fully unwind the antenna wire and extend it.

Using Aux-in source

- Press the Power ON/OFF Switch to turn on the unit.
- Plug one end of the included 3.5mm Aux cable to the Aux in port on the right side of the speaker, the blue LED will stay on.
- Plug the other end of the cable to your device (e.g. iPod / iPad / MP3 player).
- Use your device's controls for music playback.

Note: Once Aux cable is connected to the speaker in Bluetooth mode, music through the Bluetooth will be stopped. Media can be controlled only through source devices while playing music in Auxiliary mode (except VOL +/- and/or Mute).

Troubleshooting

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Low sound level	Source (Tablet, Mobile Phone, Laptop, etc.) volume too low.	Adjust source volume.
No sound at all.	Source (Tablet, Mobile Phone, and Laptop) turned off. Speaker turned off. Volume turned down source. Media paused on source.	Turn the source on. Turn the speaker on. Adjust volume source. Play media from source.
Cannot Pair	Bluetooth Disconnected	Turn OFF the Speaker; and then Turn ON the speaker after about 30 seconds. Keep your Bluetooth Speaker and Bluetooth enabled device within 3 feet of each other during the pairing process. After a successful pairing, the LED indicator light will become solid green in colour.

Care and Maintenance
Clean the unit with a soft, damp cloth. Never use chemicals or hard abrasives.
Keep this unit away from wet or damp surroundings.
