6.Volume button:To increase or reduce volume of the device.

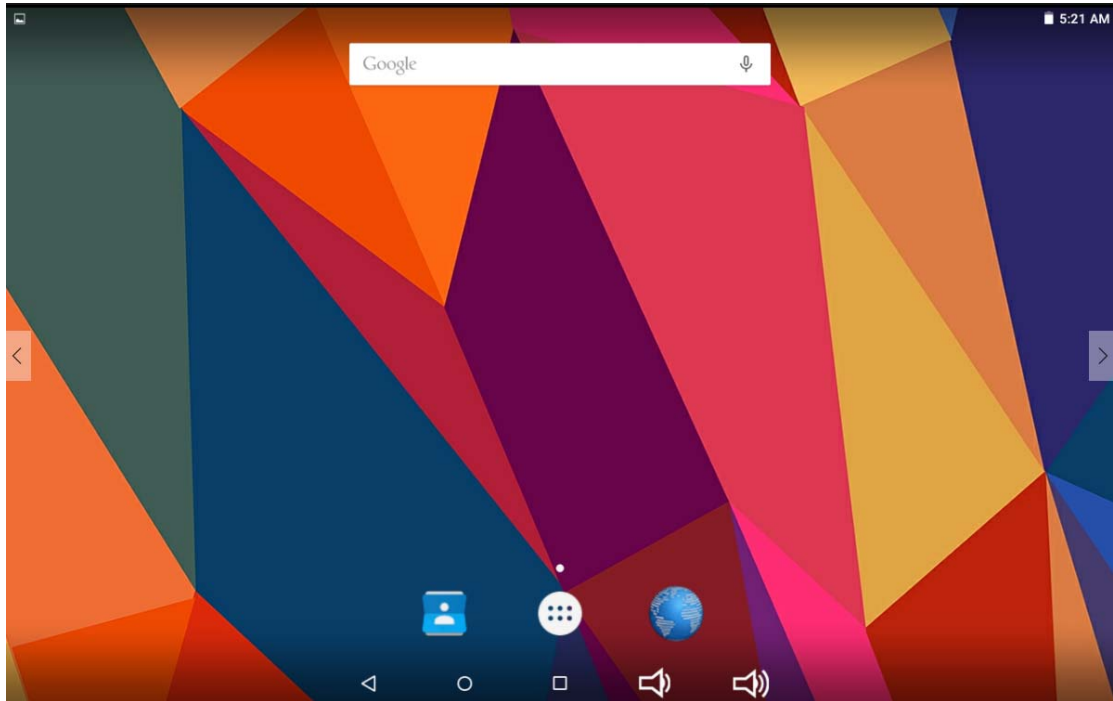
7.Earphone Jack: the jack support outputs the audio signal to a loudspeaker or Headset.

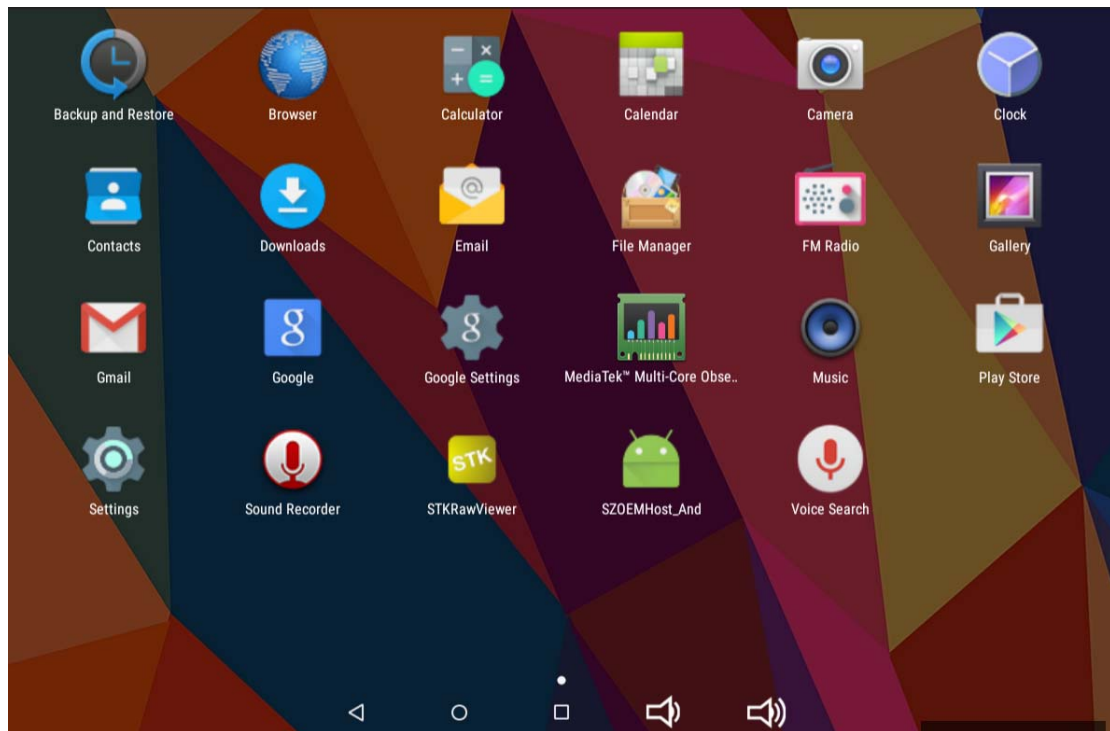

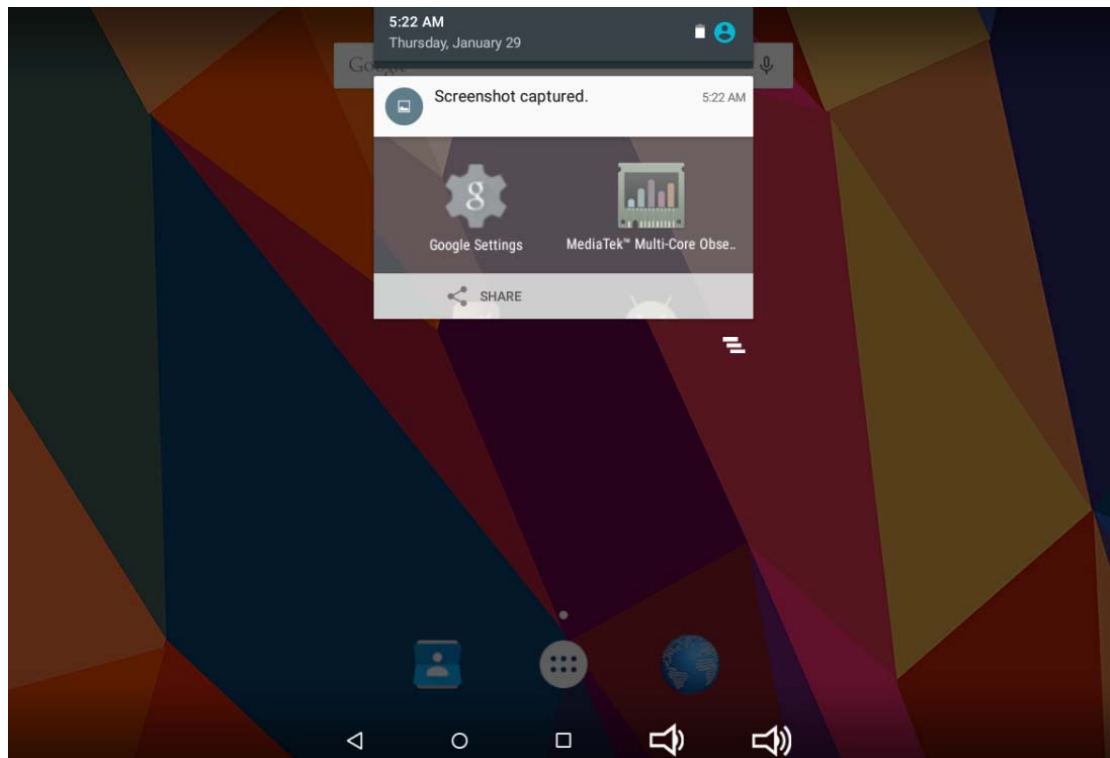


2. application center

Enter application center; default Google application; by clicking each application can enter the stage of use; the right mouse button to achieve the return function.



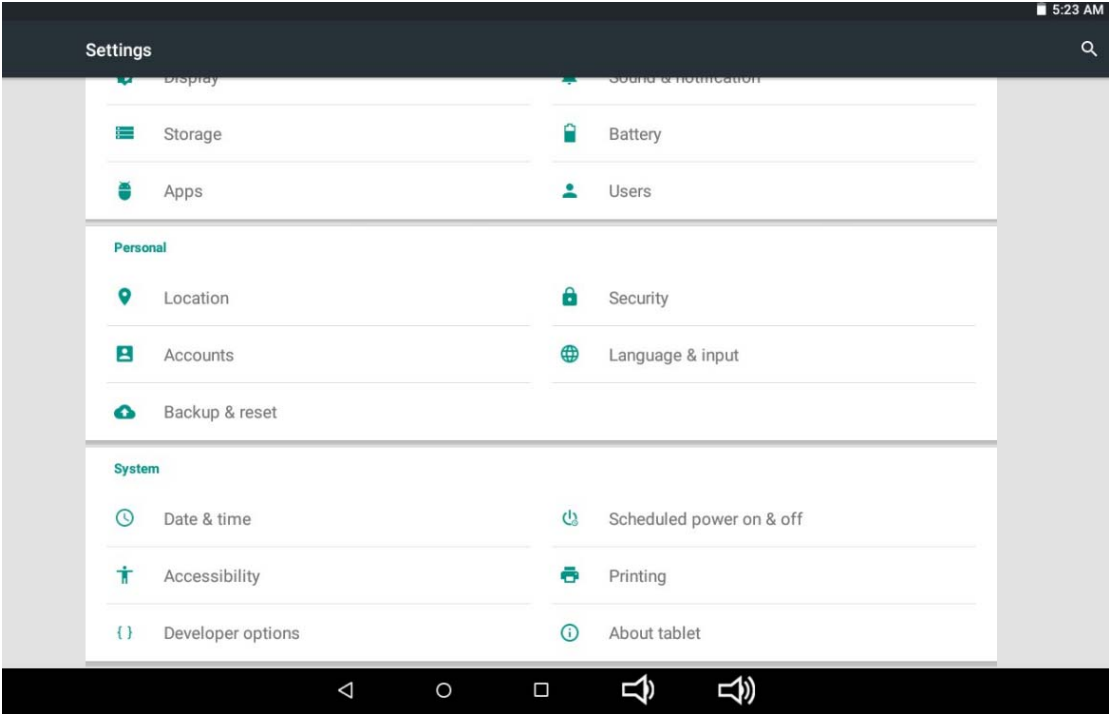
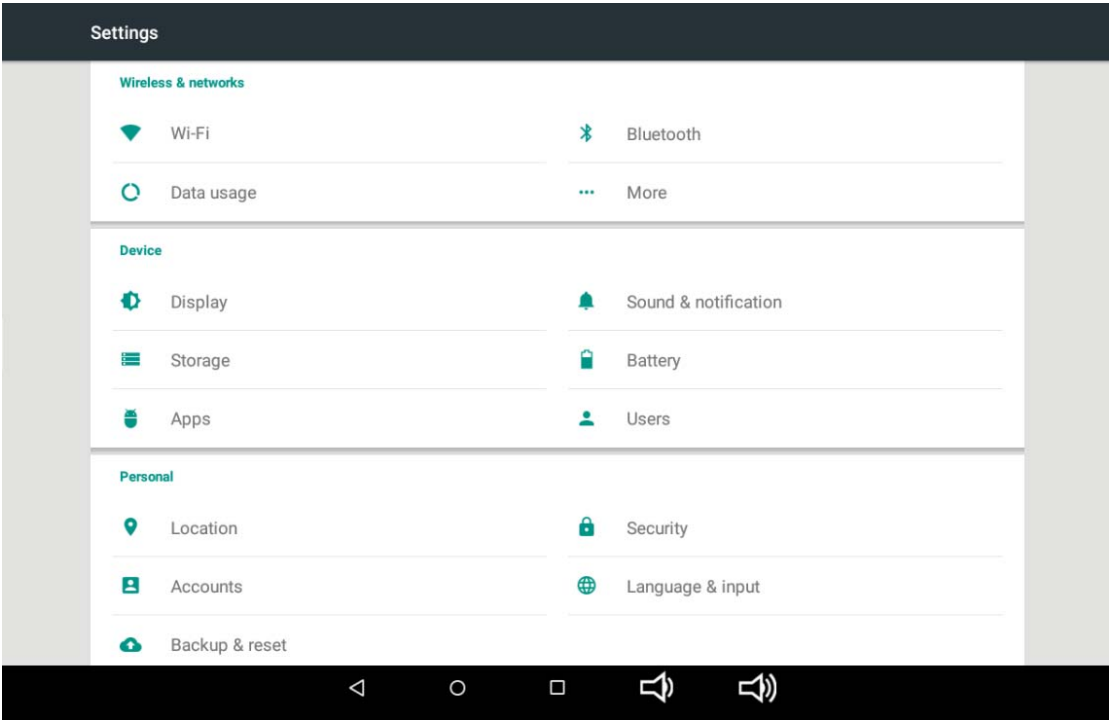
The upper middle of the desktop can be pulled down to view the latest notification information.
