Safety Precautions

- Following installation, please check before each ride that all securing mechanisms (such as screws, fasteners, etc.) are in good condition and secure.
- Ensure the battery is properly installed and secured by the locking mechanism.
- The Balight is rated for IP65 waterproofing, however, please do not submerge the product in water.
- Should excessive vibrations occur while in

use, please check all securing mechanisms (such as screws, fasteners, etc.) as soon as possible. Ensure that all securing mechanisms are properly installed and in good working condition.

5. For your safety, please do not check/watch your Balight display while cycling.

6. Please do not use the Balight in extreme weather/temperature conditions that can be above 40°C (104°F) or below -20°C (4°F).

7. It is recommended that the installation be completed by adults; for people underage, adult supervision is advised.

8. Please use the product on even surface roads; bumpy roads may cause damage to the product.

Note that adjust your Balight display to a brighter setting will drain your battery faster

Maintenance Guide

- Clean and dry your assembled Balight product regularly. When cleaning, use a clean, damp cloth. Do not wash the product under running water (like a faucet or water hose).
- Do not use abrasive cleaners to clean your Balight.
- Do not open the enclosure or disassemble your Balight in a way not illustrated in the instructions.
- Do not use your Balight if the display mechanism is cracked.
- Do not place your Balight in a dishwasher, washing machine or dryer.
- Substances in this product may harm the environment or cause injury if disposed or handled improperly.
- Do not expose your Balight to extremely high

or low temperatures.





- Do not leave your Balight in direct sunlight for an extended period of time.





Installation

Step 1



Select the appropriate Silicone Placer.




- Fix your wheel.

Step 2


Prepare the Balight Elite and install on the hub. Then install the two LED Bars near the battery slot.





Attach and tighten the Fastener.




Step 6

Install the Magnetic Sensor.





Step 7


Turn on the Balight Elite by pressing the power switch.

Remove the Battery from the Balight Elite.




Insert the Charging Cable into the port on the Battery.




* 5V/2A Charger is recommended. Any normal cell phone charger will also work.

Balight Limited Warranty Statement

WARRANTY COVERAGE

Balight's warranty obligations are limited to the terms set forth below: Balight warrants the hardware product (except battery) against defects in materials and workmanship under normal use for a period of ONE (1) YEAR from the date of original purchase; warrants rechargeable battery (if included) against defects in materials and workmanship under normal use for a period of SIX (6) MONTHS from the date of original purchase. The warranty extends only to the original purchaser. It is not transferable to anyone who subsequently purchases the product from you. It excludes all expendable parts such as packaging and accessories. During the warranty period, only under the circumstance that malfunction is caused by a product defect, at its option Balight will (1) repair the product without additional fee, or (2) replace the product without additional fee. Your Balight warranty period is recalculated upon the replacement or repair of the product.

OBTAINING WARRANTY SERVICE

The service should only be provided by Balight authorized service providers. Contact the Balight dealer from whom you purchased your product for more information. You may also visit our website www.balight.com to locate a Balight service provider.

The products need repair or replacement should be taken or sent to the Balight authorized service providers with INTACT PACKAGE. Warranty card or purchase invoice that is clearly dated should be provided.

This Limited Warranty applies only to the Product manufactured by or for Balight that can be identified by the "Balight" trademark, trade name, or logo






