To whom it may concern,

We hereby respectfully request that under the provision of 47 CFR 0.459 and 0.457 the documents listed below and attached with this application for certification be provided with confidential status.

Permanent Confidentiality

We request permanent confidentiality for the following documents:

- schematics_of_radio.pdf
- operational_description.pdf
- frequency_block_diagram_of_each_radio.pdf
- internal_photos.pdf
- user_manual_in_english_fcc_and_isd.pdf

Enclosed within this application is technical information which we deem to be trade secrets and proprietary. The documents listed above are treated as confidential by us and substantial competitive harm to us could result should they be made available to the public.

We are requesting that the internal photos be held confidential permanently. The devices are installed in a controlled and supervised environment by professionals. They are not accessible to the public. They are out of reach, behind panels or otherwise inaccessible. Additionally, the user guide is only available to trained professionals under NDA that restricts disclosure of the information.

Any exhibit / information for which we have requested permanent confidentiality, but which may not be accorded such treatment by the FCC, should be returned to us.

Short Term Confidentiality

We request temporary short term confidentiality of the documents listed below for 180 days following the date the grant of equipment authorization is issued:

- external_photos.pdf
- Test setup photos from the test reports

These documents contain design information that has not been publicly disclosed prior to the commercial release of the device. Disclosure of this information prior to commercial release would give competitors an unfair market advantage.

It is our understanding that measurement test reports and FCC ID label format cannot be granted as confidential documents and this information will be available for public review once the grant of equipment authorization is issued.
