

Welcome to Taleight: Let's get started!

1/ Wake up your Taleight. Your Taleight will wake up on its own as soon as you power it with a standard micro USB adapter or when you press the multifunction switch on the lower left side of the display. If it does not, charge it for ~45 minutes using a standard 5-volt USB charger. When it wakes up, simply follow the on-screen instructions.

2/ Register your device. Go to www.taleight.tech and create a user account. Once your account is created, login, access the Devices menu and add your Taleight to your account by entering your Taleight Hardware ID, which is shown on the first welcome screen. The Hardware ID is also the last 8 digits of the serial number printed on the labels on the side of the box and on the back of the Taleight display. It looks similar to this: 12345678.



3/ Create your bumper sticker library. You can purchase - or upload your own - bumper stickers through the www.taleight.tech Sticker Store. Purchased or created images are stored in your Library. From there, choose which sticker(s) you want to showcase and then go to the View Schedule page to program how it/they will be displayed on your Taleight. You can set up a simple rotation of your images or choose a specific date and time for each image to be shown.

4/ Install the free Taleight App on your phone. The Taleight app is available for iPhone and Android based smartphones. Search for "Taleight" in the Apple App Store or on Google Play. You will use the app to synchronize your Taleight display with your website account.


5/ Install your Taleight. Your Taleight device should be mounted on your vehicle with the provided gray adhesive pads. Depending on the surface curvature of your vehicle, cut and place the pads either on the sides or the top and bottom of the Taleight display as shown in the illustration to the right.

6/ Power your Taleight. The Taleight has an embedded battery which will power the display even if your car is off. The provided USB cable is used to supplement and recharge the battery. Run this cable between your Taleight and your vehicle's USB port or a cigarette lighter to USB adapter, we recommend an adapter with 2A or better current rating. Use the provided clear tape strips to secure the cable.


