

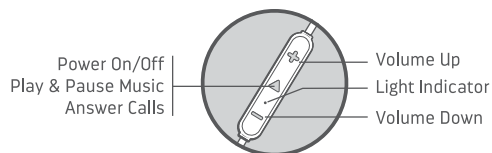
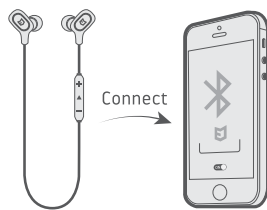

SIDE 2

Pairing Instructions

1. Press and press the Play Button for 7 sec.
Flashing indicator light will signify Power On.
(To Power Off, press button for 4 Seconds).
2. On your mobile device, access your Bluetooth settings.
Adjust your Bluetooth settings to Discoverable Mode (On).
3. While wearing earbuds, select ELWN Rise from the list of Bluetooth devices and listen for the "Connected" tone from your earbuds. This indicates that pairing is complete, and that you are ready to use your Bluetooth earbuds with your mobile device.
4. To confirm pairing is complete, look for the Bluetooth icon  in the status bar of your device.

SIDE 1
