
### Introduction

### Wearing Headset




### Start to use

Method one:

1, Simultaneously press two earphone's power button for 3 seconds till blue light flash and stop, then they will paring themselves, after a few seconds the main earphone's(Left one) blue and red light flash alternately while another earphone blue light flashing means pairing success.

2, Turn on your mobile phone bluetooth and search "TWS-SP01", click to connection.




Method two:

1, Press main earphone's(Left one) power button for 5 seconds till blue and red light flash alternately, then turn on mobile phone bluetooth and search "TWS-SP01", click to connection.

2, Press another earphone's power button for 3 seconds till blue light flash and they will pair themselves, both two earphones blue light flashing means paring success.


Turn on your mobile phone bluetooth search "TWS-SP01" and click to connection.

### Charging for Headset



Red light flash and voice reminding when low power. Using USB cable charging for headset.



USB Interface


Red light means charging, blue light means full.

### Packaging




### Turn on/off

1.Turn on: press power button for 3 seconds



2.Turn off: press power button for 4 seconds



### Operation Method

#### Answer a call

Press turn on key to answer a call when someone calls.

#### End a call

Press turn on key to end a call after talking.

#### Redial the last number

Press main earphone's(Left one) power button for one second when headset is in standby mode.

#### Reject a call

Press the turn on key for 1 second.

#### Playing music

Press the turn on key once when standby.

#### Pause music

Press the turn on key once when playing music.

#### Skip to next song

Double press turn on key skip to next song.

### Charging Precautions

1.Using the output voltage of DC5V charger like computer's USB port or mobile phone charger with USB port.

(You must choose the regular manufacturers of safety certified charger);

2.During charging the red light on; full power the blue light on.

3.Repeated charging and discharging will decreased battery performance, it is normal for rechargeable batteries.
