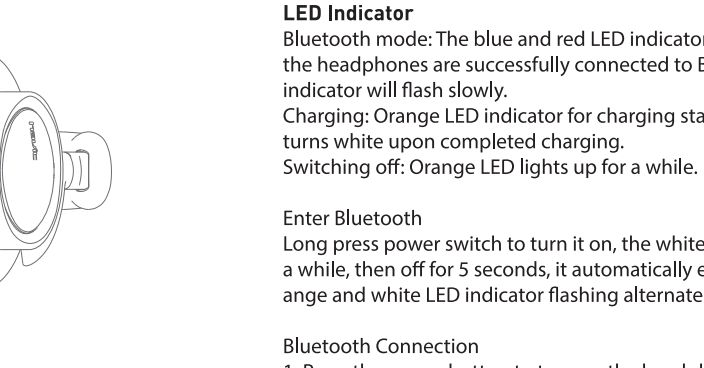

### Buttons Instructions

Note: The headphones can be used as wired headphones, if connecting with a dual 3.5mm audio cable. The buttons will not be functional in wired mode. Before switching from wired to Bluetooth mode, please stop any music in wired mode, in order to prevent double sound.



1. PREV/VOL+ Bluetooth mode: Short press for PREV, Long press for VOL+
2. NEXT/VOL- Bluetooth mode: Short press for NEXT, Long Press for VOL-
3. POWER SWITCH: Long press to power ON/OFF Short press to PLAY/PAUSE, Short press to answer/hang up phone calls Long press to reject incoming calls, Press twice to re-dial last number.
4. LED Indicator
5. Micro USB Jack
6. Mic

### LED Indicator

Bluetooth mode: The blue and red LED indicators flash alternately, when the headphones are successfully connected to Bluetooth devices. The LED indicator will flash slowly.

Charging: Orange LED indicator for charging status. The LED indicator turns white upon completed charging.

Switching off: Orange LED lights up for a while.

### Enter Bluetooth

Long press power switch to turn it on, the white LED indicator lights up for a while, then off for 5 seconds, it automatically enters pairing with the orange and white LED indicator flashing alternately.

### Bluetooth Connection

1. Press the power button to turn on the headphones, then enter pairing status of the Bluetooth mode.
2. When the orange and white LED indicators flash alternately, turn on the Bluetooth function of the Bluetooth devices (mobile phones, computers, etc.), and search for Bluetooth devices, "F9".
3. Manually click, then the device connects automatically. When Bluetooth is successfully connected, the LED indicator will be off with a voice prompt. (The password is "0000". Generally, the password is not needed)

### Multi-Point Connections

1. Disconnect with the first device and restart the headphones to pairing status before connecting the second device, then restart the Bluetooth function of the first device and manually reconnect with it. Note: If you want to play music via the second device while the first device is playing, please exit the music application on the first device, then play music on the second device.
2. One phone is making a call, while there is an incoming call of another one.
  - Long press MFB for 1 second to reject.
  - Press MFB twice to maintain the current call and answer the incoming call.
  - Short press MFB to hang up the current call and answer the incoming call.
3. One phone is making a call, while the call of another one is maintaining.
  - Press MFB twice to maintain the current call and answer the call of another which is maintained before.
  - Short press MFB to hang up the current call and answer the call of another which is maintained before.

### Charging Method

Connect the provided Micro USB charging cable to a computer or USB charger. Orange LED indication for charging status. The LED indicator turns white upon completed charging.

### Low Battery

If the battery is low, the speaker will automatically turn off. Please charge in time. If you haven't used it for a long time, please charge at least once a month, which can protect the battery.

### Warm tips

In order to extend the speaker service life, it is not recommended to adjust the speakers to the maximum level for a long time.

Wired Mode - Dual 3.5mm Audio Cable connected to Audio Jack (Without Microphone Function)

1. Plug and play: Connecting the headphones to music players with the provided dual 3.5mm audio cable, the headphones can be used as wired headphones without starting.
2. Actually, the buttons are invalid in wired mode.

### Important Safety Instructions
