- ① Please charge wireless presenter at first.
- ② Press the Page Up key to turn on power at same time.
- ③ Release Page Up key when the LED indicator to be "Flash".
- ④ Connect USB wireless receiver with PC/Laptop available USB Port.
- ⑤ When the LED indicator is off, it's paired successfully.
- ⑥ Plug & Play. No driver required.

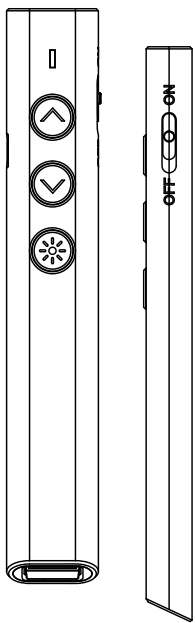

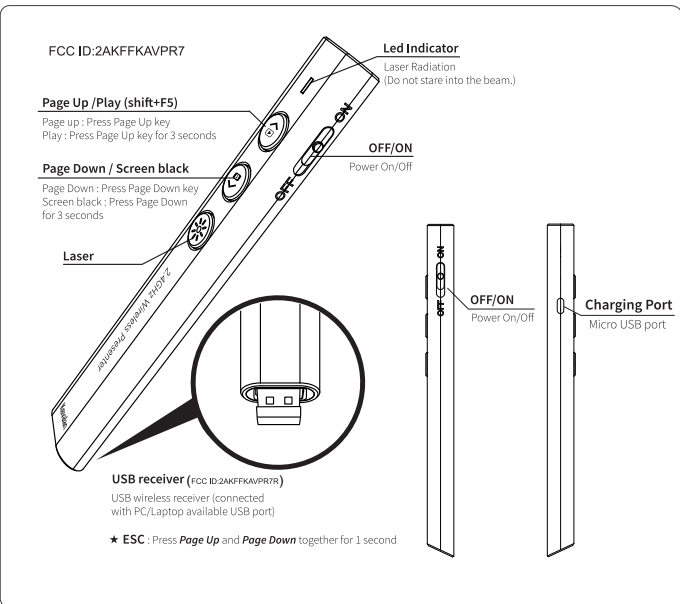
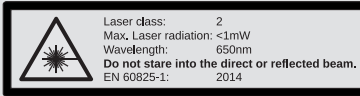

* Default Setting: Window PPT Mode

LED Indicator mode

- ① Laser On: Blue LED on
- ② Charging: Red LED on
- ③ Full Charge: Red LED off
