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GENERAL INFORMATION

Product Description for Equipment under Test (EUT)

The *Advanced Mobile Payment Inc.* 's product, model number: *AMP 7000-FA (FCC ID: 2AKJB-AMP7000-3)* in this report is a *POS Payment Terminal*, which was measured approximately: 190 mm (L) * 89.5 mm (W) *56 mm (H), rated with input voltage: DC 7.4V battery or DC 9.5V from adapter.

Objective

This test report is prepared on behalf of *Advanced Mobile Payment Inc.* in accordance with Part 2-Subpart J, Part 22-Subpart H and Part 24-Subpart E of the Federal Communication Commissions rules.

The objective is to determine the compliance of the EUT with FCC rules for output power, modulation characteristic, occupied bandwidth, and spurious emission at antenna terminal, spurious radiated emission, frequency stability and band edge.

Test Methodology

All tests and measurements indicated in this document were performed in accordance with the Code of Federal Regulations Title 47 Part 2-Subpart J as well as the following parts:

Part 22 Subpart H - Public Mobile Services

Part 24 Subpart E - Personal Communication Services

All emissions measurement was performed at Bay Area Compliance Laboratories Corp. (Kunshan). The radiated testing was performed at an antenna-to-EUT distance of 3 meters.

The final qualification test was performed with the EUT operating at normal mode.




According to FCC §2.1046 and §22.913 (a), the ERP of mobile transmitters and auxiliary test transmitters must not exceed 7 watts.

According to FCC §2.1046 and §24.232 (C), mobile and portable stations are limited to 2 watts EIRP and the equipment must employ a means for limiting power to the minimum necessary for successful communications.

Test Procedure

Conducted method:

The RF output of the transmitter was connected to the wireless test set and the spectrum analyzer through sufficient attenuation.

FCC §2.1053, §22.917 & §24.238 - SPURIOUS RADIATED EMISSIONS

Applicable Standard

FCC § 2.1053, §22.917 and § 24.238.

Test Procedure

The transmitter was placed on a wooden turntable, and it was transmitting into a non-radiating load which was also placed on the turntable.

The measurement antenna was placed at a distance of 3 meters from the EUT. During the tests, the receiving antenna height and polarization as well as EUT azimuth were varied in order to identify the maximum level of emissions from the EUT. The test was performed by placing the EUT on 3-orthogonal axis.

The frequency range up to tenth harmonic of the fundamental frequency was investigated.

Remove the EUT and replace it with substitution antenna. A signal generator was connected to the substitution antenna by a non-radiating cable. The absolute levels of the spurious emissions were measured by the substitution.

Spurious emissions in dB = $10 \lg (\text{TXpwr in Watts}/0.001)$ – the absolute level

Spurious attenuation limit in dB = $43 + 10 \log_{10} (\text{power out in Watts})$
