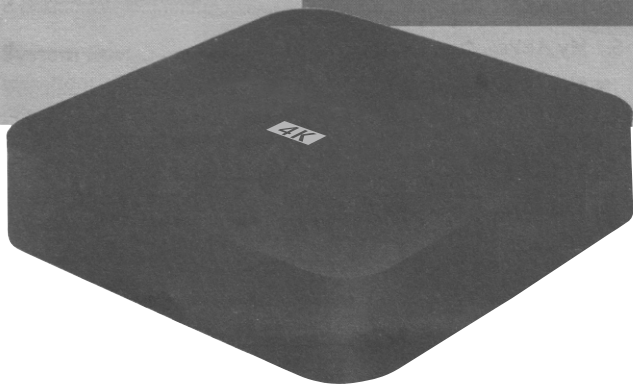

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1. System Introduction

1.1. Key Features

- Android 5.1.1 operating system with ARM Quad core Cortex A53.
- Support many kinds of IPTV and OTT TV programs.
- Support four main HD formats: 4K, VC-1, H.264, H.265, MPEG-2 and many other normal formats decoding, such as MPDG-1, DIVX, REALMEDIA and so on.
- Video formats include AVI, MPG, VOB, RMVB, MKV, M2TS etc.

2.1. Introduction of Remote Control

1. Power: Press to turn on/off
2. Mute: Press to turn on/off the volume
3. Media: shortcut to media player
4. Music: shortcut to audio player
5. Web: shortcut to the browser
6. APP: shortcut to My Apps
7. VOL-: Press to decrease the volume
8. VOL+: Press to increase the volume



Fast Rewind:Go to the precious page

Fast Forward:Go to the next page

Main Menu:Shortcut to go to the main menu

Return:Press to return back to the precious page

Navigation:Press to navigate left/right/up /down Press OK to confirm your choice

Menu:Press to choose function menu of corresponding application in video,music, photo and website

Cursor:Press to use the navigation button as cursor

Number Keypad:Press to input Arabic number

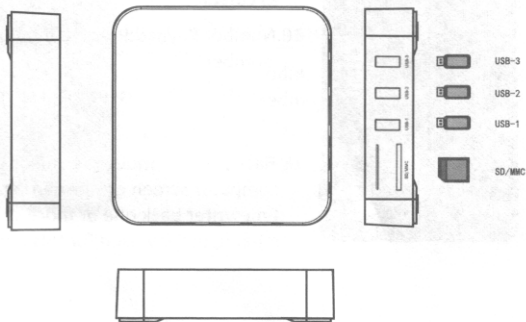
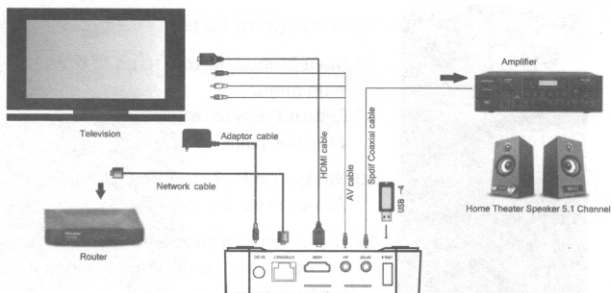
Gppgle now:Shortcut to go to the Google now interface

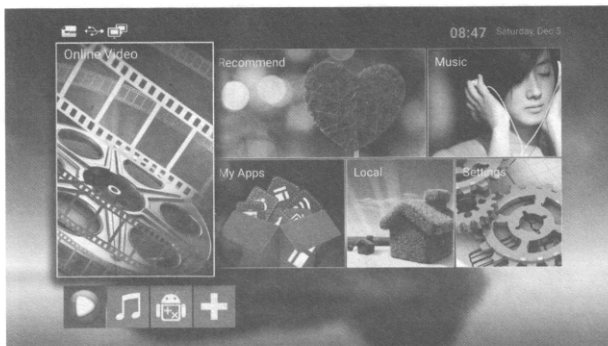

You can add/delete the app when choose the icon in the list.



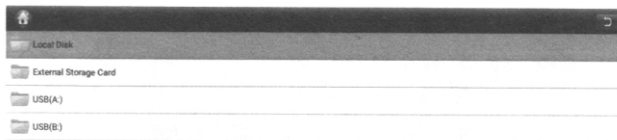
5. My APPs

Press the “My Apps” icon, then press OK to enter. You can find all the apps setting in the device.



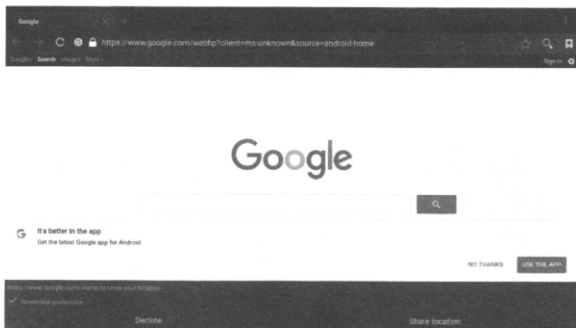
5.1. Movie Player

5.2. Browser

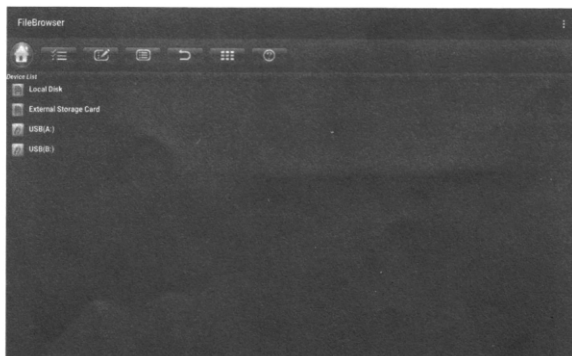
Press “Browser” icon, the homepage is Google page.

5.4. App Installer

Press "App Installer". Press OK to enter.

You can install apps by this app installer function. Please copy your desired software as app format from the computer to the USB storage device first, and then choose the desired device in order to scan the apps.

Press OK to install your desired software.

When the installation finished, the software icon will be shown in My Apps.

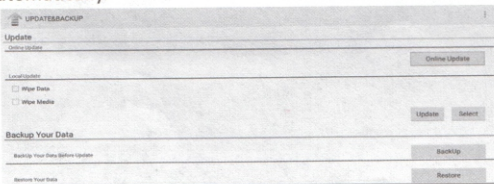


5.5. OTA update Optional

Press “Settings box” icon, Press OK to enter.

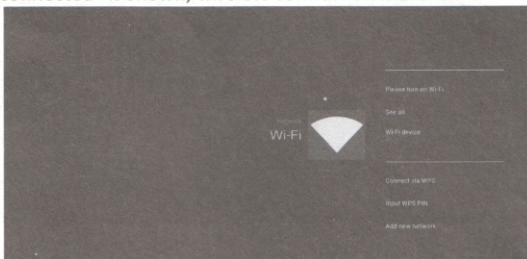
6.1. Network

6.1.1. Wi-Fi

Check “Wi-Fi”, System will start scanning available wireless points around you automatically.

Choose an access point and enter the password.

After authenticating, IP address will be given to the box and “connected” is shown, wireless connection is available.

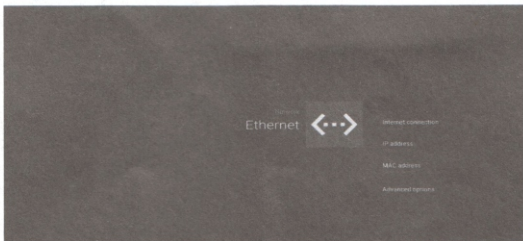


Notice: Wi-Fi connection and Ethernet connection are mutually excluded in this setting app. Only one could be activated at the same time.

6.1.2. Ethernet

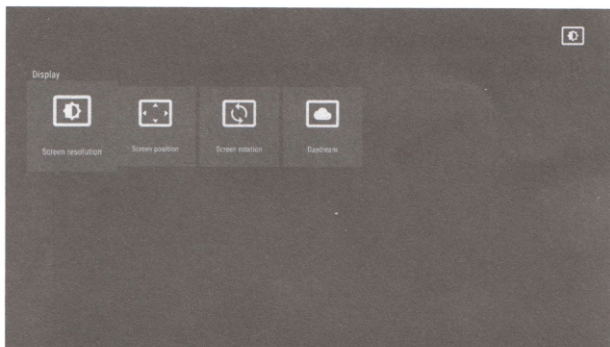
Click “Ethernet”, System will start DHCP process automatically.

When the IP address appears, the network connection is available.

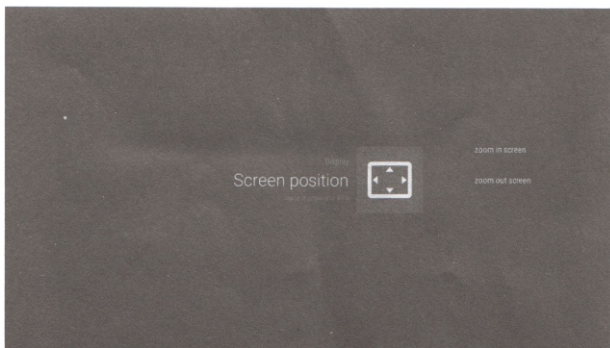


6.2. Display

Press “Display” to choose display settings. Here you can toggle HDMI auto-detection, hide or show status bar at the bottom of the screen, adjust display area, set screensaver timeout.



Please use the “Up”, “Down”, “Left” and “Right” keys on the remote to change the screen resolution, rotation and position
