

INSTRUCTION BOOK

1. "+"Key:

Short press next song, long press the volume to increase

2. "-"Key:

Short press previous song, long press the volume to decrease

3. "▶"Key:

Play state short play / pause, mobile phone bluetooth and bluetooth sound When the box connection is successful, short press the button to answer an incoming call, lone press this key to hang up the call, double click to make a call

4. "M"Key:

Click this button to change FM frequency range 87.5-108MHz mode and bluetooth mode.

5. "⏻"key:

Power switch: Switch off for shutdown, dial to ON for start up

6. USB reader:

Key: U disk interface: play the mp3 in the U disk

7. "≡" reader:

Key: TF card slot: play the mp3 file in the TF card

8. "□"

Charger slot use the micro USB cable to charging

9. AUX

AUX IN can connect to PC, mp3, Phone, or CD walkman
